4. GENERAL INFORMATION

This rally will be run in compliance with the effective National Sporting Regulations, F-Cup Regulations 2026, and MRF Pohjanmaa Ralli 2025 Supplementary Regulations (which AKK Motorsport has approved with Visa No. 1907/RA/26). The supplementary regulations are also published in English. In case of any dispute, the Finnish versions will be determinative.

Total distance of the itinerary is 282 km including 7 Special Stages. Distance of the Special Stages is 68 km in total.

The competitor is responsible for insuring the car with an insurance towards third parties which is also valid on Special Stages.

The official time of the event is the Official Finnish Time, which can be found at <https://time.is>. The Official Notice Board includes a link to the official time.

International time card is used in the rally. Markings on the time card will be made by the TC officials.

If a competitor or their Delegate is met prior to their starting time on the roads used as Special Stages in the Rally and marked yellow, grey or black or unmarked roads in the road map of Finland in the areas of Seinäjoki, Kurikka, Ilmajoki or Lapua, the competitor will be prohibited to participate in the Rally. Reconnaissance according to supplementary regulations Art. 11 is excluded from this.

The Rally follows the regulations of the Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports (FINCIS), which can be found at suek.fi, and the legislation regarding doping.

6. ENTRY

Everyone who wants to participate in MRF Pohjanmaa Ralli needs to register via KITI portal at the latest on 25.5.2026 at 16:00 or ask secondary instructions for entry from the secretary of the rally.

Foreign competitors register via entry form which is available on the Official Notice Board. The entry form needs to be returned at the latest on 25.5.2026 at 16:00.

By the order of entries, 220 crews who did the registration according to the regulations are accepted to the Rally. Possible elimination is performed from other than F-Cup classes.

Use of competitor's information by the organizer:

When registering for the event, the competitor agrees with the processing of the given personal data by the organizer and publication of the specified information (name, club etc.) in the entry list, results and communication of the event.

The administrative check will be done electronically via the forms (contact details during the event and information for the commentator) available on the Official Notice Board. The forms must be returned at the latest on 1.6.2026 at 23:59. The organizer acknowledges accepted materials to the competitor.

The organizer can assist the foreign competitors with obtaining transfer permit (license plates). Any need for the license plates shall be informed to the organizer by 2.6.2026 via email to pohjanmaaralli@gmail.com.

7. ENTRY FEES

The entry fees are as follows:

The reference number should be the license number of the 1st driver.

Entry fee will be refunded in full to candidates whose entry has not been accepted, in case the competitor cancels their participation before the closing date for entries or in case the rally is not taking place. In case the competitor cancels their participation by 1.6.2026 at 22:00, the entry fee will be returned but 50 € administrative fee will be reserved.

Cancelling the participation should always be done via email to pohjanmaaralli@gmail.com.

8. SERVICE

There is one Service Park in the Rally located in the area of Rengastien Autotarvike (Rengastie 21 and 28, 60120 Seinäjoki). The Service Park opens on Friday 5.6.2026 at 15:00. Rengastie is open for other traffic on Friday and there is no overnight security in the Service Park.

There are two services (2 x 30 min). Schedule of the services will be announced in the itinerary.

The organizer reserves 5,5 x 7,5 m service area for each crew. Each crew will receive one driving permit to the Service Park for service car.

In case of special requests or shared services, a detailed written request (with the size of the service area mentioned) should be sent to the organizer via email pohjanmaaralli@gmail.com at the latest on 29.5.2026 at 23:59. Please also inform in case you wish to have an adjacent service area with certain competitors/teams. The organizer reserves the right to reject the requests.

Service cars must have a fire extinguisher and ready-to-use oil spill kit for each crew. Each Rally car must have a liquid-impermeable protective ground sheet covering the area of the car under the car during the service. Lack of any of the above-mentioned leads to immediate exclusion from the Rally imposed by the Clerk of the Course.

There are regroupings before the services. When arriving at the service TCs 2A and 5A will give the competitor two different times (TC check in time and time when service is allowed to be started). TC also marks the allowed service start time on a separate note to the window of the car. Service can be started at the time which is marked to the time card and car's window at TC 2A / 5A Service time is 30 min.

Exceeding the service time is sanctioned with 30 seconds for every starting minute.

Sanctions for other violations in the service and refueling areas:

1st violation	300€

9. TYRES

According to F-Cup regulations 2026 art 4.1 summer tyres.

10. REFUEL

Refueling during the Rally is allowed at the gas station (ST1 Nurmo, Kaarretie 3, 60510 Seinäjoki) marked in the Road Book from the pump or from competitor's own containers in the separate refuel zones adjacent to the gas station.

11. RECONNAISSANCE (classes 1–3, 7, 9, 13, 15 and 24–32)

Competitors can collect the reconnaissance materials from the Rally Office on 5.6.2026 starting from 07:30. Competitor needs to provide the organizer information about their reconnaissance car and their phone number within the administrative check according to art 6 of these Supplementary Regulations.

Two (2) identification numbers must be attached to the reconnaissance car at the top center of the windscreen and the right rear side window and kept visible for the whole duration of reconnaissance.



