4. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The event follows the regulations imposed by Finnish National Sporting Authority (AKK Motorsport ry, AKK) including the Finnish Sporting Code (FSC), Finnish Rally Regulations (FRR), The Finnish Rally Championship Regulations (FRC) 2026 and these Supplementary Regulations. The Supplementary Regulations in Finnish have been approved by AKK with competition license number 19036/R/26. This translation of the Supplementary Regulations is informational only and in case of disputes the official Supplementary Regulations in Finnish is authoritative version.

Total length of the Rally:

- **Classes 1-18:** 215 km including 9 Special Stages, with total length of 102 km.
- **Classes 19-25 (Auto Sorsan Erikoinen):** approximately 110 km including 6 Special Stages, with total length of 56 km.



If any competitor or persons working for them are met on the non-arterial roads in the regions of Riihimäki, Janakkala, Hausjärvi, Loppi or Hämeenlinna, before their official start time, their participation in the event is prohibited.

The event follows the regulations by Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports (FINCIS), which can be found at suek.fi, as well all doping related Finnish legislation.

6. ENTRY

Competitors with AKK license wishing to take part in the event must submit an entry via KITI or contact jenni.kuisma@gmail.com via email to ask for secondary instructions.

Competitors with foreign license must submit their entry via Google forms (link <https://forms.gle/psAzCtn7ZauoyB489>). Google account is needed for submitting the form.

The maximum number of entrants is fixed at 220 cars. In case of more than the maximum entries, competitors in Finnish Rally Championship classes are prioritized.



Administrative check is done electronically. Forms for administrative check will be published in the official notice board. The check must be completed at the latest on 25.2.2026 at 16.30.

Use of competitor's information by the organizer:

By entering the event, the competitor accepts the processing of the provided personal data by the organizer and the publication and inclusion of specified personal information (name, club, etc.) in the entry list, results list, etc. organizer's communications.

SERVICE

There are 2 services on the route (Classes 1–18). Service schedule is mentioned in the itinerary.

At TCs for Regroup/Service in (TC 3A and TC 7A) the competitor receives service start time to their time card (start time minimum 3 minutes after the check in to TC). After that, and possible technical checks, the competitor moves the car to their service area. Time card must be placed on the windscreen of the car so that the given times are clearly visible.

Service is monitored: Violations related to the service time (starting service too early or exceeding the service time) are sanctioned according to the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations.

The organizer reserves each crew and team championship competitors service areas according to the Finnish Rally Championship regulations. In case of special requests or shared services, a detailed written request (with the size of the service area mentioned) should be sent to the organizer via email riihimaenua@gmail.com at the latest on 19.2.2026 at 21.00. After this time, the organizer may charge 150 €/crew for the possible changes. The organizer reserves the right to reject the requests.

Service area must have ready-to-use equipments according to Finnish Rally Championship regulations. Each Rally car must have a liquid-impermeable protective ground sheet covering the area of the car under the car during the service. Lack of any of the above-mentioned leads to sanction imposed by the Clerk of the Course.

Classes 19-25 (Auto Sorsan Erikoinen) service: Service area is announced in the Road Book.

9. TYRES

Classes 1–6: Marking and checking tyres (8 pieces) is done according to the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations. Tyre bar code form must be submitted via email to rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi at the latest 27.2.2026 at 18.00. Subject of the email should be competitor number and driver's name.

In other classes, the number of studded tyres is not limited and tyres according to the old regulations are permitted.

10. REFUEL

Refueling is only allowed at petrol stations as determined in the Road Book, and at separately marked refuel zones.

Within the administrative check, the competitor must notify the fuel they wish to use (unleaded, E85 or FIA Appendix J compliant) and the method of refueling (from the gas station or own container). Allowed refueling locations and distances will be announced in the Rally Guide.

11. RECONNAISSANCE

Starting from 27.2.2026 at 07.00 competitors in classes 1–14 and 19–21 can collect reconnaissance materials at ABC Riihimäki. Competitors must provide the organizer with the details of their reconnaissance car and phone number within the electronic administrative check.

Maximum two (2) passages per Special Stage are allowed during the reconnaissance.

Two (2) identification numbers must be attached to the reconnaissance car at the top of the windscreen and the right rear side window and kept visible for the whole duration of reconnaissance.

