4. DESCRIPTION OF THE RALLY

The length of the route is 306,66 km including 9 special stages with the total length of 101,16 km.

If a person who is either a competitor or acting on behalf of a competitor of SM O.K. Auto-ralli is found on the roads outside the reconnaissance schedule before the competitor's start time in the area of Luumäki or Savitaipale the competitor is refused the right to start. This concerns roads of Finnish roadmap, marked in yellow, grey and black or unmarked roads used for the rally.

5.1 Competitors

The competition is a NEAFP event and thus open to licence holders of other countries' ASNs.

6. ENTRIES

Anybody wishing to take part in SM O.K. Auto-Ralli must submit the entry through KITI-service, or ask the secretary of the event for instructions to submit entry using alternative means.

ASN licence holders from other countries will submit their entries via entry form which can be found in www.okautoralli.fi. The entry form should be emailed to the secretary of the event, anne.ristola@okautoralli.fi

The maximum number of entries is fixed at 180 crews. Should the number of entries exceed this number, drivers who have entered the Finnish Rally Championship or Suomi Cup will be given priority.

8. SERVICE

There is one service park in the event located at Venäläisenkyläntie 1 54580 Somerharju.

Service is allowed only in the service park. The length of the service is 1 x 33 minutes. There will be only one service. The organiser will reserve each crew 6 x 8 metres service space or a service space as defined in the Finnish Rally Championship regulations. Should a joint service space be requested, a written request (with the dimensions of the area) must reach the organiser by May 29th 2017 by 23.59 at the following contact: email anne.ristola@okautoralli.fi. After that date the organiser will charge € 150 for every change concerning the service park layout. Organiser reserves the right to reject requests.

Service vehicles must be equipped with fire extinguisher appropriate for extinguishing flammable fluids and with an oil spill kit ready for use at any time. A tarpaulin or equivalent being at least the size of the vehicles, must be used in the service park during service.

Penalty fees for infringements in the service park area are as follows:

1st infringement 300€

2nd infringement 600€

3rd infringement exclusion from the event by the decision of the Clerk of the Course.

9. REFUELLING

Refuelling is only allowed at petrol stations marked in the road book or otherwise shown by the organiser, as well as at marked refuel zones according to the Finnish Rally Championship regulations.

10. RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance for classes 1-15 will take place on Friday June 9th 2017 from 08.00 to 17.00 except SS 9 from 14.00 to 17.00.

Competitors in classes 1-15 may collect their reconnaissance material from the Rally Office at Original Sokos Hotel Vaakuna, Hovioikeudenkatu 2 Kouvolaa either on Thursday June 8th 2017 between 15.00 and 20.00 or on Friday June 9th 2017 starting at 07.00. Both drivers have to present their licences and other documents personally.

At registration, each competitor must give the organiser details of the car used for reconnaissance, contact details of his/her mobile phone and contact details for their service.

Identification stickers (2 pieces) for the reconnaissance must be affixed on the reconnaissance vehicle as follows: one to top center of the windscreen and the other to the rear side window on the right-hand side. They must be visible throughout the whole duration of the reconnaissance.

On special stages the speed limit is 80 km/h unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed along the route by the organiser. The competitors must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages. Under no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the rally in a special stage. Organiser will control the traffic during the reconnaissance paying attention to the manner of driving as well as to the speeds used. Police will also control the reconnaissance and will penalise competitors for infringements according to the Finnish Traffic Law.

The organiser will control speeding with GPS devices, which will give an automatic report. The GPS device can be collected from the Rally Office Friday June 9th 2017 starting at 07.00 and on Saturday an hour before every crew's start time. Competitor must reserve a USB power supply for the GPS device and must keep the device on during the whole reconnaissance. Competitor must return the GPS device to the Rally Office after reconnaissance.

There will be RC-stations on the course where the competitor is obligated to stop. The Clerk of the Course can also notify possible infringements via these stations.

For a speeding infringement during reconnaissance measured either by the organiser or by the police or switching of the GPS device the Clerk of the Course may impose a penalty as follows:

1st infringement: reprimand

2nd infringement: 90 € fine

3rd infringement: 200 € fine

4th infringement: refusal to start

The organiser must inform the competitor of the infringements immediately either by telephone or via RC-station. The fine must be paid to the Rally Office at the latest 30 minutes before start time or the start is refused.

If the speeding offence is more than 30 km/h, the Clerk of the Course may exclude the crew.

Competitors are, under pain of refusal to start, obliged to stop if Rally Officials with official plates request them to do so.

Reconnaissance is allowed only two times per special stage. The organiser will monitor this via GPS devices and on the course.

Competitors from classes 16-26 can not participate in reconnaissance. If a competitor from classes 16-26 is met on a special stage before their start time their start is refused.

