For fluent Safety Check we kindly ask competitor (or his authorized person) to present rally cars documentation latest 10minutes before own reserved time. There is no separate TC in Safety Check, document check desk is the TC

Scrutineering document will be given to competitor in here. After approved Safety Check, document will stay at organizer.

SEALING

Competitor or his representative needs to prepare all equipment ready to be sealed. Sealing wires needs to be in place. After adding the seals, parts will be added to scrutineer document.

DRIVERS EQUIPMENT

Drivers equipment are also checked during Safety Check.

MARKING OF TYRES (classes 1-5 and 7-12)

In Classes 1-5 it is allowed to use max 8 tires.

Competitor needs to give list of FIA codes from all tires which are used in event. List of tyre codes is as attachment in this document. Filled document needs to given to organizer latest at Safety Check, when showing cars documentation. Tyre form attached below

SERVICE PARK AND SERVICE

1. service after SS2 and 2nd service after SS3.

There is TC both service in and out. So called Flexi service.

Centralized Service Park. Other areas only drivers can do maintenance with tools which are in rally car during event.

FINISH

Rally finish is TC 5C.

After TC 5C, drivers deserved for prize giving ceremony are collected to re-grouping area and guided to Market place. (same area as rally start)

SERVICE PARK

Service Park is opens on Friday at 15:00. Entry before that forbidden. No trailers allowed. Organizer will reserve space for every competitor according Finnish Rally Championship regulations Note: no guarding during night.

Only one service car to Service Park for each competitor. Please put service car sign ("Huoltoauto") with register plate number, to windscreen. That sign needs to be visible during whole event. Smoking is allowed only in marked places, see the map. Organizer is controlling area during event.

FLEXI SERVICE

In SS 2 finish TC 2B competitor will get time for "service-out" to time card. This time includes road section from SS finish to service park, technical check time, break and service time. Service park in TC is "early entry" allowed. There will be given "Service start time" to competitor (separate document). This needs to be visually seen by organization and service can be started only that time.

After "Service-in TC", there is technical check are (min 3 minutes)

Asia

AKK-Motorsports Ry on hakenut Liikenne- ja viestintävirasto Traficomilta poikkeusta rallikilpailuissa käytettävien autojen vaatimusten osalta.

Hakijan kilpailukalenteriin merkityissä rallikilpailuissa käytettävien autojen renkaat eivät täytä vaatimuksia seuraavilta osin:

- 1. Nastojen ulkonema ylittää ajoneuvojen käytöstä tiellä annetun asetuksen 17 § 5 momentissa ja asetuksen ajoneuvon renkaiden nastoista 2 § 3 momentissa säädetyt mitat;
- 2. Nastojen lukumäärä ja pistovoima ylittävät asetuksen ajoneuvon renkaiden nastoista 2 § 1 momentissa ja 3 § 2 momentissa määrätyt arvot;
- Renkaissa käytetyt nastat eivät ole tyyppihyväksyttyjä asetuksen ajoneuvon renkaiden nastoista 3 §:n mukaisesti.

Rallikilpailuissa käytettävien autojen valaisimet poikkeavat määrän, valotehon ja hyväksynnän osalta autojen ja niiden perävaunujen teknisistä vaatimuksista annetun määräyksen liitteen 1 taulukon kohdan 20 vaatimuksista. Autot eivät myöskään kaikilta osin täytä määräyksen liitteen 1 taulukohdan 32 etunäkyvyysaluetta koskevia vaatimuksia tuulilasiin kiinnitettyjen tarrojen vuoksi.

Päätös

Traficom hyväksyy hakemuksen.




































Safety equipment instructions (smartphone) Class 1-12

GPS Safety Tracking - User's Manual

In FRC events all cars will be equipped with a GPS safety tracking device, run by AKK Sports with Traxmeet. Tracking is done using the equipment and the installed application. Below you can find the main features and operation instructions, installation instructions have been given separately.



Opening Screen

When the device opens, start the RaceLive application from the icon circled with red in the picture.

You may need to swipe to the left to access this desktop page.

