## 4. OVERVIEW

The competition will be organised in accordance with the current AKK Rally Rules and these HYAcenter Rally Rules, which have been approved by AKK Motorsport under licence number 15/R/24.

The total length of the event is 335 km, including 7 special stages totaling 95 km.

If a competitor or someone acting on his/her behalf is met on the route in the area of the following municipalities or cities, Pälkäne, Kangasala, Lempäälä, Vesilahti, Urjala, Sastamala, on yellow, grey, black or unmarked roads on the Finnish Road Map before the start time of that competitor, the competitor will be denied the right to participate in the event. Competitors in classes 1-12 will be allowed to visit the route on Friday 26.7.2024 from 9.00-17.00.

The race uses turning arrows, the direction of the junction is indicated by the direction of the arrowhead. The competition will follow the rules of the Finnish Sports Ethics Centre (SUEK), which can be found at suek.fi, and legislation on doping.

# 6. REGISTRATION

Anyone wishing to participate in the HYAcenter Rally must register via the KITI system or ask the race secretary for secondary registration instructions.

75 competitors registered in accordance with the rules will be admitted to the competition on a first-come, first-served basis. In case of elimination, it will be carried out in classes 7-12.

At least 3 runners per class are required. If the number of entrants is lower, the competitors in that class may be combined into another class.

FIA standard seats and seat belts must be used in the event, the date of validity of which is not decisive. They must be in first class condition. Competitors must have all the driving equipment required by the rules (HANS, helmet, balaclava, driving suit, underwear + socks, shoes, gloves for 1 driver).

## Use of competitor data by the competition organiser:

By registering for the competition, the competition agrees to the processing of the personal data provided by the competition organiser and to the publication of the personal data specified (name, club, etc.) in the list of participants, the results list, etc. in the communication of the competition.

The above information and photos taken by the organiser may be used in the communication of HYAcenter Rally Finland.

Documentation check is done electronically. The competitor must fill in the forms ("Service contact details", "Announcer information", "Voluntary safety check" and, for pre-arrivals, the "Information about the reconnaissance period" form) and scan the necessary documents from the KITI service under "Attachments" in HYAcenter Rally; registration certificate/transfer license, inspection card (both sides), classification certificate/Historic passport or V1600 passport, front page is sufficient (competitor's license if required) and send them to the race organiser by Wednesday 24.7.2024 by 18.00. If the forms are submitted after the above date, they will not be checked and must be taken and presented at the time of registration.

Documents should be sent by email to pr.rallit@gmail.com, clearly scanned and named.

Once a competitor has registered through KITI, he/she confirms that all paperwork is in order and complies with the motor sport regulations. 1. The 1-driver and 2-driver are obliged to inform if he/she has lost the right to drive after registration.

The reference number is the license number of the 1-driver.

If 1 instructor is under 18 years old, there is a -50% discount on the participation fee.

The participation fee includes the transponder fee. If a competitor does not return the transponder undamaged to the organiser after the race, the competitor will have to pay the organiser 200 € for the transponder.

## 8. SERVICE

Service cars must have a competitor-specific fire extinguisher (new or inspected), and an oil absorption mat ready for use, and under the car, a protective covering at least the size of the floor area of the car, which is impermeable to liquids. The absence of any of these will result in immediate disqualification from the race by decision of the race director.

The competition will use the service area located at *Ideaparkinkatu*, 37570 Lempäälä, Finland.

There is no service break in the event, but there is a possibility to service after SS 3 (minimum 20 min) and SS 6 (minimum 10 min) and the service time is included in the transition.

The organiser reserves a 7.5 m x 10 m service area for each competitor. One service vehicle per pair of competitors is allowed in the service area. The speed limit in the service area is 20 km/h.

#### 9. REFUELING

Refueling during the event is only allowed in the areas marked in the road book (refueling area) and at the service stations on the route (see the competitor's guide for details). No other refueling is allowed during the event.

Cars using 98E, E85 and 2 stroke fuel, and those cars that can use FIA race fuel in accordance with Appendix J of the Rule Book, may be refueled from a separate tank (poured or pumped into the fuel tank). This refueling point will be indicated in the road book (at the service station).

