4. INTRODUCTION

This rally will be run in compliance with AKK's, Historic Rally Trophy's, VW Aircooled Rally Series', BMW Ralli Series' regulations and these Supplementary Regulations.

These regulations have been accepted by ASN Motorsport with a licence number 19031/RA/26.

Total length of the route is 160 kms, including five (5) special stages with total length of 62 kms.

If a driver or his/her delegate is met prior to his starting time on the roads used as Special Stages in Rally, marked yellow, gray or black or unmarked roads in the road map of Finland in the areas of Kiuruvesi, the competitor will be prohibited to participate in the Rally. Reconnaissance for classes 19-24 and 41-44 is allowed during the reconnaissance period described in these Supplementary Regulations.

The cars participating the rally must comply with the technical regulations set in AKK-Motorsport Appendix J.

In the crew, the other driver may have an introduction license. In this case the other driver must have a valid international or national competitor license and rally junior examination completed, and both drivers must be at least at the age of 18 years.

The competition follows the regulations of the Finnish Sports Ethics Center (SUEK).
The regulations can be found in; suek.fi, as well as the legislation regarding doping.

6. ENTRIES

Anybody willing to participate Kiuruveden UA 60-V Juhlaralli must submit their entry via KITI-kisapalvelu system (with Finnish competitor license) or ask secondary registration instruction from the Secretary of the Rally.

Maximum 230 crew will be accepted to the rally. In the event that the number of registrations exceeds the limit, priority will be given to series competitors and drivers from AKK Region 3.

Use of competitor information by the organizer:

By entering the rally, the competitor accepts the processing of personal data provided by the organizer and the publication and inclusion of specified personal information (name, club, etc.) in the entry list, results, etc., in all organizer's communications and registers.

8. SERVICE

The route contains a service break. Service break timing will be informed in the rally schedule.

Service cars must be equipped with a fire extinguisher and an oil absorption mat at the size of engine and gearbox, and the rally car having an oil absorption mat at least the size of the car, to prevent oil spillage or liquid pillage. The absence of any of these will result in disqualification from the competition by the decision of the Clerk of the Course.

When leaving the service area, please remember to clean your own service area. Waste bins are available in the area.

9. TYRES

Tyres according to regulations in Appendix J, Article 252.6.1.

Also related to Class 25 tyres based on Regularity Rally Reries (HRRT) regulations and Finnish traffic law directions.

10. REFUELING

Refuelling is carried out at the filling stations marked in the roadbook. Refuelling from own containers will be proceeded in the filling station areas.

11. RECONNAISSANCE

On Friday 23.01.2026 at 08:00 – 10:00 competitors can collect their reconnaissance materials from Rally HQ; Kiuruvesi Culture House, Lähteentie 10 A. Upon collecting the materials, the competitor must provide the organiser with details of their reconnaissance car and their phone number.

The two (2) reconnaissance car identification stickers provided by the organiser must be fixed to the top centre of the windscreen and the rear right-hand side window, and they must remain visible throughout the reconnaissance period.

During reconnaissance and on road sections during the competition, competitors must comply with the Finnish Road Traffic Act and subordinate regulations. During reconnaissance, a speed limit of 80 km/h applies to all special stages, unless a lower speed is indicated by road signs or markers placed by the organiser. Driving behavior must not endanger or disturb other traffic or nearby residents. Driving against the direction of the special stage is strictly prohibited. The organiser will monitor speeds and driving behavior during the reconnaissance period. The police will also carry out enforcement along the route and penalize traffic violations in accordance with the Road Traffic Act.

The instructions to stop given by officials wearing official identification must be followed, under penalty of being refused permission to start.

The reconnaissance period begins on Friday 23.01.2026 at 09:00 and ends at 17:00.

Reconnaissance is permitted with the following restrictions: Courtyard areas must be taken into specific account, and driving speed must be observed."

12. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

The competition number plates used in the rally are 50 cm x 50 cm in size.

13. SCRUTINEERING

The safety inspection will be held at Kiuruveden autokatsastus, address: Valtakatu 3B, phone: +358 50 544 1215

The safety inspection begins at 08:30.

The detailed schedule for the scrutineering will be announced in the Rally Guide.

On Friday, 23.01.2026, from 18:00 to 20:00, there is an opportunity for an early scrutineering.

A time slot must be booked in advance with the Chief Scrutineer. Instructions can be found in the Rally Guide.

The scrutineering ends 10 minutes after the scheduled scrutineering time of the last competition number.

Cars must arrive at the scrutineering with road-legal tires only; **RALLY TYRES ARE PROHIBITED.**

PLEASE NOTE the racing seat and safety harnesses regulations!

In Historic Rally Trophy series as well as in National competitions outside of other championship series, cars may use seats and safety harnesses complying with FIA standards, even if their validity period has expired. The seats and harnesses must be in first-class condition, and their condition will be inspected at each event during the safety inspection (scrutineering). The event organiser must state this procedure in the supplementary regulations; otherwise, the specifications of Appendix J and its national amendments regarding safety equipment shall apply.

14. COMPETITOR MATERIALS

Each crew will receive a roadbook, detailing the route, and two (2) route maps at the competition office during registration, starting from 24 January 2026 at 07:20.

Materials distributed to competitors: Roadbook, two (2) route maps, scrutineering card, competition numbers, service car sign, two (2) transponders, and any potential bulletins.

The GPS tracking device and the timing transponder will be distributed along with the materials on Saturday, 24.01.2026. Classes participating in reconnaissance will receive their tracking devices on Friday, 23.01.2026, when collecting their materials.

In the event of retirement, return the devices to the rally headquarters.

A fee of €150 per unit will be charged for any lost tracking device or timing transponder.

15. START

The list of crews admitted to start will be published in the Sportity App, as per the official schedule.

Competitors will receive their time cards at the rally start, beginning at 10:01.

The start will take place at 10:01 at the Kiuruvesi Market Square, starting with the Regularity class, with 1-minute intervals.

Competitors must follow the official rally route defined by the organiser throughout the entire competition. Failure to comply with the route may lead to a penalty imposed by the Clerk of the Course, depending on the severity of the infringement.

16. REGROUPING

The route includes a regrouping. The times for regrouping are specified in the rally schedule.

17. RESULTS

Provisional results will be published by class on the official notice board (Sportity) according to the schedule in the Rally Guide.

The final official results will be available on the official notice board and in the KITI system.

18. PRIZES AND PRIZE-GIVING

The number of prize winners will be announced on the competition's official notice board.

The prizes are commemorative and product awards.

Prizes will be awarded to both crew members at the Finish on Kiuruvesi Market Square, by class, based on the provisional results.

The prize-giving schedule by class is informed in the Rally Guide.
