4. GENERAL INFORMATION

This Rally will be run in compliance with the effective National Sporting Regulations, Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2024 and FIXUS SM RALLI KITEE Supplementary Regulations, which AKK Motorsport has approved with Visa 23/R/24. The Supplementary Regulations are also published in English, in case of any dispute, the Finnish version is determinative.

Rally day is 5.10.2024. Total distance of the itinerary is approx. 315 km including 10 Special Stages. Distance of the Special Stages is approx. 105 km in total.

If a driver or his / her Delegate is met prior to his starting time on the roads used as Special Stages in Rally and marked yellow, gray or black or unmarked roads in the road map of Finland in the areas of Kitee and Tohmajärvi, the competitor will be prohibited to participate in the Rally. Reconnaissance for classes 1-8 and 10-15 according to Supplementary Regulations Art.11 is excluded from this.

The competitor is responsible for insuring the car with an insurance towards third parties which is also valid on Special Stages.

The official time of the event is the Official Finnish time, which can be founded at <https://time.is/>. The Virtual Official Notice Board includes the link to the official time.

The Rally follows the regulations of the Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports (FINCIS), which can be founded at suek.fi, and the legislation regarding doping.

The international Time Card and national turning signs (see below) are used in the Rally.

6. ENTRY

Everyone, who wants to participate in FIXUS SM RALLI KITEE, needs to register via KITI portal at the latest on 23.9.2024 klo 18:00, or ask secondary registration instructions from Secretary of the Rally.

Foreign competitors register via entry form which is available at KITI portal and Sportity app. The entry form needs to be returned at the latest on 23.9.2024 at 18:00.

The competitor must inform the organizer about fuel used and the type of refueling. Via KITI portal registration, please use the additional information box. International competitors are required to indicate fuel type and refueling method in the electronic entry form.

By the order of entries, 200 first crews who did the registration according to the rules are accepted to the rally. Possible elimination is performed from other classes than Finnish rally championship and Suomi Cup.

In case there are less than three (3) crews entered in any of the classes 8–20, the organizer may merge such class with another class.

Use of competitor's information by the organizer:

When registering to the event, the competitor agrees with the processing of the given personal data by the organizer and publication of the specified information (name, club etc.) in the entry list, results and communication of the event.

License number of the 1st driver must be used as Reference number.

Entry fee will be refunded in full to candidates whose entry has not been accepted, in case the competitor cancels their participation before the closing date for entries, or in case the rally is not taking place. In case the competitor cancels their participation by 28.9.2024 at 18:00, the entry fee will be returned, but 50 € administrative fee will be reserved. Cancelling participation should always be done via email to sari.haurinen@gmail.com.

8. SERVICE

The service park is located in Competition Centre, Aimontie 47, 82380 Tolosenmäki, service is allowed only in the service park. There are 2 services during the event, 1 service and 1 regroup. The service times are provided in the Rally Programme.

The Organizer reserves every crew a service space 6 x 8 m or as defined in the FRC SR.

Should a joint service space be requested, a written request (with the dimensions of the area) must reach the organiser via email by 2.10.2024 at 21:00. Please contact: Jari Hiltunen, +358 505539963, jari.hiltunen@tikkala.fi.

A fee €150/ crew is charged if the request comes after 2.10.2024 at 21:00. The Organizer has the right to refuse the request for service space.

Service vehicles must be equipped with a **fire extinguisher** appropriate for extinguishing flammable fluids and with an **oilspill kit** ready for use at any time (FRC art. 14.5) Under the rally car there must be a **fluidproof tarpaulin** at least the size of the rally car to prevent oil spillage. The competition center is located in ground-water province, so there must be a fluidproof tarpaulin under the service vehicles' possible oil spillage areas (motor, transmission, hydraulics). The absence of any of these will result in the immediate decision of the Clerk of the Course to exclude competitor from the competition.

Flex service during the regroup according to Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2024

The service area does not have parking facilities for pre-check-in cars, but they are taken to the trailer park in the immediate vicinity of the service area.

