1. Clerk of the Course's Welcome

Welcome to Jyväskylä, the city known as the home of rallying!

The Finnish Rally Championship has never before visited Jyväskylä under summer conditions. The last time Finnish Championship points were contested here was in 2023, when the event was the Winter Rally, won by Jari Huttunen.

Now we are all facing something new: a renewed organization, a new route, a new rally HQ at Jyväskylä Paviljonki, and a new Start/Finish location at Jyväskylä Harbour.

Renewal and doing things in our own way are part of our identity. We do not simply follow what others do; instead, we organize the event in a way that we believe is meaningful for the sport, the competitors, and our officials. This helps us maintain our own enthusiasm while also striving to develop the event as a whole.

Change also brings challenges, and there will undoubtedly be a few bumps along the way. Therefore, I ask everyone for patience, especially in the Rally HQ area, as we know it will be extremely popular and, at times, crowded during the event.

The main themes of our rally have been safety, the route, and the rally headquarters.

I hope these priorities are also visible to everyone attending the event. Together with the authorities, we have developed an entirely new approach to safety management and documentation. This is a pilot project, and we hope its benefits can eventually be implemented throughout the country.

The route has always been important to us, and this year we are presenting what may be the slowest and most technical summer route of the Finnish Rally Championship in this century. As much as 75% of the route is run on private roads, allowing us to introduce greater challenges while maintaining more moderate average speeds and, naturally, enhancing safety.

The rally headquarters at Jyväskylä Paviljonki is familiar from the FIA World Rally Championship events and has proven to be an excellent venue. Managing the Paviljonki area requires an enormous amount of work from our organization, but for once the rally event is truly at the heart of the city and among the public.

At the same time, the Paviljonki area will also host the Beer Harbour Festival from Thursday to Saturday and the Finnish Cheerleading Championships on Saturday and Sunday. Approximately 10,000 people are expected to visit the area, most of whom are not there solely because of the rally.

Underlying all of this is the cooperation and mutual trust between our clubs.

We are organizing this event together with Korpilahden Urheiluautoilijat ry and Jyväskylän Urheiluautoilijat ry. No one can succeed alone anymore, but together we can achieve great things.

On behalf of the Jyväskylä Finnish Rally Championship Rally and the entire public event, I warmly welcome you to Jyväskylä.

5. Before the Event

5.1 Trailer Park and Recce Vehicles

It is prohibited to bring trailers or recce vehicles into the Paviljonki Service Park or the Start/Finish area at Jyväskylä Harbour.

The Organizer's Trailer Park is located at the gravel area of Killeri, at following address:

Sykeraitti 2, Jyväskylä

Please note that the area will not be guarded by the Organizer during the event. Therefore, all participants are strongly advised to use trailer locks and take appropriate security measures.

Recce vehicles may also be parked in the Killeri area.

5.2 Service Park

A Service Park layout has been published in Sportity. During the event week, a more detailed map will be released, showing each competitor's individually assigned and numbered service area.

All service operations for the rally will be located at the Jyväskylä Paviljonki area:

Lutakonaukio 12, Jyväskylä

Service durations and the operation of regrouping areas are described in the Supplementary Regulations.

The Service Park is located in the immediate vicinity of downtown Jyväskylä. During the rally, the area will also host the Beer Harbour Festival and the Finnish Cheerleading Championships. As these events are being organized in cooperation with one another, we kindly ask all members of the rally community to show patience, consideration, and respect for cleanliness throughout the area.

Within and immediately adjacent to the Service Park, competitors and visitors will find:

- Rally Kiosk services
- Hot Dog catering services
- Restaurant services
- A K-Market grocery store

Service Areas Allocated to Competitors

- **Finnish Rally Championship classes:** 8 × 10 m
- **Estonian Rally Championship classes:** 8 × 9 m
- **Other classes:** 8 × 6 m

If competitors are using service tents, all ballast weights must be secured in such a way that they cannot become detached. Tent installations must comply with the requirements set out in the **TUKES Tent Anchoring Guidelines 2025**.

The Rally Headquarters area also provides:

- Toilets
- Changing facilities
- Shower facilities

Competitors and teams may purchase additional electrical power for their service area. Please refer to the instructions in the Sportity application for details on ordering electricity.

5.3 Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance is permitted in accordance with the Supplementary Regulations for classes 1–25.

Reconnaissance schedule:

- **Special Stages 2–7:** Friday, 12 June, from 07:00 to 17:00
- **Special Stage 1:** Friday, 12 June, from 14:00 to 17:00

After completing reconnaissance, competitors must remove the reconnaissance sticker issued by the Organizer from their recce vehicle as soon as possible.

