### 4. OVERVIEW

The rally will be held in accordance with the current AKK Rally Rules, as well as these HYAcenter Rally Rules, which have been approved by AKK Motorsport under license number 19278/RA/26

The total length of the rally is 172 km including 4 special stages with a total length of about 50 km.

If a competitor or someone acting on their behalf is met on the route in the area of the following municipalities or cities: Lempäälä, Kangasala, Valkeakoski on the yellow, grey, black or unmarked roads on the Finnish roadmap before competitor's start time, the competitor will be denied the right to participate in the competition.

Competitors in classes 1–11 are allowed to familiarise themselves with the route on Saturday 4.7.2026 at 8.00–10.30

Turn arrows are used in the competition, the direction of travel at the intersection is indicated by the direction of the arrow tip.

The competition follows the regulations of the Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports (FINCIS), which can be found in the [suek.fi](http://suek.fi), as well as the legislation on doping.

## 6. COMPETITORS

HYAcenter Rally is open to competitors who have a national, junior, junior class or international competitor license granted by AKK, taking into account the examination regulations.

## 7. REGISTRATION

Everyone who wants to participate in HYAcenter Rally must register through the KITI system or ask the race secretary for secondary registration instructions.

In HYAcenter rally classes where there is no pre-familiarization, another crew member may have an introductory license. In this case, one of the crew members must have a valid national or international competitor license and a completed junior rally examination. Both instructors must be at least 18 years old. The introductory license is purchased and paid for on site when registering. Payment 33 € in cash (exact money)

80 competitors who have registered in accordance with the rules will be accepted to the competition in the order of registration. Pruning is carried out from grades 12–22 excl. Häme region 5 competitors will not be eliminated.

A minimum of 3 starters/class is required for the classes. If the number of entries is smaller, the competitors in that class can be combined with another class.

Seats and seat belts that comply with FIA standards may be used in the race, the validity date of which is not prescriptive. The condition of these must be first-class. Competitors must have all the riding equipment that complies with the rules (HANS, helmet, driving suit, underwear + socks, shoes, gloves for 1 driver).

### Use of competitor data by the competition organiser:

By registering for the competition, the competitor agrees to the processing of the personal data provided by the competition organiser and the publication of specified personal data (name, club, etc.) in the list of participants, results, etc. in the communication of the competition.

The above-mentioned information and photos taken by the organizer can be used in the communications of the HYAcenter Rally.

The paper inspection is done electronically. The competitor must fill in the forms found in the KITI competition service under "Attachments" under "Attachments" ("Maintenance contact information" and "Announcer information" and "Familiarization time information" form for those who are previewed) and the necessary documents scanned; registration certificate/transfer permit, inspection card (both pages), classification certificate/V1600 passport/Historical passport (front page), (notifier license if necessary) and send them to the competition organizer by 28.6.2026 at 22:00 by email to [pr.rallit@gmail.com](mailto:pr.rallit@gmail.com) . The documents must be clearly scanned and named.

If the forms are submitted after the above-mentioned time, they will not be checked but must be taken with you and presented at the time of registration.

Once the competitor has registered through KITI, he assures that all paperwork is in order and in accordance with the motorsport rules. Instructor 1 and instructor of youth class 2 are obliged to report if they have lost their right to drive after registering.

## 8. PARTICIPATION FEES

The entry fees are as follows: All classes 250 €

The registration and participation fee must be received by the organizer by 23.6.2026 at 23.59 at the latest.

The 1st instructor's license number **must be used as the reference number**.

The participation fee includes the transponder fee. If a pair of competitors does not return the transponder undamaged to the organizer after the competition, the competitor in question will have to return the transponder undamaged. a pair of competitors to pay the competition organiser its price (200 €).

## 9. MAINTENANCE

Service vehicles must have a competitor-specific fire extinguisher of at least 6 kg (new or inspected) and an oil absorption mat ready for use. Under the service car and the racing car, a cover that is impermeable to liquids at least the size of its bottom area. The absence / inadequacy of any of the above will lead to an immediate decision by the competition director to disqualify from the competition.

The competition will use the maintenance / break area, which is located at: Ideapark, Ideaparkintie 4, 37570 Lempäälä

The area will be visited after SS 2 and it is included in the transition period (maintenance time approx. 20 min).

The organizer will reserve a 7.5 m x 10 m service area for each competitor. One service vehicle per competitor pair is allowed in the service area. There is a speed limit of 20 km/h in the service area,

If you need space for a larger service vehicle, please contact Tommi Wirtanen, who is in charge of the service area, by 29.6.2026 about possible exceptional arrangements. After this, the organizer will charge a fee of 100 euros for the arrangements.

