Tyres

OKJ: Vega Option (CIK) OK: LeCont Prime (CIK)

-During Free practice sessions and Warm up: no limitation of quantity -In Powerpark Karting Race: 2 sets slick and 2 sets rain

Fuel

Only PANTA fuel is recommended to be used in the Powerpark Karting Race.

Chassis and engines

-No limitation of quantity of used chassis during the Powerpark Karting Race (same brand as entered)

-No limitation of quantity of used engines during the Powerpark Karting Race (same brand as entered)

-All karts must cover CIK technical regulations at all times.

-During Free practice sessions all karts must be fitted with TRANSPONDER and at least front and rear number plates with drivers race number.

-In case you don't have a transponder the organizer will provide you with one.

-There will be a 200EUR penalty for each driver who doesn't have a transponder on his/her kart, penalty must be paid before next session at the Race office by credit card or cash.

At the free practice and the Powerpark Karting Race, we are using numbers from World Championship 2019 entry list. The list for numbers used in Powerpark Karting Race will be published on our website next week.