When the application opens, you choose reconnaissance tracking (RE-CCE) or RALLY tracking.


















Reconnaissance Tracking

If you press RECCE on the start screen, the view pictured on the left will open, as the device is searching for connection.



Once connected, the device will show a possible speed limit set by the organiser for a certain area (e.g. a special stage) and the your current speed.

All competitor movement within special stage areas will be registered in the application database and can be used afterwards to monitor speeds etc.

Once you finish reconnaissance, you can stop the tracking application by gliding the green dot at the bottom of the screen to the right.

Should the tracking device cause disturbance to your recce or rally intercom system (old systems are less protected), the easiest way to fix this is to wrap the intercom control box into normal aluminium foil used in kitchen.






















Reconnaissance Tracking continued...

Should you go over the speed limit set by the organiser, the device will show this to the drivers (SPEEDING). The device will not show any speed limits set by the road authorities.

Any speeding will be stored in the application database.



When you have chosen RALLY tracking from the start screen, the view pictured on the left will open to the screen, as the device is searching for connection.


























Rally Tracking continued...

Once connected, the device will show the basic status with OK and SOS buttons, and the connection confirmation.



If you need to stop on stage to change a tyre or something, but there is no need for medical or fire assistance, nor any danger to the surrounds, you must press OK on the basic status screen.

When OK is pressed, the screen goes green. It will automatically return to basic status after approx. 5 seconds after pressing the OK and the message having gone through to the system.














Accidents - SOS

If you stop during the rally e.g. to change a tyre, the device will automatically start an SOS alarm in about 20 seconds, unless OK is pressed.

The time before the alarm is made can be seen on the SOS button (17) seconds remaining on the sample screen). It takes about 40 seconds from the moment of stopping to the time of sending the SOS.

Please remember to dismiss the automatic SOS before it is sent by pressing OK.

The Auto-SOS re-activates once the car is moving again at a minimum speed of 60 kph. Auto-SOS function is active on Special Stages only, not on road sections. When stopping at the finish of SS at the STOP control, it may activate itself, as for the device you are still "inside" the stage area according to its settings.

If an Auto SOS is sent, the device will return to basic status.



Should a competitor have an accident where help is needed, he needs to press the SOS button on the RALLY screen.

Pressing the SOS button will take the application to the mode seen on the left, with three options for the user:

- 1. Cancel the alarm by sliding the green dot to the right.
- 2. Confirm the alarm and ask for medical assistance by pressing MEDI-CAL.
- 3. Confirm the alarm and ask for extinguishing assistance by pressing

If data connection does not work, the SOS will be sent as SMS.

After pressing FIRE/MEDICAL the button will flash for a while and the device will return to basic status, unless the SOS has been sent via SMS.
















Accidents - Communication

The Rally Control has an option to communicate with the car, e.g. to get more information on the seriousness of an accident, number of patients or their condition.

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The screen will then show the INFO text, the question underneath and the answer options YES and NO.

The drivers must answer accordingly. There may be multiple questions following one after the other.



Accidents - Red Flag

The application is equipped with an option for the Rally Control to send a Red Flag notification and thus stop the stage for these cars, e.g. in case of accident, road block or other reason.

These feature is not yet in use, but it may be tested on a road section according to organiser's instructions. This will be informed to the drivers.

Should you receive a Red Flag on the screen, you must confirm its reception by pressing the OK at the bottom of the screen.

The flag will remain on the screen until dismissed by Rally Control.











GPS Safety Tracking Device - Installation

AKK Sports is introducing a new GPS Safety Tracking system for the Finnish Rally Championship.

The new system requires some preparations in the rally cars. These are described below. Should you have any questions, we are happy to help.

With the new system we will have better communication facilities with the rally cars in case of any accidents, as well as a more secure communiction channel between the cars and the rally control centre.

Charging Power

Each car must have a female USB power socket for 12V current. The socket must be within 50 cm of the planned installation location of the device. The connection may be part of the car's main circuit, so that when the main power is switched off it will not be discharging the battery e.g. in overnight parc fermé. You may use a basic USB socket, but it must give at least 2A of current. Connection always to the holder (which has a 12V -> 5V converter), not the device!

