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4. GENERAL INFORMATION

Total length of the route for classes 1-11 is 400,19 km including 9 special stages covering 93,09 km, of which 4,41 km is on tarmac.

Total length of the route for classes 12-19 is 304,17 km including 6 special stages covering 69,38 km, of which 3,19 km is on tarmac

Should a person who is either competitor or acting on behalf of a competitor of SM Ralli Turku be found on the roads in the area of Turku, Lieto, Paimio, Sauvo, Aura, Marttila or Salo prior to the start time of the particular crew, excluding official reconnaissance as per Art. 9., such crew will consequently be refused to start the rally.

6. ENTRIES

Anybody wishing to take part in SM Ralli Turku, must submit the entry through KITI-service, or ask Secretary of the event for alternative means to submit entry.

The maximum number of entries is limited to 150 crews.

There has to be at least 5 crews in each and every class. In case the number of crews in classes 8-19 is less than this, the class can be combined with another class.

The entry fee includes lunch tickets for the drivers on their competition days at Turku Fair and Congress Center restaurant. Suomi-CUP and additional classes entry fees include the fee for the tracking device.

8. SERVICE AREA

There is one service park in the event, located at the Turku Fair and Congress Center (Messukentänkatu 13, Turku). Servicing the rally car is only allowed in this area.

Organiser reserves every crew a service space as defined in the Finnish Rally Championship regulations. Should a joint service space be requested, a written request (with the dimensions of the area) must reach the organiser by 8 August 2016 at 9.00 pm EET at the following contact: email mika.kannisto@turunua.net . After the deadline the organiser will charge € 150 for every change concerning the service park layout. Organiser reserves the right to reject requests.

Service vehicles must be equipped with a fire extinguisher suitable for extinguishing flammable fluids and tarpaulin or equivalent under both the rally car and service vehicle to prevent possible oil spillages, ready to be used at all times during the service procedures. Should any of these be missing, the penalty will be immediate exclusion from the event by the decision of the Clerk of the Course.

Penalty fees for infringements in the service park are as follows: 1st infringement: 300€ 2nd infringement: 600€ 3rd infringement: exclusion from the event by the decision of the Clerk of the Course

9. REFUELLING

Refuelling is allowed only at the petrol stations marked on the roadbook or otherwise guided by the organiser according to the FRC regulations. On the rally route there is 3 refuelling locations, Refuelling from own containers must be done at separate refuelling areas as marked on the roadbook.

Fuel and Technique –form for classes 1-4 must be returned to the Rally Office on Friday morning in connection with the administrative checks.

Refuelling at any other places is strictly forbidden.

10. RECONNAISSANCE

Starting on Friday August 19, 2016 at 7:00am reconnaissance material and the reconnaissance tracking device for competitors in classes 1-11 can be collected from the Rally Office at Turku Fair and Congress Center. At registration, each competitor must give the organiser details of the car used for reconnaissance and contact details of his/her mobile phone. At the administrative checks/registration for reconnaissance both drivers must present drivers' competition and driving licenses, competitor/entrant license, and authorisation for the drivers by their ASN to take part in the rally. Both drivers have to present their licenses and other documents personally.

Identification signs (2 pcs) for the reconnaissance must be affixed on the reconnaissance vehicle in up and center of the vehicle's windscreen and on the right side window on the back of the vehicle. The signs must be visible throughout the whole duration of the reconnaissance. Competitor must reserve a suitable USB power supply for the tracking device and the tracking device has to be online during the reconnaissance session.

On special stages the speed limit is 80 km/h unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed along the route by the organiser. The competitors must drive in a manner that does not endanger or cause inconvenience to other traffic or people living near the stages. Under no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the rally in a special stage. Organiser will control the traffic during the reconnaissance







paying attention to the manner of driving as well as to the speeds used. Police will also control the reconnaissance and will penalise competitors for infringements according to the Finnish Traffic Law.

Competitors are, under pain of refusal to start, obliged to stop should Rally Officials with official plates request them to do so.

Reconnaissance starts Friday 19 August 2016 at 8.00am and ends at 6.00pm. The maximum number of passages on each SS for reconnaissance is limited to two per crew. This applies also to the SS's which are driven twice.

11. ADVERTISING

Advertisements in number plates will be given in Competitors' Information Kit Advertisements on rally car windscreen will be given in Competitors' Information Kit

12. START

Start time of each crew for Part 1 and 2 will be published on the official notice board according to the programme.

Time cards for classes 1-11 will be given at TC0 (Start of the rally), which is located at Forum Marinum, Linnankatu 72, Turku.

Time cards for classes 12-19 will be given at Rally Office, Turku Fair and Congress Center, one hour before the start time of each crew.

Competitors in class 1-11 are kindly asked to reach the starting area at Forum Marinum earliest 30 minutes and at the latest 15 minutes before their respective starting time.

Crews who have retired from the rally during Part 1 or have been rejected to start the rally by technical scrutineering officials are allowed to repair the car and restart the rally on Part 2. ASN Reg art 11.4. Such crew is obliged to inform the Rally Office by a written document latest on Saturday 20 August 2015 at 00.30am.

Should such crew fail to complete special stage/special stages on Part 1, total time for Part 1 will be fastest time in the respective class added by 5 minutes per non-completed special stage. Should a crew retire from the rally either on the road section after SS3 a time penalty of 5 minutes will be added to the total time.

Rally car of a crew retired during Part 1 and restarting the rally for Part 2, will undergo a technical scrutineering procedure in Parc Ferme 1 hour before the start time of 1st competitor on Saturday August 20, 2016. Only cars that have passed the technical scrutineering will be eligible to restart the rally.

Starting order for Part 2 is the one used on Part 1. This also applies to crews retired from the rally during Part 1 and restarting the rally for Part 2.

Competitors will start Part 2 at Turku Fair and Congress Center.

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Competitors are allowed to enter the Parc Ferme area at the earliest 10 minutes before their respective starting time.

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Any deviation from the given road sections will lead to exclusion by a decision of the Clerk of the Course.

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13. COMPETITOR'S MATERIAL

At the administrative checks (Turku Fair and Congress Center, on Friday 19 August 2016 starting at 7.00am), each crew of classes 1-11 will receive a road book describing the route of the rally in detail, and two route maps.

Crews in classes 12-19 will receive a road book and two route maps at the administrative checks (Turku Fair and Congress Center) starting on Saturday, 20 August 2016 at 8.00am.

Both drivers must be present personally.

14. SERVICE

Along the route there is 2 service halts and a regrouping halt. Before entering the Parc Ferme after part 1, there is a possibility for service. Time for service is included in TC3B-TC3C driving time and no penalty for early arrival to Parc Ferme.

15. SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering will take place at Turku Fair and Congress Center, Messukentänkatu 9-13, Hall D Classes 1-11 on Friday, 19 August 2016 starting at 4.00pm Classes 12-19 on Saturday, 20 August 2016 starting at 9.00am

The tracking device will be delivered to the competitors at the scrutineering. More information in the Competitor's Information Kit.

Schedule for scrutineering will be given in the Competitors' information kit, which is regarded as part of these supplementary regulations.

17. PRIZES AND PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

The number of awarded competitors is given on the official note board. Prize ceremony will take place 20 August 2016 at Turku Fair and Congress Center. Schedule for the ceremony will be given in the Competitors' information kit. All crews to receive prizes are obliged to attend the ceremony. Only the Clerk of the Course may grant a permission for a crew not to attend the ceremony.
