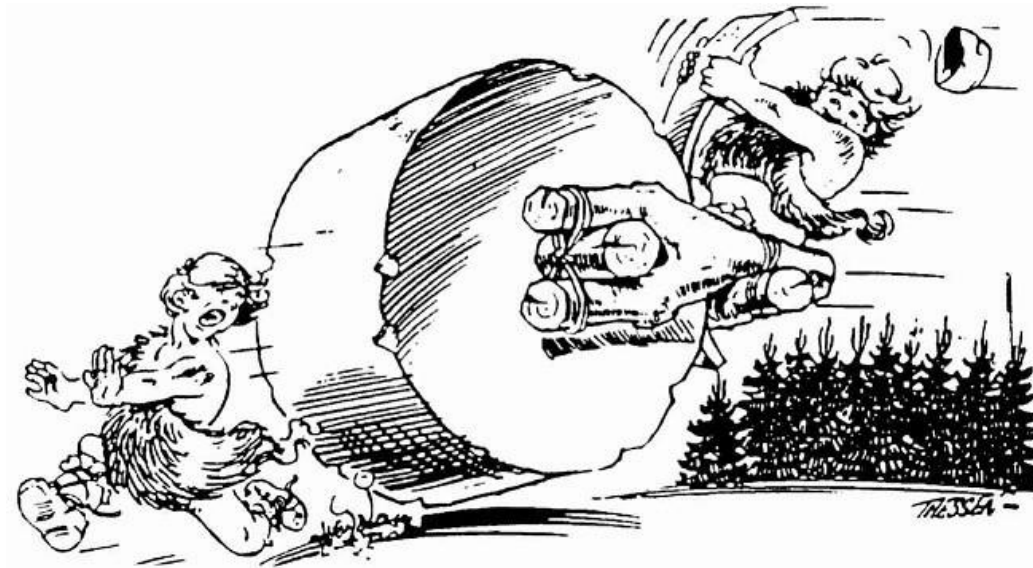

4. GENERAL INFORMATION

The rally will be run in compliance with the effective National Sporting Regulations, Historic Rally Thorpy Finland Regulations, Historic Regularity Rally Trophy series regulations, BMW Rallyseries, VW Aircooled Rally Series and these Supplementary Regulations of NIBE-Rantaralli, which AKK Motorsport has approved with VISA number 69480/RA/26.

An English version of these Supplementary Regulations is published, but in a contradictory situation the Finnish regulations are applied.

Total distance of the itinerary is 226 km, including 6 special stages, with a total distance of approx. 69 km. Special Stages include 0,8 km tarmac surface.

If a competitor or his/her delegate is met on the roads in Mynämäki, Säkylä, Pöytyä, Oripää, Nousiainen or Masku on the yellow, grey, black or unmarked roads on the road map of Finland before the competitor's start time, the competitor will be excluded from the Rally.

In this Competition the Regulations of Suomen Urheilun Eettinen Keskus (SUEK) will be followed. These Regulations can be found at suek.fi. With doping related items, the Finnish Legislation will be followed.

6. ENTRY

Everyone who wants to participate in NIBE-Rantaralli must register via KITI portal or ask instructions for entries given by the Secretary of the Rally.

By the order of the entries, 210 crews who have completed the registration according to the rules are accepted for the Rally. Possible eliminations will be done from extra classes.

Usage of the competitors' information by the organizer:

Upon completing the registration competitors accept the usage of their personal information by the organizer and publication of the pre-determined personal information (name, association etc.) in the entry list, results etc. in Rally media.

7. ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are as follows:

Registration with entry fee must be with the Organizer no later than **8.9.2026 at 18.00 local time**. Registration can be stopped before this scheduled date and time if the maximum number of competitors will be reached according to item 6.

8. SERVICE

There is one service/regrouping break in this competition. Service time is 30-60 minutes.

Only one service car per competitor is allowed to enter the service area. In service car there must be clearly visible note: "HUOLTOAUTON AJOLUPA" which is given to competitors with other competitor material.