Installation in the Car

The device must be installed in the car with the equipment described in the following pictures. It is an absolute must that the device will be place so that

- both the driver and the co-driver can reach the touch screen without opening safety belts
- both the driver and the co-driver can see the screen when driving on special stage

The RAM Mount 25 mm ball base can be borrowed or bought from the rally office. The price will be 10 Euros, either as a payment or as deposit which will be returned when the ball is returned after the rally.

Device



The tracking will be done with an application. There are no other applications in the device. Operation instructions will be given later.

The clamp mount seen in the picture does not exist, but the device will be installed with the RAM Mount ball.




















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


This ball mount must be attached to the car with solid screws, in a place as instructed above, in order for the drivers to be able to use the device.

The device is attached to the ball with the double socket arm.



The installation measurements for the base of the ball can be seen here. Screw hole diameter is 6.5 mm and distance between the holes 40 mm.























The 12V USB connection as defined in the tracker installation instructions has raised a lot of questions, as the standard for USB is 5V. Our reason for asking for a 12V connection is that the connection from this female USB is made to the device holder containing a 12V->5V adapter, instead of a direct connection to the actual tracking device.

Below please find one simple and cost-effective way of doing this.

Where to start from?

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
The easiest option is to find the nearest Motonet (www.motonet.fi) store and get a USB socket by Hama (price 8.99€):

The product looks like this:







Cut the cable close to the Micro-USB.


















Peel the cable. There are four thin wires inside.

The white and green ones are for data transmission, forget about them.

The red and black ones are for charging. The red one is connected to the PLUS from the battery and the black to the MINUS (ground).

This female USB is then connected to the male USB coming from the tracker and you're ready!








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The trackers are delivered in a small bag, which can be used for the installation to rollcage bars with the Velcro strap of the bag, with cable ties, duct tape or similar devices.




The device must be switched on by pushing the power switch (1) for at least 2 seconds with a pen or equivalent. When turned on, all LEDs will light for a while. Then they go off and the green LED will blink indicating GSM connection.

These lights do not concern the competitor as such, as long as you remember to control that the official has switched on the power on delivery.

Independent whether the unit will be installed vertically or horizontally, it is important to check that the GPS antenna is pointing up towards the sky (see picture on front page). If the antenna points to the side, it is not so dangerous, but definitely avoid pointing it towards the ground.

Please install the unit as far from the helmet intercom as possible, to avoid unnecessary disturbance (similar to GSM phone disturbance). Recommended places are any vertical or diagonal bars close to the rear or side windows.



















Emergency switch

The tracking device will be delivered with an emergency switch, which can be used to send an SMS to Rally Control Centre. The emergency switch should be connected to the GPS tracking device with the supplied cable to allow the alarm message to be sent. Don't break the cable! Emergency message may only be sent if a crew member or any third person has been injured and needs immediate medical attention.

The emergency switch must be placed in the car so that both crew members can reach to it without opening or loosening their safety belts! The switch will be delivered with some 3M DualLock tape to be used for fastening the switch to the car. After the rally, you can leave the tape to the car, ready for next event, but the switch must be returned together with the tracking device. The cable of the emergency switch mustn't be fastened with cable ties! The cable has one or two mounting straps.

Returning devices

The tracking device and the emergency key will be removed immediately by the organizer after the last TC of the competition.

Retirement

Retirement of the competition the competitor must disconnect the tracking device and the emergency switch from his car. The equipment must be handed over to the sweeper car or the competitor delivers the equipment to the competition center at the competition office.

Recce

During the recce, the tracking system monitors visits in special stages and controls speeds.

In two days of competitions, where the first day is recce and competition, a charging cable is provided. The charging cable is used to make sure that the battery lasts for a whole day. The competitor must transfer the tracking device to the racing car after the recce and the charge cable must be returned immediately to the competition office after the event.

In one day competitions, when one day is for recce and on the other day is competing, the charging cable isn't included. After the recce the tracking device must be returned immediately to the competition office.

These recce instructions doesn't apply in Rovaniemi.
