This insurance is checked during administrative check.



















7. Entry

Maximum amout of entries is 220. If qualification is required for entries over maximum, FRC and FJRC Classes are priorised. Rally is also part of Regional Championship, so region drivers are not qualified from the rally in any case.

10. Administrative Check

Administrative check is online by forms found from Sportity application and Kiti. Information required: Drivinglisence, contact information during rally, media information and members of team.

These forms must be returned latest 27.2.2022 at 23:59 by email: henna.pallonen@gmail.com Email must include headline with competitor number and name.

Organizer confirms these forms as recieved, but these forms must be present during rally. During Thursday at Rally Office, only driving license is checked. Only one of the competitor crew can recieve rally material.

12. Tyre Regulations

Maximum amount of tires allowed to use during rally is 8. Classes 1 - 7

FIA-barcodes must be informed to organization by tire form found from Sportity. This must be sent by email: rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi Latest on Friday 4.3.2022 at 17:00

If tires without FIA barcode is used, please contact Scrutineer Manager the day before scrutineering.

13. Reconnaissanse (classes 1 - 8 and 14 - 18)

13.1 classes 1 - 8 ja 14 - 18

PLEASE NOTE! Because of the rally liasions, route cannot be reconnaissanse cannot be completed only on Friday.

On Thursday 3.3.2022 at 10:00 - 12:00 or ,on Friday 4.3.2022 at 7:10 - 10:00 competitors can recieve material for reconnaissance. Information about recce-car, contact phone and service team information





















must be provided forehand. Competitor must provide also phone number where crew can be contacted during entire rally.

Reconnaissance car numbers provided by organizer must be fitted in the center top of windscreen and codriver side rear window. These numbers must be visible during reconnaissance.

Speedlimit during recce is 80km/h if other is not stated by traffic sign or signs by organizer. Driving during recce shall not make any kind of risk or disturb other traffic or citizens nearby. Driving against SS driving direction is not allowed. Police and organizer is following recce trafic.

Only highway use tires are allowed to use during recce.

GPS- tracking device is recieved at administrative check. GPS device must be held ON during entire recce. Competitor must have USB powersource for the tracking device. Reconnaissanse is allowed twice for each special stage, including Stages driven twice.

After reconnaissance and before the start of Section 1, competitor must fit GPS-tracking device from recce car to rally car.

Speeding during recce (Stated by organizer GPS or by Police). Penalties follow by Police and ASN Regulations from Clerk of the Course.

13.2 Schedule for reconnaissance

SS 1/7 and 6 on Thursday 3.3.2022 at 12:00 – 16:00 NOTE: RECONNAISSANCE FOR THESE STAGES ONLY **ON THURSDAY**

SS 2 – 5 and 8 – 9 Thursday 3.3.2022 at 12:00 – 21:00 and on Friday 4.3.2022 at 8:00 – 16:00

13.3 Classes 9 - 13 ja 19 - 23

Classes 9 - 13 and 19 - 23 reconnaissance is not allowed. If competitor from these classes (or their representative) is met from route will they be excluded from the event. Organizer at any point during rally is allowed to check competitors car and personal belongins (also mobile phones) for possible pacenotes to found. Penalties from these offences are stated in ASN Regulations.

14. During Rally

Start times can be found from official notice board.

GPS Tracking device must be fitted in rally car during entire rally.

GPS device is given during administrative check (reconnaissance classes) or 1 hour before start time (classes without reconnaissance). GPS devices are given from Rally Office.

TimeControl cards are included in Roadbook.

Section 1 starts on Friday at 18:01 for car number 1. Car number 2 18:02,...

Organizer has the right to extend start time gaps between drivers.





















Section 1 start is not under Parc Fermé regulations, drivers are allowed to access Section 1 start area 10 -20 minutes before their start time. Retirement competitors are allowed to start on Section 2 by the permission of Clerk of the Course and Scrutineer Manager.

Competitor must inform Rally Office if they will not start on Section 2. This information must be given before Friday 4th of marc at 23:30.

Super Rally penalties are +5min + fastest class time for Stage by class. If competitor retires on the last liasion on Saturday, time penalty of 5 minute is added to total time.

All retirements from Friday must bring car to scrutineering on Saturday morning at 7:10. Accepted scrutineering is needed for Section 2.

Retirements on Section 1 must return GPS-tracking device to rally office if they are not capable to continue on Saturday.

Section 1 includes three Time Controls with EAA (Early Arrival Allowed) 2C, 2D and 2E.