Violations related to maintenance time (too early start of maintenance or exceeding of maintenance time) will be sanctioned in accordance with section 14.10 of the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2024.

Penalties for other violations in the service and refueling area:

1st offense 300€

2nd offense 600€

3rd offence of exclusion from competition by decision of the competition director.

9. TYRES

In classes 1-6 competitors are permitted to use 10 tyres (10 pcs) according to the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2024.

Tyre code form must be submitted electronically to rallismkatsastus@gmail.com before Friday 4.10.2024 at 19:00.

Email Subject line must include competition number and name of the 1st Driver.

Marking the tyres and inspections take place in accordance with the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations.

Tyre code form is available on Sportity Virtual Official Notice Board and KITI system.

In the tyre code form must be listed: barcode/FIA-code, mark and model of the tyres (for example Michelin M80, Pirelli K4). If the competitor has tyres with no FIA barcodes or the code is only on one side of the tyre, please contact The Chief Scrutineer a day before the pre-event scrutineering at the latest.

In other classes the number of tyres is not limited.

10. REFUEL

All classes will refuel on the route according to the road book at the gas stations (E95, E98 and diesel).

The Competitors with cars using other permitted fuels can refuel from their own containers at separate refueling area at the Competition center and at Neste gas station.

11. RECONNAISSANCE

Starting 4.10 2024 at 7:30 a.m., competitors can collect the reconnaissance material from the safety scrutineering site Veekmas Oy, Tolosentie 3, 82380 Tolosenmäki. When confirming receipt of the material, the competitor must provide the organizer with information about his/her pre-acquainted car and his/her phone number.

When searching for competitor material, the identity document (official identity card, driver's license, passport, etc.) is checked.

It is enough for one of the competitors to pick up the materials.

The two (2) reconnaissance car IDs given by the organizer must be attached to the windshield in the middle up and the right rear side window and must be visible throughout the reconnaissance period.

During reconnaissance, a speed limit of 80 km/h is in force for all special stages, unless the speed with traffic signs or signs set by the organizer is even lower than this. The mode of driving must be such that it does not endanger or disturb

other traffic or nearby settlements. The organizer forbids driving against the direction of the special stage. The organizer performs speed and driving mode monitoring during reconnaissance. The police also carry out checks on the route and punish traffic violations in accordance with the Road Traffic Act.

Competitors are obliged to stop if requested so by officials with organizers' logos at the risk of denying the right of departure.

The reconnaissance period starts on 4.10. 2024 at 8:00 a.m. and ends on 4.10 2024 at 18:00. The reconnaissance car is only allowed to have 1st and 2nd drivers participating in the race.

Reconnaissance for the route is allowed with the following restrictions: **SS 4 reconnaissance 4.10.2024 from 15:00 to 18:00.**

Reconnaissance two (2) times per special stage, also applies to twice-run special stages.

GPS tracking devices are distributed in connection with the distribution of reconnaissance material and must be in use throughout the reconnaissance period. The competitor must reserve a USB power supply for the monitoring equipment in their reconnaissance car and keep the device connected throughout the reconnaissance. After prior acquaintance, before the competitor's start time for race part 1, the competitor must transfer the GPS tracking device to their race car.

The reconnaissance vehicle identifiers must be removed immediately after the reconnaissance has ended. Cars used for reconnaissance must not be parked in the service areas of the competition after the reconnaissance has ended. A fine of €100 is imposed for the violation. If the violations are repeated, the Finnish Rally Officials have the opportunity to issue an additional sanction.

12. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

Competition number stickers are according to Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2024.

Windscreen advertisement (FRC Regulations 2024): Plus Katsastus
Classes 8–20 Windscreen advertising is free.

Competition number stickers on doors must be placed so that the number is towards the front of the car.

Competition numbers and other stickers are part of the competition materials. Stickers must be in their correct places before the safety scrutineering. The competitor is responsible of fixing the stickers properly.