The Organiser withholds the right to search at any time during the rally the car and all personal items (including telephones) and bags of a competitor from classes 16-26. If any notes for the route are discovered the competitor will be excluded from the race.

The lenght of reconnaissance, classes 1-15

Reconnaissance starts June 9th 2017 at 8.00 and ends June 9th at 17.00
Reconnaissance for SS 9 is from 14.00 to 17.00 the same day.

Reconnaissance is allowed with the following restrictions: Reconnaissance is allowed only two times per special stage including special stages that will be driven twice during the rally..

Speeding infringements during the rally

For a speeding infringement on a road section or in the Service Park measured either by the organiser or by the police, the Clerk of the Course may impose a penalty as follows:

1st infringement: written reprimand and 90 € fine. If the speeding offence is more than 30 km/h, the Clerk of the Course may exclude the crew.

2nd infringement: as defined by the Clerk of the Course, but may be a maximum 500 € fine or exclusion.

The fine must be paid to the Rally Office immediadly after the rally or at the latest before the publication of the Provisional classifications. If failing to do so the Clerk of the Course may exclude the crew.

11. ADVERTISING

Windscreen stickers in championship classes: as per rules of the Rally SM series. On competition numbers: OK Auto Oy, Kaupunkilehti Pohjois-Kymenlaakso (logo), Original Sokos hotelli Vaakuna, Kuljetus Nokkanen Oy.

V THE RALLY

12. START

The rally will start at Kouvola market square June 10th 2017 at 09.01 in one minute intervals. The start time of every crew will be published on the Official Notice Board.

GPS device and the transponder for the results can be collected from the Rally Office at the latest one hour before every crews own start time.

GPS device and the tranponder must be retuned at finish TC.

Time card will be given to competitors at start TC.

13. FINISH

The finish of the rally is located at Original Sokos Hotel Vaakuna starting June 10th 2017 at 17.21. There will not be a Parc Fermé area at the finish.

Protest against any cars must be made before said car arrives at the finish. Telephone number can be found in the road book.

14. COMPETITOR MATERIAL

Competitors in classes 1-15 are given one road book, which gives detailed description of the route to be followed, and two route maps, either on Thursday June 8th between 15.00-20.00 at the same time as administrative checks or during administrative checks in the Rally Office at Sokos Hotel Kouvola Vaakuna on Friday June 9th 2017 starting at 07.00.

Competitors in classes 16-26 are given one road book, which gives detailed description of the route to be followed, and two route maps after administrative checks one hour before their start time from the Rally Office.

15. REGROUPING HALTS

There will be two (2) regrouping halts during the rally. Service is forbidden during these halts. The lenght of these halts will be maximum 18 minutes and minimum 4 minutes.

There will be one (1) service halt during the rally. Service is allowed during this halt. The lenght of the service halt will be 33 minutes.

16. SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering will start Saturday June 10th 2017 at 7.30 at OK Auto Oy, Kaitilankatu 6, 45130 Kouvola, tel +358 45 6101361.

Detailed schedule will be given in rally guide and will be regarded as part of these Supplementary regulations.

Scrutineering of closes 30 minutes after the time given for the last competition number.

Voluntary scrutineering will be held Friday June 9th 2017 from 18.00 to 21.00 at OK Auto Oy, Kaitilankatu 6, 45130 Kouvola, tel +358 45 6101361.

If a competitor wishes to enroll for voluntary scrutineering they can do so during administrative checks in the Rally Office either on Thursday June 8th 2017 from 15.00 to 20.00 or on Friday June 9th starting at 7.00. They will be given a time for scrutineering when enrolling.

Scrutineering for classes 16-26 will only take place on Saturday June 10th 2017. Details on the rally guide.

16.1 Sealing for Turbos and R5 cars

Sealing will take place during pre-rally scrutineering on Friday June 9th 2017 from 16.00 to 18.00. Details on the rally guide.

16.2 Tires

The maximum number of tires that can be used in the rally is ten. The acquisition, marking and checking of the tires should happen according to Finnish SM Rally Regulations. Details on the rally guide.

17. RESULTS

Provisional classifications per competition class will be published on the official notice board as per schedule given in the rally guide. Official classifications will be available at KITI-system and www.okautoralli.fi.

18. PRIZES AND PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

The prizes will be memorabilia and utility articles.

The number of awarded competitors will be published on the Official Notice Board.

Prizes will be given to both drivers in the finish area at Original Sokos hotel Kouvola Vaakuna based on provisional classifications. If there is a chance on crews awarded a prize after official results the competitor is required to return prizes given to them.

All crews to receive prizes must attend the ceremony. Only the Clerk of the Course may grant permission for a crew not to attend the ceremony.