## 10. REFUELING

Refuelling during the race is only allowed in the areas marked in the road book (refuelling area) and on the route from the distribution equipment of the service stations marked in the road book (more details in the competitor instructions).

Refuelling elsewhere during the competition is prohibited.

Racing cars that use 98E, E85 and 2 t fuel, and those racing cars that can run on FIA racing gasoline according to Appendix J of the rulebook, can be refueled from their own separate container, (poured into the fuel tank or pumped). This refueling point is indicated in the road book, (at the gas station near the metering station).

If violations of the rules regarding refueling are detected, it will lead to immediate disqualification from the competition by the decision of the race director.

## 11. RECCE

On Saturday 4.7.2026 at 7.15 a.m., competitors can pick up the introductory material from the competition office. When acknowledging receipt of the material, the competitor must provide the organizer with information about their introductory car and phone number.

The two (2) familiarisation car identifiers given by the organiser must be attached to the windshield in the middle up and to the right rear side window and they must be visible throughout the tour.

During the reconnaissance of the route, a speed limit of 80 km/h is in force on all special stages, unless the speed is set even lower by traffic signs or signs placed by the organizer in the terrain. The driving style must be such that it does not endanger or disturb other traffic or nearby residential areas. The organiser will carry out speed and driving style control during the familiarisation period. The police also carry out surveillance on the route and punish traffic violations in accordance with the Road Traffic Act.

If you drive against the direction of travel on the road, take special care and follow traffic rules.

The reminder of the officials with the organizers' insignia to stop must be complied with under the threat of denial of the right to start

The pre-consultation period starts on 4.7.2026 at 8.00 a.m. and ends at 10.30 a.m.

Exploring the route is allowed with the following restrictions:

- The special stages can be explored twice.
- Any reduced speed limits in the terrain must be observed on the special stages
- Only 1st and 2nd instructors participating in the competition may be in the introductory car

#### **11.1 Speeding offence during the recce**

During the pre-reconnaissance, the race director may impose the following penalty for speeding measured by the police or the race organizer with a speed control device:

1. One time: a written reprimand and a fine of 90 €. If the violation is over 30 km/h, the race director may deny the competitor pair's right to start
2. once: the right to leave is denied

The fine received for a speed violation during the preliminary familiarization must be paid to the competition office before the competitor's own start time. Failure to pay will result in denial of the right to leave.

### **12. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING**

The competition uses competition number templates 50x50cm and the bonnet number template 50x25cm.

Advertisements are indicated in the additional order. The stickers are distributed in connection with the distribution of materials and their presence is checked during the security inspection.

### **13. START AND FINISH**

The ideal start times of the competitors will be announced according to the program on the official notice board of the competition in Sportity.

Competitors will receive a time card from the start TC.

The departure will take place on 4.7.2026 at Ideapark, Ideaparkinkatu 4, 37570 Lempäälä from 11.31 am, every minute.

The competitor must follow the competition route determined by the organizer throughout the competition. Failure to follow the competition route will always result in disqualification from the competition.

The finish line of the competition is at the Ideapark competition centre.

### **14. COMPETITOR MATERIAL**

From Saturday 4.7.2024 at 07.15, each crew will receive a road book showing the route to be followed in detail, 2 route maps, 2 door numbers, 1 bonnet advertisement and inspection card from the competition office.

The I instructor and the junior class II instructor must present a driver's license and the II instructor must present an identity document (photo a valid identity document, e.g. driver's license).

### **15. BREAKS**

There is no break in the competition.

### **16. SAFETY INSPECTION**

The safety inspection will be held on 4 July 2026 starting at 10.30 a.m. A more detailed schedule and location will be announced in the additional order.

The security check must have numbers and advertisements affixed to their places.

The safety check ends on 4.7.2026 10 minutes after the last race number.

The cars must have a valid Finnish motor liability insurance, a valid inspection (normal or racing car), and license plates/red plates are valid.

## **17. RESULTS**

The conditional results will be published by class according to the schedule according to the competitor instructions on the official notice board of the competition in the Sportity application and the final official results can be found in the KIT1 system, on the competition website and in the Sportity application.

## **17. PRIZES AND AWARD CEREMONY**

The number of winners will be announced on the official notice board of the competition.

The prizes will be awarded to both instructors, Ideapark, Ideaparkinkatu 4, 37570 Lempäälä immediately after arriving at the finish line based on unofficial results.

The schedule of award ceremonies by category is indicated in the supplementary regulation.

All award-winning competitors must attend the award ceremony. For compelling reasons, permission to be absent can only be granted by the race director.
