



BULLETIN NO 1

SM Mad-Croc Länsirannikon Rally, Time Control instructions due Covid-19. All contacts will be minimum.

TIME CARD / TIME CONTROL STATIONS

- a. Time Card will not be given to personnel at time control. Time card is shown through window at wanted moment / minute for personnel by competitors
- b. Personnel marks this time to time keeping system and also manually to stages time control table.
- c. Time Control Personnel shows this time control marking, TC information and possible target time for the stage for competitors. This is shown clearly by separate sign.
- d. Competitors marks these times, which shown by Time Control Personnel's, to their own Time Card by themselves.

START OF STAGE

- e. When competitors arrive to start line of the stage, co-driver shows their time card by showing it through the window without opening it for personnel's to see it.
- f. Personnel's at TC marks competitors exact start time for time keeping system and manually to stages time control table.
- g. Personnel shows the exact start time and Time Control information for competitors one minute before exact start time.
- h. Competitors mark this exact start time to Time Card by themselves
- i. If you receive an bulletin at the start of the special stage => when you have understand it, acknowledge it in the acknowledgments list on the last page of the road book.

STOP-SIGN

- j. At stop sign of the stage, competitors are shown by personnel's of TC their time of arrival by the accuracy of 1/10 sec.

FALCE MARKS AT THE TIME CARD

- k. If competitors mark their time card wrong themselves, must this be informed at time card and inform Rally Organizers by phone (Competitor Relations Officer).

If Stage is cancelled or start is delayed:

- l. SS TC Personnel's continue working from "TC-Cars".
- m. Competitors in queue visit to show their time card for TC-car at their time want to be marked.
- n. TC Personnel's inform competitors time to mark to their Time Card, and sets this time to time keeping system.
- o. Competitors in queue must obey safety clearance with fellow competitors. Face Mask is highly recommended.





Competition steward change

Competition steward is changed, Mr. Jani Hänninen changed to Mr. Jarmo Leivo.

Regulations art 15.1 addition to Tyre Regulations

Minimum tread deep of the tires need to be at least 1.6mm during the competition.

The tire compound is free.

If a competitor registers a maximum of 8 tires for use in the entire race, these tires may be used in the race on both days.
