4. DESCRIPTION

Total distance of the rally is approx. 295 km, including 6 special stages, special stages distance will be approx. 106 km.

If a competitor is found on roads used as special stages in rally and marked in yellow, grey or black on the road map of Finland (Kuopio, Juankoski, Lapinlahti and Rautavaara areas) before the competitor's start time, his start will be refused (also see art 10. Reconnaissance).

5.1. Competitors

The rally is a NEAFP – race and thereby open for ASN-licences from other countries.

6. ENTRIES

Any licence-holder wishing to take part in the TAHKO - Rally must fill in an entry form at www.tahkoralli.fi / Entry form.

Entry form must be sent by e-mail to the organiser: [toimisto\(at\)nilua.fi](mailto:toimisto(at)nilua.fi).

The number of entrants is fixed at 240 cars. In case there are more than 240 entries, the lack of competition experience will be used as grounds for rejection.

Teams coming from outside Finland are compelled to purchase a traffic insurance for the race cars during the competition.

7. ENTRY FEES

The licence number of the driver must be given as reference.

Checks are not accepted. Please NOTE that the amount is payable in EURO only and all expenses shall be invited by the competitor.

8. SERVICE

There is one service park in the event, located in the centre of Tahkovuori. Service is allowed only in this area. Organiser reserves every crew a service space in size 6 m x 8 m and for the teams competing for Finnish championship as defined in the Finnish Rally Championship regulations.

Special requests must be sent in a detailed written application (indicate the size of the area), Service Park Manager Petri Lammela at the latest Sat 04.03.2017 at 12.00 am, e-mail: nilsianautoapu (at) luukku.com. After this, the organiser will charge changes to 150 euros / crew. The Organiser reserves the right to reject requests.

Service vehicles must be equipped with fire extinguisher appropriate for extinguishing flammable fluids (6kg) and with an oil spill kit ready for use at any time. A tarpaulin or equivalent being at least the size of the vehicles, must be used in the service park during service BOTH under service vehicle AND rally car to prevent oil spillage. The absence of one of these will lead to immediate exclusion by the Clerk of the Course as follows:

Sanctions for other Infringements in service area:

- 1 Infringement EUR 300,00
- 2 Infringement EUR 600,00
- 3 Infringement: Exclusion by the Clerk of the Course

9. REFUELLING

Refuelling is only allowed at petrol stations marked in the road book or otherwise shown by the organiser, as well as at marked refuel zones according to the Finnish Rally Championship regulations ART. 15.1.

10. RECONNAISSANCE

10.1 Classes 1 - 11

Reconnaissance time is Fri 10.3.2017 at 07.00.- 18.00, see schedule in Rally Guide

When signing for reconnaissance material, competitors must give full information about the reconnaissance car, mobile phone number and proof of identity at Rally HQ on Thu 9.3.2017 at 15.00-20.00 or on Fri 10.3.2017 starting at 06.00, Tahko Spa Hotel, Keitaankatu 1, Tahkovuori. At the administrative checks/registration for reconnaissance both drivers must present drivers' competition and driving licences, competitor/entrant licence, and authorisation for the drivers by their ASN to take part in the rally. Both drivers have to present their licences and other documents personally.

Identification stickers (2 pieces) for the reconnaissance must be affixed on the reconnaissance vehicle as follows: one to top center of the windscreen and the other to the rear side window on the right-hand side. They must be visible throughout the whole duration of the reconnaissance.

On special stages the speed limit is 80 km/h unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed along the route by the organiser. The competitors must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages. Under no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the rally in a special stage. Organiser will control the traffic during the reconnaissance paying attention to the manner of driving as well as to the speeds used. Police will also control the reconnaissance and will penalise competitors for infringements according to the Finnish Traffic Law. Competitors are, under pain of refusal to start, obliged to stop if Rally Officials with official plates request them to do so.

The organiser will supervise speed limits additionally with GPS-tracking devices. Tracking devices are available for competitors on Fri 9.3. from 06.00 and on Sat one hour before start. Race vehicles must be equipped with USB-power supply for the tracking device and the device has to be kept on during the whole reconnaissance. Switching off the tracking device will impose a penalty. After reconnaissance the GPS-devices are to be returned back to Rally HQ.

