



1. General about the event

1.1 Clerk of the Course's greetings

The Rally Super Weekend is here once again. The Lahti Historic Rally and Future SM Rally will be held on the beautiful gravel roads of Southern Finland, where past and present will meet on the weekend of August 23.-24 2024.

The competition itself will start on Friday morning, and the first competitors are expected at the finish line on Saturday afternoon. Thus, the harbor will be buzzing with activity throughout the weekend.

Due to the special arrangements required for traffic and event organization, we kindly ask that you strictly follow the instructions and commands of the competition organizers, both on the route, in the service park, and in other areas affected by the competition.

A warm welcome to all in Lahti on behalf of myself and our organization.

1.2 Rally Guide

Start by reading the Supplementary Regulations, series-specific rules, and bulletins which have most of the information you'll need. Details of these regulations are not repeated in this Rally Guide, but other useful information and important phone numbers are gathered here.

The staff in the Rally Office and CROs will be happy to assist you. The Sportity app will be updated with current information both before and during the competition, so please make sure to follow it.

2. Before the event

2.1 Trailer and reconnaissance car park (map for competitors Sportity app)

Trailer Parking: Vanha Ravirata 15800 Lahti

Recce Car Parking: Lahti Hall P-area, Salpausselänkatu 7, 15110 Lahti

IMPORTANT: Bringing recce cars into the service area is strictly prohibited!

Space is limited at the service park, so please follow the instructions of the traffic controllers and other officials. Remember to remove the identification numbers from recce cars immediately after reconnaissance.

2.2 Service Area

The location of the service park is shown in the map available in the Sportity app. Only rally cars and one service car per crew with the service car identification are allowed into the service park. Service car identification is in the material package.

Competitors and their service crews are expected to handle fuel, oil, and other liquid substances very carefully. It is mandatory to use a liquid-proof tarpaulin/cover under the rally car and service vehicle while servicing, under the threat of disqualification from the competition.

Absorbent mats are available for purchase in the service area. For more information, contact: RTE Motorsport, Janne Eronen +358 44 281 5031

Please notice, each competing car must carry an oil spill kit capable of absorbing the total amount of oil-based fluids contained in the car's systems. The kit should include oil absorbent material, plastic bags, and gloves as a minimum. The competition organizer has provided additional oil spill equipment in both service parks, which can be used in the event of a larger oil spill. The location is marked, and it includes absolom absorbent powder, brushes, and wheelbarrows for collecting waste.

A fire extinguisher (minimum 6 kg) must be on hand at all times. Open fire is not allowed. Smoking is allowed only in marked areas. If any competitor or their service crew breaks these rules, the Stewards may impose sanction up to exclusion.

If service tents are erected, they must be weighted down so that they cannot be dislodged by wind or other mechanical stresses.























2.3 Administrative check and collection of materials

HRT

Competitors' identities will be checked during material distribution.

Competitors will receive a road book, two route maps, door numbers, timecards, and, if necessary, series-specific decals, as well as a tracking device from the rally office during the following times:

- Wednesday, August 21, 2024, between 07:30 -12:00 and 16:30 20:00
- Thursday, August 22, 2024, between 06:30 11:00 and 18:00 20:00
- Starting Friday, August 23, 2024, at 07:30

SM

Competitors' identities will be checked during material distribution.

Competitors in classes 1-8 will receive a road book, two route maps, door numbers, time cards, and a tracking device from the rally office during the following times:

- Wednesday, August 21, 2024, between 07:30 -12:00 and 16:30 20:00
- Thursday, August 22, 2024, between 06:30 11:00 and 18:00 20:00

2.4 Reconnaissance

- Wednesday, August 21, 2024, from 08:30 to 17:30
- Thursday, August 22, 2024, from 07:00 to 16:00

Different types of chicanes will be used on the special stages that are not marked in the road book. These chicanes will be in place during the reconnaissance.

