Registration:

Last day of normal registration: Thursday 11.7 at 23.59

The depot will open on Thursday 16 July at 8.00.

Registration takes place via the Surveypal link (<https://q.surveypal.com/Crosskart-Nordic-Championship-2026-Ouluzone-18.7.2026>) Finnish competitors register through the KITI system.

Schedule:

Friday 17.7.2026

The course is open for free practice by class according to a separate schedule from 9:00 to 19:00.

Registration at the competition venue: 8.00–21.00

Scruteering: 15.00–20.00

Drivers must wear a driving suit during the scruteering.

Saturday 18.7.2026

Jury meeting at 8.00 a.m.

Drivers meeting at 8.30 a.m. in the start area.

Race start at 9:00 a.m.

All drivers must be present in the start area, grouped by category for the national anthem.

Jury meeting 15 minutes after the last start.

The competition starts at 09.00 according to a separate schedule.

The finals start after the lunch break.

Award ceremony about 30 minutes after the final final. Drivers must wear driving suits.

Participants

The competition is open to drivers who have a Swedish, Nordic or former CNC country crosskart driving license.

The organizer may reject registrations made after Thursday 16 July.

Categories

Mini, Class 1 (85/150), Xtreme Junior, Class 2 (125/250), Class 3 (250/450), Class 4 (650), 50+ (650) and Xtreme.

Permitted vehicles, technical regulations and tyres

Driver's license according to the country's ASN Crosskart technical rules.

Noise measurement

Vehicles must meet two different noise measurement requirements:

1. Stationary test: The microphone is placed 2 meters from the exhaust pipe at an angle of 45 degrees and 1.35 meters from the ground. The throttle is gradually increased until the engine reaches full rpm. The maximum is 110 dB(A).
2. Drive-by measurement: The microphone is placed 10 meters away from the driving car and 1.35 meters from the ground. The measurement is taken at full throttle during the pass-by. The maximum is 95 dB(A).

OuluZone has strict noise rules set by the local authority, repeated violations will result in disqualification from the competition.

Paid at the course when registering either by card or even in cash with exact money.

Objections

All objections must be submitted in writing to the Clerk of the course and paid (300€) either by card or even in cash with exact change.

Electricity

An electricity pitch can be purchased for €40 for the whole weekend as long as there are places available.

Depot

When registering, drivers must indicate the pit space they need and any wishes to park together with others. OuluZone hopes that drivers who park together will arrive at the track at the same time.

Cancellation of a competition

The organizer can decide together with AKK to cancel the competition in a force majeure situation or if the number of participants is not enough to achieve championship status.

If the competition is cancelled, all registered drivers must be notified at least 24 hours before the start of registration at the competition venue.

Advertising

ASN or organizer advertisements on vehicles may be made mandatory. You can't get rid of advertising by paying. If the ASN or the organiser exercises their right to advertise, the stickers will be distributed at the time of registration and must be applied before the inspection.

Awards

In the Mini class, all participants will be rewarded with trophies.

In all other classes, the 3 best drivers of the A-Final will be awarded with trophies.