The competitors must comply with the Finnish Traffic Law and lower regulations during the reconnaissance. Speed limit of 80 km/h is valid on all Special Stages during the reconnaissance unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed on the route by the organizer. Driving during the reconnaissance must not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living close by. Driving in the opposite direction of the rally is prohibited with the exception of 1,85 km at the start of SS1. It is allowed to drive that part in the opposite direction of the rally when going from SS2 to the start of SS1 during the reconnaissance. The organizer will control speed as well as the manner of driving during reconnaissance. The police will also supervise on the route and may penalize traffic infringements according to the Finnish Traffic Law.

Competitors are obligated to follow stopping requests of the Rally Officials with the organizer's identifications, or the penalty will be refusal to start.

The reconnaissance starts on 5.6.2026 at 08:00 and ends on 5.6.2026 at 20:00.

GPS tracking devices will be handed out with the reconnaissance material and must be used during the reconnaissance. The competitor must have a USB port in the reconnaissance car and keep the tracking device plugged in throughout the reconnaissance. Only two (2) passages are allowed on Special Stages during the reconnaissance. The organizer will control inter alia the number of passages on each Special Stage with the tracking device.

Competitor must move the GPS tracking device into their rally car after the reconnaissance, and prior to their starting time for the Rally.

If a competitor from these classes or their Delegate is found on the rally routes prior to their starting time, the competitor will be prohibited to participate in the Rally. This does not exclude potential extra sanctions given by ASN.

12. COMPETITOR NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

The Championship and Rally organizers reserve the following areas of the car for competitor numbers and advertisements:

- At the top of the front doors, panels measuring 67 cm wide by 20 cm high are reserved for the competitor numbers (number part of the sticker must be placed towards the front of the car) and organizer's advertisements: Rengastien Autotarvike Oy, Seinäjoen kaupunki and MRF Tyres.
- 20 cm high area for competitor numbers from the rear side windows.
- At the top of the windscreen, a 15 cm high and the full width of the windscreen, area for the advertisement of the Championship organizer.

The organizer will provide the competitor numbers and the advertisements, and they will be collected from the Rally Office with other materials. They must be attached to the car in the above stated positions prior to scrutineering. It is the responsibility of the competitor to make sure the numbers are attached and won't detach.

13. SAFETY SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering is held at Rengastien Autohuolto premises, address Rengastie 21, 60120 Seinäjoki. Scrutineering starts on Saturday 6.6.2026 at 08:00.

Each competitor must book their own scrutineering time slot at <https://slotti.fi/booking/rallism/> starting from 29.5.2026 at 12:00 and at the latest on 1.6.2026 at 18:00.

Scrutineering closes 10 minutes after the last booked time slot ends.

If the competitor wishes to change their scheduled scrutineering time after the booking system has closed, the organizer will charge 50 € fee. The same fee applies also if the organizer books the scrutineering time for the competitor in case the competitor hasn't booked it, or if the competitor is late from their scheduled time.

The competitor or their delegate must check in at the scrutineering area 10 minutes before their scrutineering time, when car's presence on time will be recorded. After the check in, the competitor/delegate moves to the equipment inspection and after that the car will be moved towards the scrutineering line.

Noise level of the car might be checked at the scrutineering (maximum 103 dB at 3500 rpm).

The following car documentation must be provided to the organizer according to F-Cup regulations art 13.1 at the latest on Tuesday 2.6.2026:

- Scrutineering card
- Homologation certification or technical passport
- Homologation certification of the safety frame (if homologated/certified)
- Catalyst certification, if the car has catalyst
- Rally car's transfer permit / registration
- Scrutineering certificate or certificate of the accepted annual scrutineering

Further instructions on providing the materials will be given in the Rally Guide.

The competitor is solely responsible for submitting the documents and notifying any changes. The documents must be present at the competition venue in accordance with F-Cup regulations 2026 art 13.1.

14. SHAKEDOWN

There is no Shakedown.

15. COMPETITOR MATERIALS

Competitors in classes 1–3, 7, 9, 13, 15 and 24–32 receive a Road Book, where the route to be followed is described in details, time cards (3 pcs) and route maps (2 pcs) and reconnaissance materials during the collection of the materials on Friday 5.6.2026 07:30-20:00.

Competitors in classes 4–6, 8, 10–12, 14 and 16–23 receive a Road Book, time cards (3 pcs) and route maps (2 pcs) from the Rally Office within the administrative check on Saturday 6.6.2026 from 07:30.

Identity card, passport etc. will be checked in the Rally Office during the administrative check and collection of the materials.

16. START

Start List will be published on the Official Notice Board according to the programme.

The start takes place at Seinäjoen Keskustori at 10:00 and every 1 minute.

The timekeeping transponder will be given to the competitors at the start area.

Competitors must follow the determined route during the whole rally. If the competitor fails to follow the route, it might lead to a sanction imposed by the Clerk of the Course depending on the severity of the violation.

17. REGROUP

There are two regroupings with the services. Schedule of the regroupings will be announced in the itinerary.

18. RESULTS

The provisional classifications will be published according to the programme on the Official Notice Board and the official classifications can be found at KITI portal and on the following websites www.pohjanmaaralli.fi and www.f-cup-fi.

19. PRIZES AND PRIZE GIVING

The number of awarded competitors will be published on the Official Notice Board.

The prizes will be given according to the provisional classifications to both drivers at the finish of the Rally at Seinäjoen Keskustori.