Service Break Area is 6x8 meters.

Cars which are used in reconnaissance are prohibited to enter in the service area. Those cars can be parked in trailer park.

Break/service will be after special stage 3. SS3 Stop will give the time to leave to competitors.

Entry to break is free but when leaving there is a time control.

9. TIRES

Tires according to National Sporting Rules for year 2026 by AKK.

10. REFUELING

Refueling is allowed only in petrol can places or from petrol pumps at the petrol stations indicated on the road book. Refueling elsewhere during the competition is prohibited.

Racing cars using RE 85 and 2-stroke fuel and those racing cars that can use racing fuel approved by FIA (mentioned in appendix J in Finnish National Sporting Rules by AKK) can be refueled from competitors' own equipment by pouring or pumping.

If any violations related to refueling are noticed, it will cause an immediate penalty of exclusion by the Clerk of the Course.

Distances between refueling can be found in Rally Guide.

Reconnaissance classes 19–24, 41–46

Friday 18.9.26 starting at 8.30 in Rally Office.

Organizer provides two (2) reconnaissance car identifications that must be fitted in the middle and up of the windscreen and to the right back side window and must be visible for the whole reconnaissance time.

The speed limit of 80 km/h is valid on all special stages during the reconnaissance unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organizer. Driving during the reconnaissance must not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people close by. Driving in the opposite direction of the special stage is prohibited. Organizer will control speed and driving habits during reconnaissance time. Local Police is also having control on course and traffic violations will be punished according to the Finnish Road Laws.

Stopping orders by cars having the signs of the Organizers must be obeyed, otherwise the starting permission will be denied.

Reconnaissance time is starting on 18.9.2026 at 9.00 o'clock and will end on 18.9.2026 at 18.00 o'clock.

Reconnaissance is allowed with restrictions as follows:

Reconnaissance is allowed only for competitors in classes 19-24, 41-46. The number of drives through special stages is limited to 3 times during reconnaissance time.

Only the rally competitors (1st and 2nd drivers) can be in the reconnaissance car.

On the route there will be speed control during the reconnaissance!

Classes 1–18, 25–40 No reconnaissance

Saturday 19.9.26 starting at 7.30 from Rally Office

GPS transponder and Transponder for timekeeping will be delivered in safety scrutineering. Timecard will be delivered in in time control area in the starting area of the competition.

13. SAFETY SCRUTINEERING

Saturday 19.9.2026 in Kasitien Katsastus, Kivistöntie 5, 23100 Mynämäki

Regularity classes at 8.00 and numbers 1–30 during 8.30–9.00, numbers 31–60 during 9.01–9.30, numbers 61–90 during 9.31–10.00, numbers 91–120 during 10.01–10.30,

numbers 120–150 during 10.31–11.00, numbers 151–180 during 11.01–11.30, numbers 181–210 during 11.31–12.00.

Safety scrutineering ends 10 minutes after the last scrutineering time available.

NOTICE in classification of seats and safety belts:

Seats and safety belts according to FIA standards can be used, validity date is not mandatory. Condition of seats and safety belts must be excellent and these will be checked in safety scrutineering.

14. START

The list of competitors permitted to start will be published according to the programme in Sportity application and on the official notice board.

1st competitor is starting at 10.01, starting interval will be 1 minute.

Route given in the road book must be followed the whole time of competition. Deviation of route given will probably cause the penalty decided by Clerck of the Course depending the seriousness of the offense.

15. RESULTS

The provisional results will be published by class according to the schedule on the Official Notice Board. The official results will be found on the Official Notice Board, KITI portal and also on home pages of competition and HRT series.

16. PRIZES AND PRIZE GIVING

The number of awarded competitors will be published at the Official Notice Board.

The prizes will be given to both drivers according to the provisional results in the finish area of the competition, Keskuskatu 17, 23100 Mynämäki.