During reconnaissance, a speed limit of 80 km/h is in force on all special stages unless a lower speed limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs set up by the organizer. The driving style must not endanger or disturb other traffic or nearby residences. Driving in the opposite direction on a special stage is prohibited by the organizer.

The identification numbers on the recce cars must be removed immediately after the end of the reconnaissance. Parking recce cars in the service park after reconnaissance is prohibited. Violations will be penalized with a fine of 100 euros. If the violations are repeated, the rally committee has the option to impose additional sanctions.























3 During the event

3.1 Identification of officials

Officials can be identified as follows:

- SS Commander: Red vest
- SS Safety Commander: green vest
- · Competitors' Relations Officer: ID card
- Timekeeping, secutiry officers, marshal, ticket sales: yellow vest
- Scrutineering: yellow vest

3.2 Time card and operation at time controls (timecard instructions Sportity app)

International timecard is used in the rally. Timecard will be distributed to competitors along with other materials. The time for the next AT is calculated by adding the transition time to the actual start time of the SS. Each competitor pair is solely responsible for their timecard. At the time control station, the timecard is handed over to the official, who will make time entries on the time cards – not the competitors. A sample timecard can be found in the appendix.

3.3 Competitors' action procedure in the event of an accident, OK/SOS

Warning triangle: In case you need to stop at SS due to driving off road or for any other reason, the warning triangle must be placed to warn other competitors at least 50 meters before the location where you stopped.

SOS&OK

If medical help or fire-fighting assistance is required in case of an accident, the SOS button in the GPS tracking device should be pressed and the SOS sign displayed for the next competitors arriving to the scene. Do not leave the sign unattended!

If you see fellow competitor showing the SOS sign, you definitely must stop to provid assistance and if necessary to call for additional help via the GPS tracking device or safety number (emergency number found in the road book). In case calling for help fails, you must report the information to the next radio point which may also be the Finish line.





















When you call for help, provide the following information:

- competitor number of the crew involved
- if and how many crew members or spectators are injured
- how seriously injured they are
- is anyone trapped in or under the car
- location of the accident (road book page and box/junction/other information)
- other vital information (car on fire, in the water etc)

Free access to the accident location for rescue vehicles must be ensured by moving the rally cars that have arrived to the scene past the accident site. In case this is not possible, the cars must be moved to the side of the road (space should be showeled if necessary)

If you need to retire, please inform the rally control center via phone (number found in the road book). Hand in the GPS tracking device and timekeeping transponder as soon as possible to the closest TC or rally office.

If no medical help or fire-fighting assistance is required, show the green OK sign to the fellow competitors and officials.

3.4 Refuel

Refueling is only allowed at designated refueling zones (RZ) at commercial gas stations marked in the road book.

- Friday, August 23, 2024:
 - Matkakeidas Vierumäki (Tervalammentie 1, 19110 Vierumäki)
 - Matkakeidas Hollola (Hopeakalliontie 2, 15880 Hollola)
- Saturday, August 24, 2024:
 - Shell Express Hennala (Helsingintie 120, 15700 Lahti)
 - St1 Mäntsälä P (Pohjoinen Pikatie 1, 04600 Mäntsälä)
 - Matkakeidas Hollola (Hopeakalliontie 2, 15880 Hollola)

Transition and SS distances can be found in the schedule.

Refueling is only permitted at gas stations designated by the organizer in the road book and at specially marked refueling zones.























3.5 Finish and prize giving

The finish of the competition is located at Lahti Harbor. Before arriving at the finish arch, competitors will be arranged in a regroup area where the final AT is located, and where competitors will be arranged for driving onto the finish podium and the award ceremony.

Note: Only awarded rally cars will be driven onto the finish podium. Others must follow the organizer's instructions for exiting the area.

3.6 Technical check

Possible technical checks will take place at Autosalpa Vanhanradankatu 2, 15520 Lahti.

4 After the event

4.1 Cleanup of the service park

After the competition, please ensure that your service area is clean. There are sufficient trash bins available on the site, with separate bins for bottles and cans. The service area also has designated recycling containers for hazardous waste.
