3. DESCRIPTION OF THE RALLY


The total length of the rally for classes 1-12 and 14-20 is 460 km including nine (9) special stages with total length of 116 km. For class 13 the length of rally is 110 km including three (3) special stages, with total length of 26 km (class 13 drives only on friday 14.6.). for classes 21-24 the length of the rally is 327 km including six (6) special stages, with total length of 90 km (classes 21-24 drive only on Saturday 15.6.).

If a driver or his Delegate is found prior to his/her starting time on rally routes marked yellow, grey or black or unmarked on the road map of Finland in the areas of Seinäjoki, Lapua, Isonkyrö or Laihia, the driver will be prohibited to participate in the rally. Reconnaissance for classes 1-12 according to rally regulations art. 10 is excluded from this.

The rally organizer holds the right to inspect the rally cars for classes 13-24 and any personal items in the car (incl. phones) at any given time in search for notes. If any notes are found the driver will be disqualified from the rally

The rally is FIA/NEAFP classified, and thus open also from other countries' ASN license holders.

5. ENTRIES

Each wanting to participate in SM Pohjanmaa rally must registrate in KITI portal or ask rally secretary for alternative registration guidelines.

When entering for the competition each driver must inform the organizer of the fuel and the method for refueling according to Rally SM championship regulations art 15.1.

180 drivers registrated according to the rules are accepted in the competition. Possible elimination will be eligible for all except the classes in Finnish Championship and Finnish Cup.

If the classes 13-23 have less than three (3) entries in each class the classes can be combined.













6. ENTRY FEE

All drivers in classes SM1-SM4 competing under SM championship regulations art 3.1 are eligible for Finnish Championship points.

Registered drivers will pay the entry fee according to the first column of the table.

Other drivers competing with ASN license will pay the entry fee according to the second column of the table.

7. SERVICE

Service is allowed only in the designated

service areas. at Rengastien Autotarvike area (Rengastie 28, 60120 Seinäjoki). Class 13 excluded (Young class), who are granted service after special stage 2 at ST1 Ylistaro, which includes rally refuel station.

Service breaks:

Class 13 service (JT-laite Ylistaro) applies in transitiontime.

classes 1-12 and 14-20 1 x 30 min. 1 x 15 min and 1 x 40 min

classes 21-24 1 x 40 min

The organizer reserves one 6 x 8m service area for each competitior and service areas for team Championship competitors according to championship regulations.

In case of special requests or joined services the organizer requires a detailed written application (size of the service area mandatory) on 2th of june 2019 at 11.59pm at the latest

to pohjanmaaralli@gmail.com. After this the organizer will claim 150 euro additional fee for any changes.

The organizer holds the right to reject the applications.

Service vehicles must contain a fire extinguisher for each driver and a ready-to-use oil spill kit in case of oil leakage. Each car must have a liquid-impermeable protective ground sheet under the car during service. The lack of any of these can result in disqualification at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Sanctions for other violations in the service and refuelling areas:

1. violation 300€ 2. violation 600€

3. violation Exclusion from the event by the decision of the Clerk of the Course.

REFUELLING

Refueling is allowed only in the petrol stations marked in the Road Book (ST1 Ylistaro) or otherwise appointed by the organizer

When registrating, the competitor must inform which fuel he/she wishes to use (nonleaded, E85 or according to FIA Appendix J) and which refueling method he/she wishes to use (petrol station or own containers). This must be informed in KITI portal in section 'additional information'.













RECONNAISSANCE (classes 1- 12)

Starting on 13th of June 2019 at 6:30pm-8:30pm and 14th of June 2019 at 6.30am Rally office (Hotelli Sorsanpesä, Törnäväntie 27, 60200 Seinäjoki) is open for disrtribution of recoinnassance material.

When receiving the material the competitor must hand out information to the organizer of his/her recce car, phone number and accommodation. All official documents for driver and co-driver will be checked when handing out the material. Both drivers must be present in person.

The two (2) identification stickers need to be placed in the middle of the wind shield and in the right rear side window of the recce car and these need to be visible during the reconnaissance.