If any infringement of the rules regarding refueling is detected, it will result in immediate disqualification by decision of the Clerk of the course.

#### 10. RECONNAISSANCE

From 26.7.2024 at 8.45 a.m., competitors may pick up reconnaissance documents from HQ. When signing for the material, the competitor must give the organiser details of his/her recoinaissance vehicle and telephone number.

The two (2) tour car badges provided by the organiser must be attached to the windscreen, centre up and to the right rear side window and must be visible throughout the reconnaissance period.

During the reconnaissance, the speed limit is 80 km/h on all special stages, unless the speed limit is lowered by traffic signs or signs placed on the terrain by the organiser. The driving style must be such that it does not endanger or disturb other traffic or nearby settlements. The organiser shall carry out speed and driving controls during the reconnaissance period. The police will also monitor the route and punish traffic offences in accordance with the Road Traffic Act. If you are driving on the route, you are about to explore in the opposite direction to the route, please take special care and follow the traffic rules.

Officials with the organisers' insignia must obey the stop command under penalty of disqualification. The reconnaissance period starts on 26.7.2024 at 9.00 and ends on 26.7.2024 at 17.00.

A more detailed timetable for each special stage will be published in the competitor's guide.

Access to the route is permitted subject to the following restrictions:

- 2 passes of recce allowed.
- On special stages, any reduced speed limits on the terrain must be respected.
- Only 1- and 2-drivers participating in the competition may be in the reconnaissance car.

## 10.1 Speeding during reconnaissance

During the reconnaissance session, the Clerk of the course may impose the following penalty for speeding as measured by the police or the race organiser's speed camera:

- 1. Written warning and a €90 fine. If the offence exceeds 30 km/h, the race director may deny the pair the right to start.
- 2. Start of the event denied.

The fine for a speeding violation during the pre-registration must be paid to the race office before the competitor's own start time. Failure to pay will result in disqualification from the start.

### 11. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

The competition will use a 50x50cm competition number and a 50x25cm hood sticker.

Advertisements will be indicated in the instructions for competitors. Stickers will be distributed at the time of distribution and will be checked during the safety check.

### 12. START AND FINISH

The competitors' ideal start times will be announced on the official notice board of the competition, on the Sportity app, according to the programme.

Competitors will receive their timecard after an approved scrutineering from the start TC.

Start is on 27.7.2024 from *Ideaparkinkatu*, 37570 Lempäälä, starting at 10.01 every minute.

The competitor must follow the route set by the organiser throughout the revent. Failure to follow the route will always result in disqualification from the event.

The finish of the race is at Ideapark (HQ)

#### 13. COMPETITOR MATERIAL

From 26.7.2024 at 08.45, each crew will receive a route book detailing the route to be followed, 2 pcs of route maps, 2 pcs of door numbers, 1 pc of bonnet advertisement and a timecard.

The driver and the co-driver in the youth category must show a driving licence and the co-driver must show proof of identity (photo ID, e.g. driving licence).

For more information on the distribution of material and transponders, see the competitor's guide.

### 14. SCRUTINEERING

The scrutineering can be carried out in advance on Friday 26.7.2024.

You must register in advance for the voluntary scrutineering on Friday at registeration.

The scrutineering will take place on 27.7.2024, the exact time and place will be announced in the competitor's guide. At the scrutineering the numbers and advertisements must be in place.

The security check will end on 27.7.2024 10 minutes after the last race number.

Cars must have valid Finnish motor insurance, roadworthiness test (normal or racing), and registration plates/transfer plates.

## 15. RESULTS

The provisional results will be published by category according to the schedule in the competition guide on the official notice board of the competition in the Sportity app. The final official results will be available on the KITI system and the Sportity app.

#### 16. PRIZES AND AWARDING OF PRIZES

The number of winners will be announced on the official notice board of the competition.

Prizes will be awarded to both pilots at the finish area, *Ideaparkinkatu*, 37570 Lempäälä.

The prize distribution schedule by category will be announced in the competitor's guide. All competitors to be awarded prizes must attend the prize-giving ceremony. For compelling reasons, only the Clerk of the course may authorise absence.
