# • DESCRIPTION OF THE RALLY

The length of the rally for classes 1-13 is 271 kilometers including 8 special stages, the total length of which is approx. 110 kilometers.

The length of the rally for classes 14-19 is 119 kilometers including 5 special stages, the total length of which is approx. 75 kilometers. The end of Special Stage 8 includes a 1-kilometer-long portion of asphalt.

If a person who is either a competitor or acting on behalf of a competitor is confronted on the roads around Sastamala, Huittinen or Punkalaidun before the competitor's starting time and outside the reconnaissance schedule for classes 1-13, as depicted in in Art. 10, the competitor's right to start will be revoked. This concerns roads of the Finnish roadmap marked in yellow, grey and black or unmarked roads used for the rally.

There is no reconnaissance for classes 14-19. These classes only partake in special stages 1-5. The organizer has the right to check the car and all personal equipment (including telephones) and bags of any class 14-19 driver at any point of the competition in case of possible pace notes. The discovery of such material leads to exclusion, as well as possible further sanctions after the competition determined by the AKK.

#### 5.1 Competitors

The competition is an FIA/NEAFP event and thus, it is open to license holders of other countries' ASNs.

#### ENTRIES

Anybody wishing to take part in Enset SM-Ralli must submit the entry through KITI-service, or consult the Secretary of the Event by email (<a href="mailto:tanja.tuomisto@hotmail.fi">tanja.tuomisto@hotmail.fi</a>) or by phone (+35840 568 9205) for instructions on how to submit an entry using alternative means.

The maximum number of entries is fixed at 180 crews. Should the number of entries exceed this number, drivers who have entered the Finnish Rally Championship or Suomi Cup will be given priority.

If the number of entries in classes 11-19 is less than 3, the organizer may merge such class with another class

As the entry has been submitted, the competitor accepts the usage of given personal information by the organizer as well as the publication of designated personal information (name, club etc.) in the participant list, result list and other means of communication during the competition.

Driver's competition license number should be used as the reference number for the payment. The entry fees for competitors enrolled in SM1 – SM4 classes include the series' service fees and tracking device fees.

#### SERVICE

The competition utilizes a centralized service area located in Vexve-Areena, Ratakatu 27, Sastamala or in its direct proximity.

The service area is opened on Friday 31th of August 2018 at 13.00. The area is guarded during the night in between Friday and Saturday. (Service Area Manager Mika Karvonen Tel. +35840 582 2113.)

The organizer will reserve every competitor-duo a service area of 6 x 8 meters and a service area conforming to the regulations of the Finnish Rally Championship for those driving for team championship.

For joint service area requests and other special requests, a detailed written application (the size of the service area must be mentioned) needs to be sent to the organizer by 21<sup>st</sup> of August 2018 at 23.59 to <a href="mika.karvonen@kopteri.net">mika.karvonen@kopteri.net</a> After this date, the organizer will charge €150 for every change concerning the service park layout. The organizer reserves the right to reject requests.

The service vehicles must be equipped with a competitor-specific fire extinguisher of 6 kilograms as well as an oil spill kit ready for use at any time. A liquid-proof tarpaulin must be positioned under the rally car so that its whole surface area is covered. There must also be sufficient protection under the service vehicle in case of accidental oil leaks.

#### Penalty fees for infringements in the service park area are as follows:

1st infringement300 € fee2nd infringement600 € fee

**3rd** infringement exclusion from the event by the decision of the Clerk of the

#### 8.1 Flexi-service

During both service halts, flexi-service takes place. Once the competitor arrives at the break's time-checking station, he is given a leaving time from the service as well as the starting time of the service. After this, the competitor can move the car to the service area and attach a sticker indicating the time of the commenced service to a visible spot on the rally car. This is a means of indicating the starting time of the service. The official competition timer defines the actual time of the beginning of service. The competitors must immediately exit their vehicle after arriving at their service area. Premature starting of service procedures causes exclusion from the event. This is supervised by the event judges.

#### REFUELING

Refueling is only allowed at petrol stations marked by the organizer, as well as at marked refuel zones according to the Finnish Rally Championship regulations 16.1.

When entering the rally, competitors must fill and hand in a form where they inform the organizer of the type of fuel to be used (98E5, E85 or FIA Appendix J) and the method of refueling (directly from the pump at petrol stations or in organizer's refuel area from own drums/cans).

The competitor must inform the organizer about the aforementioned information through the KITI-system's enrollment's additional information-field by 21th of August 2018 at 23.59. If the organizers are not informed, the enrollment is insufficient and the competitor is obliged to pay a fee conforming to the regulations of the rally during the enrollment.

#### RECONNAISSANCE

From the 31th of August 2018 at 07.00 onwards, the competitors of classes 1-13 can collect the reconnaissance material from the Rally Office. Once they receive and check out the material, the competitors must give the organizer information about their reconnaissance vehicle as well as their phone number.

The Reconnaissance time of Special stages 1-7 starts on the 31th of August 2018 at 08.00 and ends on the 31th of August 2018 at 18.00

The Reconnaissance time of Special stage 8 starts on the 31th of August 2018 and ends on the 31th of August 2018 at 18.30

Identification stickers (2 pieces) for the reconnaissance must be affixed on the reconnaissance vehicle as follows: One on top of the windscreen in the middle and the other on the rear side window on the right- hand side. They must be visible during the whole time of the reconnaissance.