Overnight – Parc Fermé

Overnight Parc Fermé is located at Kuopio market square parking hall at: Puijonkatu 27, 70110 Kuopio. Parking hall level 3. Parc Fermé is guarded during the night.

GPS-tracking devices must be shut down during night.

Because of the timetable, cars must be brought with rally tires fitted to overnight Parc Fermé.

Section 2

Start list equals as Section 1.Clerk of the Course can redeploy retirement drivers start lists from Section 1 for Section 2.

First competitor start time for Section 2 is 08:01 on Saturday. Competitors can entry Parc Fermé 10 minutes in advance before their start time.

TC 6C – TC 6D regroupping 40 min, service 50 min. TC 6C – TC 6D maximum of 90 min and minimum 50 min. TC 6C service out time is marked to confirm arrival for TC 6D.

Competitors after rally finish are informed by organizer for podium ceremonies. Prizes are given on podium by conditional results. Finish TC is EAA.

Section 2 TC 9C is EAA.

Road Book instructions must be followed by the risk of excluding from event by the decision of Clerk of the Course.

Competitor crew must held mobile phone switched ON during entire rally in the risk of an accident. This mobilephone number must be provided to Rally Office before Section 1 start.

Speeding during rally, stated by police or organizer will lead to penalty as mentioned in ASN Regulations and Police.

Timetable is informed in Rally Guide, and part of these supplementary regulations.

Competitors must book scrutineering time from https://slotti.fi/booking/rallism/ during 25.2.2022 at 8:00 -28.2.2022 at 20:00.

Safety Scrutineering ends 10 minutes after last time available to book.

If competitor is forced to change scrutineering time after time earlier mentioned, please contact Scrutineering Manager: Riikka Raatikainen, p. +358 503598510 only during evening.

Fee of 50€ is charged if time must be changed. Fee is also charged if competitor will not attend for time booked.

TC is located at Sahakatu 2, and competitor or their representative must arrive 10 minutes in advance to the time booked.

Personal equipments must be checked 10 minutes before booked scrutineer time. Scrutineering personell informs procedures on place.

Measurement of the noise is included to safety scrutineering. Limit: max. 103 db at 3500rpm.

SEALING:

Cars without 2022 turbo sealing: Sealing must be prefitted in advance.

Final Sealing is made during safety scrutineering.

All spare parts and parts that require sealing are sealed during scrutineering.





















CHANGING OF SEALED PART:

If sealed part(s) need to be changed during rally (Turbo or pop off valve), please contact Scrutineering manager Riikka Raatikainen, p. +358 503598510.

RETIREMENTS ON SECTION 1:

Safety Scrutineering before start of Section 2 is held on Parc Fermé on Saturday morning, starting 07:10.

Address Puijonkatu 27, 70110 Kuopio (Kuopio Market Square Parking, level 3)

Scrutineering is required to start Section 2.

16. Service

Rally includes two seperate service areas with three possibilities of service, located at: Savitie 189, 70870 Kuopio (Service A and Service C) and Luostarintie 15, 71210 Tuusjärvi for Service B) Further information (maps etc.) are defined in Rally Guide.

Regroupping before SERVICE C (FLEX-service).

Service schedule:

- SERVICE A (60 min) after TC 2C. TC 2D After service -> TC 2E for overnight Parc Fermé.
- SERVICE B service time included TC 3B TC 4A liasion max time.
- SERVICE C (90 min) regroupping 40 min, service time 50 min FLEX-service. Arrival TC 6C. Competitors in classes 1-13 can start service time by their decision and mark service time beginning to timecontrol card and place that on top of the windscreen. Also A4 sized sign must be placed outside of service area highly visible. No further markings to timecontrol card. Servicetime / timecontrol cards are monitored by organizer. Organization delegates must have free access to any service area. Classes 14 – 23 are free service entire time.

Further information about services can be found from Rally Guide, which is part of rally regulations.

All specific wishes for Service Park arrangement must be sent by email: raisu37@gmail.com, latest on Friday 25th of February. After that, fee of 200€ is charged.

Service cars must include 6 kg fire extinguisher (for each Rally car), which meets FIA regulations for service are usage. Also oil leak protection carpet and under rally car tarpaulin to block all leaking liquid. These requirements include all equipments using any type of fuel.

Penalties for offences at Service Park:

1st Offence: 300€

2nd Offence: 600€

3rd Offence: Exclude from the event by the decision of Clerk of the Course