Information About the Special Stages

Sections of the special stages have previously been used in national rally events and in WRC Secto Rally Finland. However, none of the special stages have ever been run in their current configuration.

5.4 Pre-event Scrutineering

Pre-event Scrutineering will take place in **Hall C1 of Jyväskylä Paviljonki**, located at:

Lutakonaukio 12, Jyväskylä

Please arrive at Pre-event Scrutineering well in advance of your assigned time slot.

Remember that the competition car must be equipped with all required safety equipment in accordance with the regulations, and all safety equipment must be in proper working condition and free from damage.

IMPORTANT!

The Pre-event Scrutineering schedule for Friday has been changed from that published in the Supplementary Regulations.

6. Materials Distribution

Competitor materials will be distributed at the Rally Office, located at:

Jyväskylä Paviljonki

The distribution schedule is in accordance with the Supplementary Regulations.

Distribution of Reconnaissance Materials and Competitor Packages (Classes 1–25)

- **Thursday, 11 June 2026:** 18:00–21:00, or
- **Friday, 12 June 2026:** 07:00–09:00

Distribution of Competitor Packages (Classes 26–31)

- **Saturday, 13 June 2026:** 08:00–10:30

Each crew will receive:

- A Road Book detailing the route to be followed
- Two (2) route maps
- A GPS tracking device
- Reconnaissance vehicle identification stickers
- All competition number decals for the rally car
- The required championship windshield sticker

The following advertising will be added to the competition door numbers:

MELTEX

Both crew members must be present at material distribution and must present either a valid driving licence or an official identity document.

The timing transponder will be distributed at the Start Area before the competitor's scheduled start time.

7. Virtual Chicane / Speed Reduction Zone

A Virtual Speed Reduction Zone will be in operation on Special Stage 6.

The location of the zone is marked in the stage 100 metres before its beginning with warning signs. The start of the zone is indicated by large green signs on both sides of the road, and the end of the zone is marked by red signs.

Throughout the entire 100-metre-long zone, competitors must comply with a maximum speed limit of **60 km/h**.

Two speed display boards will be positioned within the zone, allowing competitors to monitor their speed in real time. Compliance will be supervised by a Judge of Fact appointed by the Clerk of the Course, who will report any speeding violations.

Penalties for Speeding

- Speeds exceeding **60 km/h**: **2 seconds per each km/h over the limit**
- Speeds exceeding **70 km/h**: **3 seconds per each km/h over the limit**

Example:

A recorded speed of **67 km/h** results in an excess speed of 7 km/h.

Penalty: **7 × 2 seconds = 14 seconds time penalty.**

Speeding violations may be verified using the speed display boards located within the stage and/or GPS speed data from the competitor's tracking system.

The Virtual Speed Reduction Zone has been implemented at the request of the landowner and is intended to protect the bridge located at this section of the route.

8. Time Card

An International Time Card system will be used during the event.

The event officials will complete and record all entries on the competitors' time cards.

9. Refuelling

Refuelling is permitted only at the fuel stations indicated in the Road Book or within the Refuelling Zones designated by the Organizer.

Refuelling from cans is permitted only in the area specifically designated for can refuelling, located near the Service Park and marked in the Road Book.

Refuelling distances and locations have been calculated and indicated in the Itinerary.

10. Message from the Route Manager

The rally route has been designed to be slow, technical, and demanding.

If you are uncertain about your pace notes, or if you have not completed reconnaissance, exercise particular caution and maintain a sensible pace. The route contains several unexpected jumps, crests, and tightening corners that are not marked on the road.

Please drive accordingly and remain alert throughout the event.

11. Retirement on Friday – Section 1 of the Rally

If you retire during the first section of the rally on Friday, the Organizer will assume that you intend to restart and continue the event on Saturday.