GPS tracking devices are given at the distribution of reconnaissance materials. Competitors must have a USB power source in the car to be used in reconnaissance for the tracking device. The device must be connected during the whole time of the reconnaissance.

The organizer will monitor the reconnaissance with the tracking device. The monitoring feedback is created automatically so it cannot leave space for ambiguity. The competitor is responsible for returning the tracking device on Friday after the reconnaissance. On Saturday, the competitor must collect the device from the Rally Office at least 2 hours before the departure. The devices are recalled at the time checking station of the competition's finish line. In case of retirement, the device is given to the demolition vehicle or returned to the Rally Office immediately. This also applies on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2018 regarding classes 14-19.

During the reconnaissance, the speed limit of all special stages is 80km/h, unless it is lowered additionally with traffic signs or other signs placed in the terrain by the organizer. The way of driving must not endanger or disturb other traffic or settlements nearby. The organizer prohibits driving against the directions of the special stage. The organizer also observes the speed and driving behavior during the reconnaissance. The police will also perform observations along the course and punishes for all misdemeanors according to the Finnish traffic laws.

Competitors are obliged to stop if Rally Officials with official plates request them to do so.

#### Speeding infringements during reconnaissance

A Speeding infringement during reconnaissance is penalized according to the series rules Art. 10.1.

# START

The starting time of each crew will be published according to the programme on the official notice board.

The competitors will receive their time card on the 1st of September 2018 one (1) minute before the starting time at the start-TC, ABC Huittinen.

A start will take place on the 1st of September 2018 at 10.01 and every minute onwards. There is no Parc Fermé-area at the start.

Should a competitor not follow the route given in the road book of the rally on the road sections, it may lead to exclusion by the Clerk of the Course.

AT/TC 5C is not free early arrival (suom. "ennakkovapaa") for classes 14-19

#### Speed infringement during the competition

Speed infringements during the competition will be penalized according to the series rules Art. 9.2.

## • COMPETITOR MATERIAL

Competitors for classes 1-13 are given one road book, which gives detailed description of the route to be followed, and two route maps starting on Friday the 31th of August 2018 at 07.00 at the Rally Office.

Competitors for classes 14-19 are given one road book and two route maps starting on Saturday the 1st of September 2018 at 07.30 at the Rally Office.

#### REGROUPING HALTS

For classes 1-13 there will be two (2) service halts and three (3) regrouping halts.

For classes 14-19 there will be one (1) service halt and one (1) regrouping halt.

#### PRE-RALLY SCRUTINEERING

Pre-rally scrutineering will take place at the car compartment of Vammalan Ammattikoulu, Ratakatu 36, Sastamala, Chief Scrutineer Markku Suvanto puh. +358400 827 628

Optional pre-rally scrutineering for classes 1-13 takes place on Friday the 31th of August 2018 at 14.00 - 20.00

BOOKING at https://slotti.fi/booking/rallism/ on the 23rd of August 2018 - 29th of August 2018 at 21.00 - 04.00.

If the competitor wishes to change the scrutineering time after the closing of the booking system, the organizer will charge a fee of 50€ for the change. This fee is also charged for the cars that must be placed by the organizer if the service time is not reserved by the competitor or if the competitor is late for the reserved scrutineering time.

Detailed schedule will be given in the Competitors' Information Kit and will be regarded as part of these Supplementary regulations.

Pre-rally scrutineering for classes 1-19 begins on Saturday the 1st of September 2018 at 07.30 and ends 10 minutes after the last booked inspection.

The competitors are not obliged to be present during the pre-rally scrutineering.

The competitor or anyone acting on behalf of a competitor has to enroll at the pre-scrutineering office (Ratakatu 36, Sastamala) 10 minutes before their own pre-rally scrutineering time, so that the rally car is deemed to be present on time, and that the race car registration form or transportation license, scrutineering card / Historic-pass (HTP) or V1600- pass and a valid traffic insurance are inspected.

After a successful inspection of the necessary papers, the arrival time will be filled into the pre-rally scrutineering transcript. The transcript is given to the competitor or anyone acting on behalf of the competitor, who then moves the car to the pre-rally scrutineering line.

Should a driver wish to lodge a protest against another competitor's car, this must be done by phone to the number given by the organizer, before the arrival of the car in question to the Time Control at the finish of the rally. After this, the car will be placed under scrutineers' control. The organizer must verify the identity of the lodger of the protest. All protests made against any car during the rally must be verified in writing at the latest when the lodger arrives to the final time control. The phone number in question will be given in the Road Book of the rally.

## Tyre Regulations

The make and model of the tyres used in the competition are unrestricted as long as they comply with the regulations of Appendix J. In FRC and Suomi Cup a maximum of 10 pcs of tyres are allowed.

Competitors in classes 1-6 must deliver the organizer a list of all the FIA barcode numbers of the tyres used in the rally by filling the series tyre code form. This must be done before the inspection of the necessary papers at the pre-rally scrutineering.

It is permitted to carry a maximum of two spare tyres in the rally car.

# RESULTS

# PRIZES AND PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

The number of awarded competitors will be published on the Official Notice Board.

The prizes for classes 1-13 are distributed on Saturday the 1st of September 2018 on the finish platform of the Spectator SS in the Hoppu area. The prizes for classes 14-19 are distributed on Saturday the 1st of September 2018 in the hall of Vexve-Areena.

All crews to receive prizes must attend the ceremony. Only the Clerk of the Course may grant permission for a crew not to attend the ceremony.
