#### 3. Entry

Everyone who wants to participate RATA-SM BOTNIARING race needs to register via KIT portal or request secondary instructions from the Secretary of the Race.

The competitors need to provide a copy of a valid traffic insurance certificate to the Race Office before participating in any part of the Race – this is also applicable for the foreign competitors.

#### 4. Entry fees

The entry fees are the following:

The entry fee includes 25€ payments for water, waste, electricity and environmental fee.

**Fee for the guest drivers** in the classes of the Finnish Championship is the fee mentioned above + 50 €

In case the competitor enters into two classes with a same car, the entry fee for the second, cheaper class is ½ of the fee mentioned above.

The entry and the entry fee must be with the organizer at the latest 25.7.2021 at 23:59. The payment should be done to the account of Etelä-Pohjanmaan Urheilutoimilijat ry.

The reference number to be used is the license number of the competitor.

The entry fee includes the electricity fee specific for the track for 31.7.-1.8.2021. Fees for the track and electricity for the dates outside of the race are charged by the track owner.

## 5. Paddock

When arriving to the paddock, you must obey the instructions of the Chief of the Paddock/organizer.

In case the paddock spot is set up on one's own without permission of the Chief of the Paddock, the organizer has a right to make the competitor to move their installation.

Demolition of the paddock installation before the last race start has finished is only allowed with a case-by-case permission from the Chief of the Paddock.

## 6. Advertising and competition numbers

The organizer doesn't reserve any places of the car for advertisements.

The competition numbers are according to the regulations of each class, taking into account possible annual competition numbers. The competitors are responsible to get their own competition numbers.

## 7. Drivers' briefing

Takes place on Saturday 31.7. at 8:15. The location will be announced in the information for the competitors.

## 8. Progress of the race

The race proceeds according to the final timetable published later: warm up – qualifications – finals 2-3 pcs. The timetable published together with the information for the competitors (27.7.2021) is referential. Start time for the day and the driving order are invariable. The competitors should follow the progress of the race and be ready in the gathering area when the previous class is on the track.

## 9. Scrutineering

Scrutineering will be done at your own paddock spots, more detailed schedule will be in the information for the competitors.

## 10. Results

The competitors should be available in the competition area until the results of their class are published. Only the Clerk of the Course may grant permission to leave earlier for compelling reasons.

During the competition the provisional and official classifications will be published in the electronic official notice board at [www.epua.fi](http://www.epua.fi) – botniarace.

After the race, the results can be found at KITI portal.

## 11. Prizes

The prizes are souvenirs.

The number of awarded competitors will be announced in the official notice board.

### 11.1. Prize giving

The method of prize giving will be announced in the information for competitors. All competitors receiving prizes need to attend the ceremony. Only the Clerk of the Course may grant permission to be absent for compelling reasons.

## 12. Responsibilities and reservations

The organizer is not responsible for any damage that may occur to the competitor himself or his car or that is caused to another person or another person's property. The competitor is responsible that he and his crew know and comply with these rules, the information for competitors published later and possible bulletins published later. The organizer is entitled to postpone, cancel or suspend the race if the circumstances require it. The organizer has the right to cancel separate classes if the number of competitors remains low.