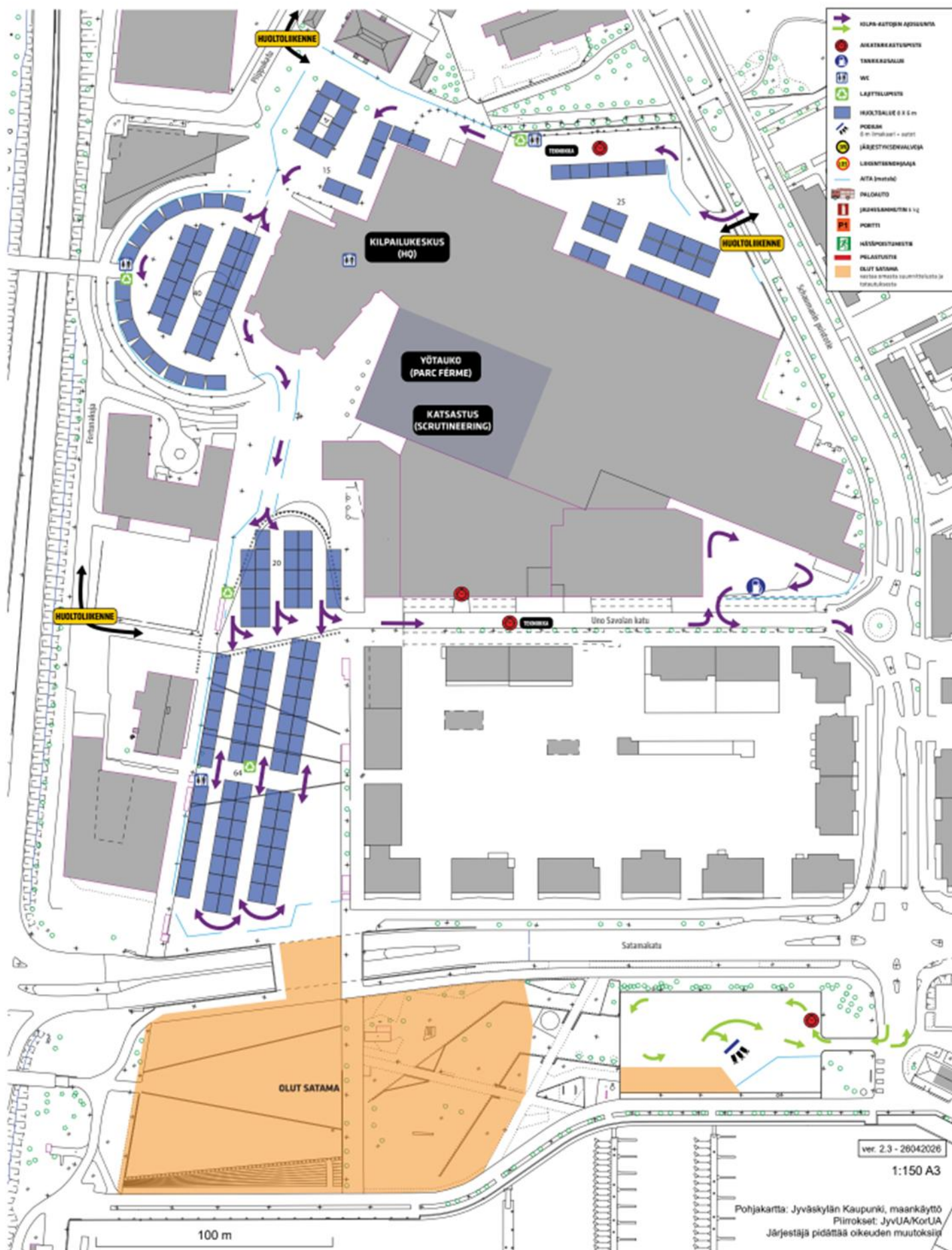

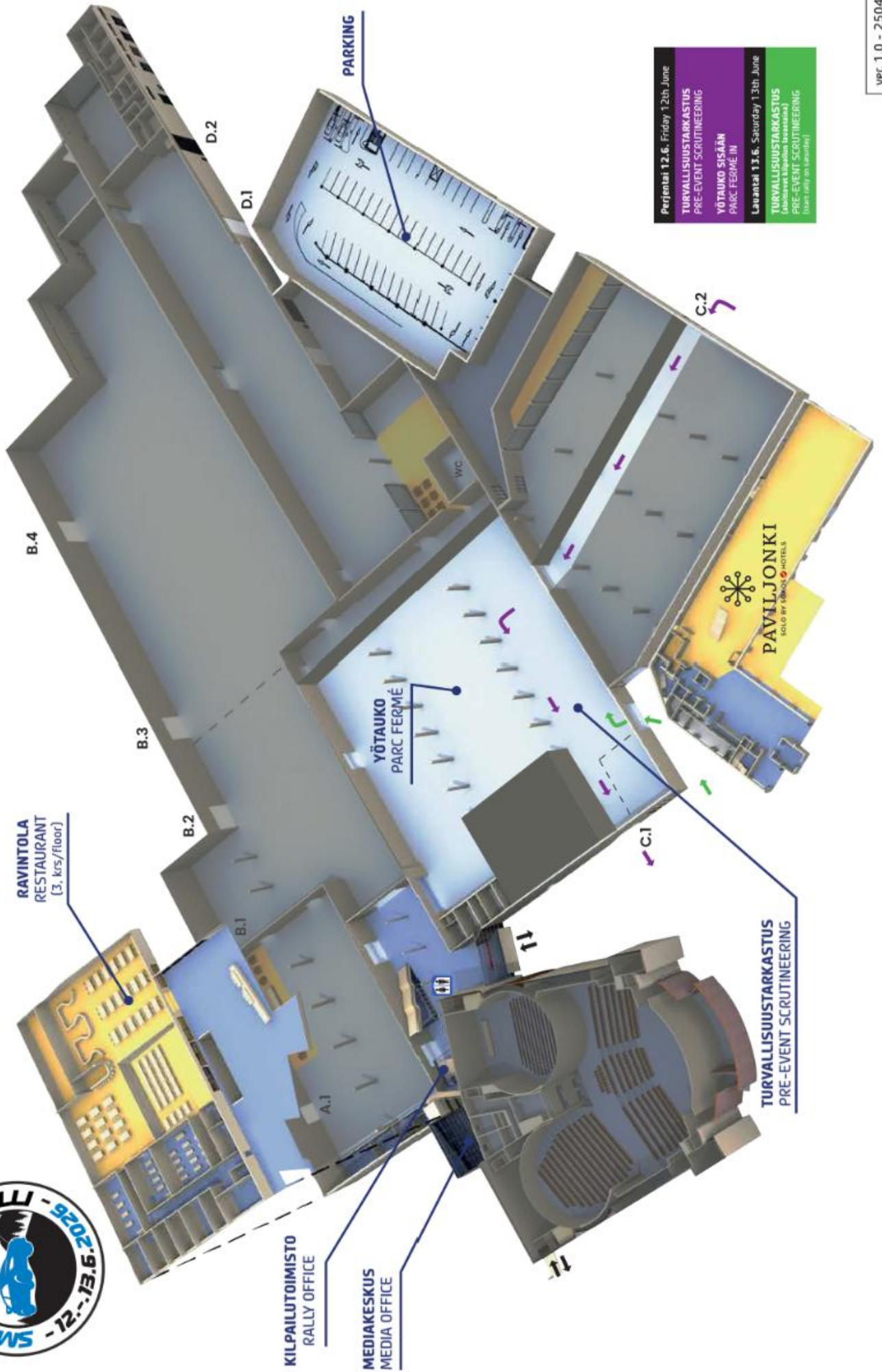
If you retire on Friday and already know that you