13. PRE-EVENT SCRUTINEERING

Pre-event scrutineering will take place in Veekmas Oy, Tolosentie 3, 82380 Tolosenmäki
Scrutineering starts on Friday 4.10.2024 at 16:00 and on Saturday 5.10.2024 at 8:00

Documents for scrutineering must be submitted by email to rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi by 2.10.2024 at 18:00.

The following documents are required:

- Inspection card, page 1 and page 2
- First page of Homologation certificate or passport (V-, R-Lite, Historic or F-group national passport)
- Condition inspection certificate or certificate of an approved annual inspection
- Race car transfer permit / registration extract
- Safety cage classification certificate or certificate, 1st page
- 1st page of the catalyst certificate
- Tyre bar code (NB! Tyre code form must be submitted electronically to rallismkatsastus@gmail.com at the latest on Friday 4.10.2024 at 19:00)

Email Subject line must include competition number and the name of the 1st Driver!

In connection with the safety inspection, the noise level of the racing car is checked, which may be a maximum of 103db at 3500rpm.

The competitor or his delegate must check in at the scrutineering area (Veekmas Oy, Tolosentie 3, 82380 Tolosenmäki) 10 minutes before their scrutineering time, when car's presence on time is recorded.

Every contestant must book their scrutineering time in advance online at <https://slotti.fi/booking/rallism/>
Online booking is open between 26.9.2024 at 12:00 – 1.10.2024 at 18:00.

Sealing

The spare parts to be sealed and registered for the competition are inspected and, if necessary, sealed during the safety inspection.

Changing the sealed part during the race

If the competitor wishes to replace a sealed part (turbochargers or a FIA pop-off valve), the competitor must make a report by phone to the Head of Scrutineering Petri Karppinen puh. +358400014081

Pre-event scrutineering ends 10 minutes after the end of the last scrutineering time.

If the competitor wants to change their scrutineering time after the booking system has closed, please contact the Assistant Head of Scrutineering Juha Pykäläinen +358505204125

For the change of time, event organizer will charge a fee of €50.

14. SHAKEDOWN STAGE

There is no Shakedown Stage in the competition.

15. COMPETITION MATERIALS

Each crew will receive following competition materials at Veekmas Oy, Tolosentie 3, 82380 Tolosenmäki (Safety scrutineering place). One member of the crew can receive the materials, proof of identification must be shown (Passport, Driving license, official ID-card etc.)

Starting on Friday 4.10.2024 at 7:30

Competitors in classes 1–8 and 10–15: one road book describing the rally route in detail, two route maps, competition numbers and a GPS safety tracking device.

Starting on Saturday 5.10.2024 at 7:00

Competitors in classes 9 and 16–20: road book describing the rally route in detail, two route maps, competition numbers and a GPS safety tracking device,

Competitors in all classes will receive the timing transponders in connection of the safety scrutineering.

16. START AND VIRTUAL CHICANES

16.1 START

The start list will be published on Ajaksi-online, the Finnish Rally Championship website

www.rallism.fi and the Virtual Official Notice Board, Sportity code **SMKITEE24**, according to the program.

The international timecard is used in the competition and competitors receive it at the start of the competition at Kiteentie 14, 82500 Kitee. The departure takes place every minute from 9:01.

The competitor must follow the competition route assigned by the organizer throughout the competition. Failure to follow the competition route always results in disqualification from the competition.

16.2 VIRTUAL CHICANES

According to the permit conditions of Centre for Economic Development, Transport and the Environment (ELY Centre), there are two (2) virtual chicanes on the route. Precise instructions will be provided in Rally Guide.

17. TIME CARDS

The international timecard is used in the competition and competitors receive it at the start of the competition. Instructions on how to use the card can be found in the Rally Guide.

18. REGROUPS

There is one (1) regroup on the route. Time of the regroup is informed in the Rally Programme.

19. SPECIAL REGULATIONS

On Saturday 5.10.2024 there is a **meet and greet area** for interviews, autographs etc. after Time Control 3A. Rally car is taken to service by the competitor's service personnel.