During the reconnaissance and road sections of the rally, the competitors must comply with the Finnish Road Traffic Act and regulations. Speed limit of 80 km/h is valid on all Special Stages during the reconnaissance unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organizer. Driving during the reconnaissance must not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living close by. Driving in the opposite direction of the rally is prohibited. The organizer will control speed as well as the manner of driving during reconnaissance.

GPS tracking devices will be handed out with the reconnaissance material and must be used during the reconnaissance. The competitor must have a USB connection in the reconnaissance car and keep the tracking device connected throughout the reconnaissance. Competitor must move the GPS tracking device into their rally car after the reconnaissance, and prior to their starting time for the Rally.

Any request to stop by the officials with the organizer's identification must be obeyed at the risk of being denied the right to start.

Reconnaissance is allowed on 27.2.2026 as follows:

- SS 1-6 and SS 8-9: 07.30–18.00.
- SS 7: 16.00–18.00.

12. COMPETITOR NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

The competitor numbers are size of 67*20 cm.

The organizer reserves an advertising space measuring 67*20 cm under the competitor number.

13. SAFETY SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering is held at Hyria koulutus Oy Riihimäki, Sakonkatu 1, 11100 Riihimäki. Scrutineering starts on Friday 27.2. at 15.00.



Each competitor must book their own scrutineering time slot at <https://slotti.fi/booking/rallism/#/>:

- Classes 1–7: booking opens on Friday 20.2. at 10.00 and closes on Wednesday 25.2. at 16.30
- Classes 8–25: booking opens on Monday 23.2. at 10.00 and closes on Wednesday 25.2. klo 16.30

The documents required for scrutineering according to Finnish Rally Championship regulations art 11.1 must be provided at the latest on 25.2. at 16.30 via email to rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi. Subject of the email should be competitor number and driver's name.

If the competitor wishes to change their scheduled scrutineering time after the booking system has closed, the organizer will charge 50 € fee. The same fee applies also if the organizer books the scrutineering time for the competitor in case the competitor hasn't booked it. The fee must be paid in the Rally Office at the latest one hour before competitor's start time.

The competitor or their delegate must check in at the scrutineering location's office 10 minutes before their scrutineering time, when car's presence on time will be recorded. After the check in, the competitor/delegate moves to the equipment inspection, and the car will be moved towards the scrutineering line.

Noise level of the car might be checked at the scrutineering (maximum 103 dB at 3500 rpm).

Sealing

The spare parts to be registered and sealed for the Rally will be checked and if needed sealed at the scrutineering. Further instructions will be published in the Rally Guide.

Changing a sealed part during the Rally

The competitor must notify the Chief Scrutineer Jyrki Hapulahti via phone, tel. +358 400 8495 69.

Expired HTP passports are accepted in the Historic classes (13, 14, 17, 21 and 24) and expired V1600 passports are accepted in the classes 18 and 25.

14. MATERIALS FOR THE COMPETITORS

Each crew receives a Road Book, where the route to be followed is described in details, and 2 pieces of route maps.

Material can be collected as follows:

- Classes 1–13 and 19–21 on Friday 27.2. at 7.00–18.00, ABC Riihimäki, Kinturintie 2, 11120 Riihimäki
- Classes 15–18 and 22–25 on Saturday 28.2.2026 at 8.00–13.00 ABC Riihimäki, Kinturintie 2, 11120 Riihimäki

Both drivers must be present at the material collection and present a driving license or identity card.

GPS tracking devices will be handed out with the competitor material and transponder at the start of the Rally.

15. START

Start List will be published at Sportity according to the Programme.

- Classes 1–18: Start happens at 10.30 in the center of Riihimäki, Kauppakatu.
- Classes 19–25 (Auto Sorsan Erikoinen): Start location (competition's start TC) will be announced in the Road Book.

The competitors will receive time cards and transponder at the start TC.

International time card is used in the Rally. Instructions for the use of the card will be in the Rally Guide.

The official time of the event is the Finnish official time which can be found at <https://time.is>.

16. REGROUP

There is no separate regroup. Possible shortening of time intervals will happen during the Service.

17. RESULTS

The final official classification can be found at the official notice board, KITI portal and on the website of the Finnish Rally Championship.

18. RESULTS PRIZES AND PRIZE GIVING

The number of awarded competitors will be published at the official notice board.