will not be able to continue in the event, please inform the Organizer as soon as possible.



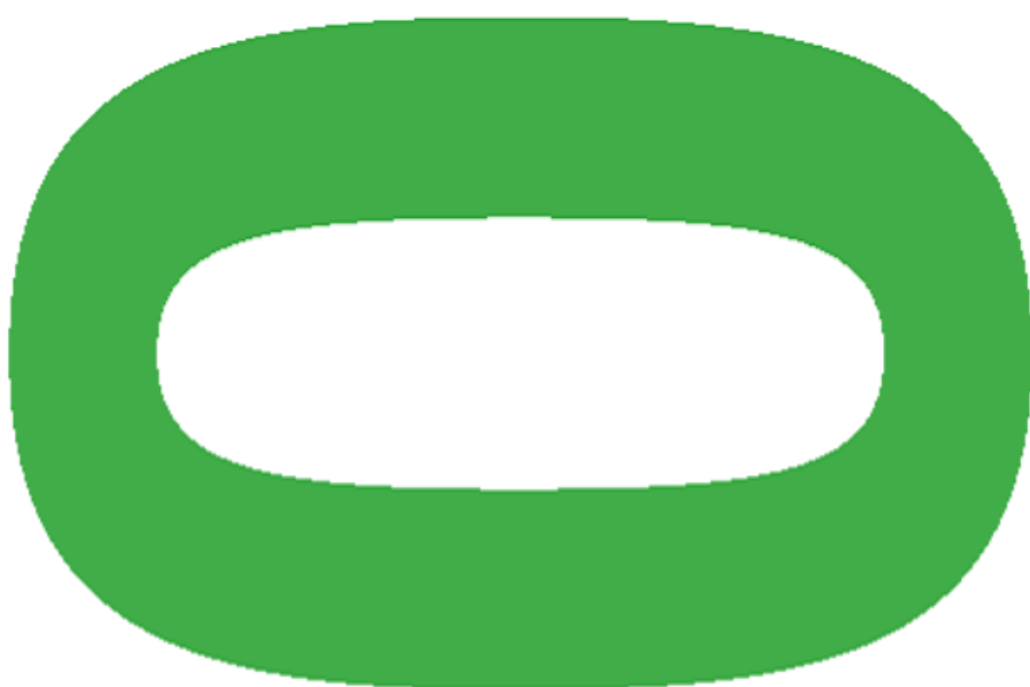