Speed limit of 80 km/h is valid on all special stages during the reconnaissance unless the speed limit is marked lower by the traffic sign or by signs set up by the organizers. Driving during the reconnaissance must not endanger or disturb other traffic or people living close by. The organizer forbids driving in the wrong direction on special stages. The organizer will supervise speed and driving style during reconnaissance. The police will also supervise the routes and give out sanctions according to Finnish traffic laws

GPS tracking devices will be handed out with the reconnaissance material and must be in use during reconnaissance. The competitor must either have a USB connection in the car or reserve a USB battery for tracking devices and charge the device throughout the reconnaissance. Reconnaissance is allowed only two times on special stages, including special stages driven two times

The organizer is supervizing the amount of reconnaissances with the tracking device.

Competitor must move his/her GPS tracking device in his/her rally car after the reconnaissance and prior to his/her starting time for the 1st part of the rally.

Competitors are obligated to follow stop signals of Rally Officials with official IDs under the penalty of refusal to start.

A detailed reconnaissance schedule can be found in the Rally Guide, which is for that part a part of these regulations.

Reconnaissance for competitors in classes 13-24 is not allowed If a driver or his/her delegate of class 13-24 is found prior to his/her starting time on rally routes the driver will be prohibited to participate in the rally. This does not exclude a possible extra sanctions by ASN.













Speeding iolationuring reconnaissance

The Clerk of the course can impose the following sanctions for speeding during the reconnaissance measured with speed control device by the police or the organizer.

violation: Warning violation: Fine 90 € violation: Fine 200 € violation: Refusal to start

Speeding violation during the rally

The Clerk of the course can impose the following sanctions for speeding during the competition or in the service area measured with speed control device by the police or the organizer Or for shutting off GPS-tracking device Can organiser impose following sanctions:

- violation: Written caution and a 90 € fine. If the violation exceeds 30 km/h, the Clerk of the course can disqualify the competitor from the competition.
- violation: A sanction defined by the Clerk of the course which can be a max. 500€ fine or disqualification from the competition.

10. ADVERTISING

Organizer advertisements (Hotelli Sorsanpesä and J.Rinta-Jouppi Oy advertisiments) will be placed on the competition number.

The windshield ad is available for the competitor's own use. The ad must however fill the definitions of Rally sports regulations (art 17.2)

11. RALLY REGULATIONS

The starting times for each competitor will be published according to the program on the official notice board.

Competitors of classes 1-20 must pick up a transponder from the rally office (Hotelli Sorsanpesä) an hour prior to the starting time and attach it to his/her rally car before the start according to the regulations along with the GPS tracking device.

Competitors of classes 21-24 must pick up a transponder and the GPS tracking device from the rally office (Hotelli Sorsanpesä) two (2) hours prior to the starting time and attach the devices to his/her rally car according to the regulations.

Competition part 1

Organizer holds the right to lenghten or shorten startingtimes at the start and/or at starttimes of Special stages

The competitors will receive their time cards from TC located in Hotelli Sorsanpesä

The starts will be given every minute on 15th of June 2019 starting at 7.01pm

The start of the rally doesnt have a Parc Fermé area.













If a competitor retires part1 or his/her right to start part 1 is denied by the Clerk of the course the competitor has the possibility to try to repair the car and participate in part 2 of the competition

The competitor must inform his/her willingness to continue the rally in a written form to the rally office on 14th of Jun 2019 11.59pm at the latest.

If a competitor is unable to participate on special test, his/her time will be counted as the best time of the class +5min. Should he/she retire on friday on last transition, he/she will receive a five-minute penalty.

After the repairs, the competitor has to report to the Parc Fermé at least one hour before the start time of the first competitor for part2. Only the cars approved in this inspection are granted the right to start part 2.

The competitors retired on part 1 must return the GPS tracking device to the rally office on 14th of June 11:59pm at the latest or hand out the device to the sweeper car, even if the competitor is going to continue on part 2.

Night break - Parc Fermé

Night break Parc Fermé area is located in Educational center SEDU area, address Törnäväntie 26, 60200 Seinäjoki.

This does not apply to the retired cars continuing on part2.