For a speeding infringement during reconnaissance measured either by the organiser or by the police, the Clerk of the Course may impose a penalty as follows:

1st infringement: reprimand
2nd infringement: 90 € fine
3rd infringement: 200 € fine
4th infringement: refusal to start

The organiser is obliged to inform competitors without delay of any infringements either by phone or through terrain stations. Given fines must be paid at latest 30 minutes before start, or refusal to start will be imposed.

Special stages may reconnaissance only twice. The organiser monitors the amount of reconnaissance with tracking devices as well as through terrain checking.

10.2 Classes 12-15

No reconnaissance for classes 12-15. The organiser reserves the right to inspect race cars of classes 12-25 at any stage of the competition, and personal equipment in the car including (cell phones) to ensure there are no traces of reconnaissance. Possessing of such material will lead to exclusion from the competition and may lead to penalty ordered by AKK.

10.3 Speeding infringement during competition

For a speeding infringement during reconnaissance or on the service area measured either by the organiser or by the police, the Clerk of the Course may impose a penalty as follows:

1st infringement: written reprimand and 90 € fine. If the speeding offence is more than 30 km/h, the Clerk of the Course may exclude the crew.

2nd infringement: as defined by the Clerk of the Course, but may be a maximum 500 € fine or exclusion.

Given fines must be paid at Rally HQ immediately after arriving to finish, at latest before the preliminary official results being announced. Otherwise exclusion by the Stewards.

11. ADVERTISING

On the competition numbers (50 x 520cm) the advertising will be "TAHKO" and "FIXUS".
Windscreen advertising place is on Competitors' own use in accordance with the serial rule.

12. START OF THE RALLY

Start times will be published on the Official Notice Board according to the programme.

The cars will be started on Sat 11.3.2017 at 10.01 am in the front of Break Sokos Hotel Tahko.
Start times will be given at 1 minute intervals.

Time Cards will be given at the start.

13 FINISH

There is no Parc Fermé in the finish.

Should a driver wish to lodge a protest against another competitor's car, this must be done to the organiser, before the arrival of the car in question to the Time Control at the finish of the rally.

14 COMPETITOR MATERIAL

Each crew are given one road book, which gives detailed description of the route to be followed, and two route maps, at the same time as optional administrative checks at Rally HQ.

Classes 12 – 25 will receive their material Fri 10.3.2017 at 15.00 – 20.00 or Sat 11.3.2017 at 06.30.

15 REGROUPING HALTS

There will be two service halts on the rally.

16 SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering will take place at Tahko Fire Station (Tahkon Palohalli), Sääskiniementie 400, Tahkovuori. Scrutineering starts on Sat 11.3.2017 at 07.00. Detailed schedule will be given in the Rally Guide. Voluntary scrutineering will take place on Fri 10.3.2017 at 15.00-20.00 at the same location. Scrutineering finishes 30 minutes after the scheduled time of the last competitor.

16.1 Sealing

The sealing of turbos and voluntary scrutineering will take place at the same location on Fri 10.3.2017 at 15.00 – 20.00.

16.2 Number of tyres, classes 1 –6

Number of tyres is 10 pieces.

Competitors must submit the list of tyre FIA-barcodes to the Organiser at Scrutineering. If a competitor's tires have not the FIA - bar code, the organiser will provide alternative instructions.

The lack of bar codes must be informed to the Rally HQ before Scrutineering.

17 RESULTS

Provisional final results will be published on the Official Notice Board in the Rally HQ.

18 PRIZES AND PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

The awards list will be published on the Official Notice Board. Awards will be trophies and items.

Prize-giving ceremony will take place in Rally HQ, Tahko Spa Hotell, where both of the drivers will be rewarded. Schedule for the ceremony will be given in the Rally Guide.

All crews to receive prizes must attend the ceremony. Only the Clerk of the Course may grant permission for a crew not to attend the ceremony.