This does not apply to competitors of class 13.

Class 13's GPS-tracking devices are collected at the finish by TC 3C

When arriving to night break Parc Fermé area TC will collect all GPS tracking devices from the competitors. (Classes 1-12 and 14-20)

Competition part 2

Part 2 starting order is the same as in part 1 for both the retired and the active competitors

The competitors must pick up a GPS tracking device from the rally office (Hotelli Sorsanpesä) half an hour (30 min) prior to the starting time for Part 2 and attach it to the rally car before the start. This applies also for competitors retired on Part 1 continuing to Part 2.

The first competitor starts for part 2 on Saturday 15th of June 2019 at 9:01am from the overnight Parc Ferme. The competitors are allowed to enter the Parc Ferme area 15 minutes prior to their starting time at the earliest. Attaching tracking device is allowed. The first competitor starting for part 2 must be at the TC 3 F at 9:01 (TC 3 F = overnight Parc Ferme out and service B in)

The competitors will receive a time card from 2 TC 3 F at their own starting time. classes 21 - 24 leave according to the timetable from service TC 3H where they receive their time card.













12. COMPETITOR MATERIAL

Competitors in classes 1-12 will receive a Road Book with detailed information on the route and two (2) pieces of route maps during administrative checks on Thursday 6:30pm-8:30pm and on friday starting at 6.30am from rally office

Competitors in classes 13-24 will receive a Road Book with detailed information on the route and two (2) pieces of route maps from the rally office in exchange for an approved scrutineering document two hours prior to their starting time.

The competitors must follow the route also between special stages, otherwise they can be excluded from the competition.

13. BREAKS

Overnight - Parc Fermé, doesnt apply to competitors of classes 13 and 21-24

Overnight Parc Fermé area is located in Educational center SEDU area, address Törnäväntie 26, 60200 Seinäjoki.

This doesn't apply to competitors retired on part 1 continuing to part 2.

Regrouping halts, doesn't apply to competitors of class 13

On route on Saturday 15th of June 2019 there is one(1) Regrouping halt that resides in servicearea on Rengastien Autotarvike, Rengastie 28, 60120 Seinäjoki

Length of regrouping halt is maximum of 20 min (minimum of 4 min.)

14. SCRUTINEERING

Safety scrutineering is organized at Rengastien Autotarvike premises, address Rengastie 28, 60120 Seinäjoki, phone+358400420458

Scrutineering for classes 1-20 on Friday 14th of june 2019 at 12:00pm - 7:00pm. Scrutineering for classes 21-24 Saturday 15th of june 2019 starting at 8:30am.

Scrutineering schedule will be announced when the Rally Guide is published. Each competitor must book their own scrutineering time at https://slotti.fi/booking/rallism/ between thursday 6th of June 2019 9:00pm - Tuesday 11th of June 2019 10:00pm . booking doesnt apply to classes 21-24. classes 21-24 scrutineering timetable is published in the rally guide.













Scrutineering closes 10 minutes after the last scrutineering time of each class.

If the competitor wishes to change their scheduled scrutineering time after the booking system has closed the organizer will charge 50 € for the change. The same fee applies if the organizer books the scrutineering time when the competitor hasn't booked it or if the competitor is late for his/her scheduled scrutineering time.

The competitor or his/her delegate must sign up at the scrutineering office (Rengastien Autotarvike, Rengastie 28, 60120 Seinäjoki) 10 minutes prior to their own scheduled scrutineering time for stating that the rally car has arrived on time and checking the documentation. After an approved documentation check the competitor or his/her delegate will receive the scrutineering documentary with arrival time filled in and proceed with the car towards the scrutineering.

Sealing

The spare parts registrated and sealed for the competition will be inspected and if needed sealed on Friday 14th of June 2018 during scrutineering. More detailed instructions in the Rally Guide which on that part is a part of these regulations.

Amount of tires

The total length of the special stages of the competition is 116 km. It is allowed to use ten (10) tyres in the competition according to Series rulebook, art.16.4. Tyre marking and checking will take place according to FRC regulations, art.16.2.

16. PRIZES AND AWARD CEREMONY
