4. GENERAL INFORMATION

The rally will be run in compliance with the effective National Sporting Regulations and Finnish Rally Championship 2022 regulations, as well as these SM Mad-Croc Länsirannikon Ralli supplementary regulations which AKK Motorsport has approved with Visa No. 9/R/22. There will be supplementary regulations published in English, but in contradictory situations the Finnish supplementary regulations are ruling.

Total distance of the itinerary for classes 1-8 is 378,06 km including 9 Special Stages with a total distance of 105,64 km. Of which two stages on Friday are completely on tarmac with an overall length of 16,99 km and on Saturday with circa 600m.

Total distance of the itinerary for classes 9-13 and 14-25 is 305,85 km including 7 Special Stages with a total distance of 88,65 km. Of which circa 600 m are driven on tarmac.

If a driver or his/her delegate is met on the roads in Masku, Nousiainen, Mynämäki, Rusko, Aura and Lieto in the yellow, grey, black or unmarked roads on the road map of Finland before the competitor's start time, excluding designated reconnaissance time for classes 1-8 and 14-19 according to the supplementary regulations Art. 10, the competitor will be excluded from the Rally.

6. ENTRY

Everyone who wants to participate in SM Mad-Croc Länsirannikon Ralli must register via KIT1 portal, competitors from outside of Finland must use the entry form found in the Official Notice Board.

Upon entering the rally, competitors must state the fuel they are using and the fueling method in Kiti portal under "Further information".

By the order of the entries, first 130 crews who have completed the registration according to the rules are accepted for the rally. Possible eliminations is performed from the extra classes, not from the competitors competing for the Western Finland local championship competitors.

Registration must be with the organizer no later than 3.5.2022 at 21:00 local time.

Usage of the competitor's information by the organizer:

Upon completing the registration competitors accept the usage of his/her personal information by the organizer and publication of the pre-determined personal information (name, nationality etc.) in the entry list, results etc. Rally media.

8. DOCUMENT CHECK

The competitor's document check will be done online.

Online **forms must be returned no later than 10.5.2022 at 22:00 local time.**

Instructions / links to the forms are found on the Official Notice Board.

9. SERVICE AND REGROUP

Centralized Service Park is used in the Rally and servicing is allowed only in this area.

Service Park will be opened on Friday 13.5.2022 at 07:00 local time.

Contradictory to the FRC regulations there is no parking for Reconnaissance cars in the Service Park area. Parking area is located with the trailer park and it is located in the immediate vicinity of the Service Park area. Further instructions will be provided in the Rally Guide, which is part of the Supplementary Regulations.

Regroup on the itinerary maximum of 20 minutes, minimum of 0 minutes.

10. TIRES

The make and model of the tyres used in the competition are unrestricted as long as they comply with the FRC regulations. However the tyre make, model (surface tread) and the diameter of the rim used on Friday 13.5.2022 has to be the same as in the tyres used on Saturday 14.5.2022. This applies to all crews taking part in Leg 1.

Differing from the FRC regulations, a maximum of 10 tires are allowed in FRC and Suomi Cup – classes. During this Rally the usage of two of these tires are restricted to be used only on Friday 13.5.2022 on special stages 1-2.

These tires must be marked in the tyre code form's first two rows with an extra marking "PE". The competitor has the right to carry a maximum of two spare tires.

Competitors from classes 1-7 must deliver the organizer a list of all the tyres to be used in the rally by filling the series tyre code form. The form must be returned no later than Friday 13.5.2022 at 18:00 local time via email to rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi. The tyre code form is found on the Official Notice Board. In case the competitor has tires that are missing the FIA Barcode or the barcode is located only on one side of the tyre, contact Chief Scrutineer Juho Laaksonen phone number +358 41 5279 0099 the day before the start of the Rally at latest. Failing to return the tyre code form will result in the cancellation of entry.

CHASSIS

The usage of a special chassis made for tarmac driving is prohibited. The ends of the suspension rods are marked in scrutineering and upon inspection there must be the same or a similar part attached in the car. Broken part can be replaced with a part identical in measure. According to the Regulations Art. 34.2. the marking made by scrutineering must not be removed before the end of the technical inspection. Anti-roll bars according to the class regulations.





11. REFUELING

The competitor must declare what fuel is used and the method of refueling at the time of the entry.

Refueling is allowed in the areas marked in the road book or the refueling zone pointed by organizer.

The refueling zone of the rally in in the vicinity oh the Service Park from own containers to the refuelers.

Further instructions and the map of the area are found in the Rally Guide, which is a part of the Supplementary Regulations.

12. RECONNAISSANCE

Competitors may collect the reconnaissance material on Thursday 12.05.2022 at 18.00-21.00 and on Friday 13.05.2022 07.00-11.00 Reconnaissance is allowed in classes 1-8 and 14-19.

Upon the collection of the reconnaissance material, 1st driver's license and 2nd driver's I.D. are checked.

Special Stages may be driven only two (2) times through, including special stages driven twice in the rally.

GPS tracking devices are given with the reconnaissance material and they must be in use for the whole duration of the reconnaissance. The competitors must have a USB power outlet in his/her reconnaissance car for the GPS device and it must be powered for the whole reconnaissance. Competitors are obligated to follow stopping requests of the Rally Officials with the organizer's badges, or the penalty will be refusal to start.

The organizer is monitoring for possible speeding with the GPS device. After the reconnaissance, before the competitor's starting time for the section 1 the driver must move the GPS tracking device to his/her rally car.

In classes 14-19 the competitors must move the GPS tracking device to their rally car before the start of the rally.

Organizer provided two (2) reconnaissance car identifications must be fitted in the middle and up of the windscreen and to the right back side window and must be visible for the whole reconnaissance time.

The speed limit of 80 km/h is valid on all Special Stages during the reconnaissance unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organizer. Driving during the reconnaissance must not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people close by. Driving in the opposite direction of the rally is prohibited. The organizer will enforce driving speed and manners during the reconnaissance. The local police will also supervise on the route and may penalize traffic infringements according to the Finnish Traffic Law.

Competitors are obligated to follow stopping requests of the Rally Officials with the organizer's badges, or the penalty will be refusal to start.

Reconnaissance starts 13.05.2022 at 8.00 and ends at 18.00

13. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

The competition number bases used in the Rally are according to the FRC Regulations.

14. SAFETY SCRUTINEERING

Safety scrutineering will be held in the Peltola Ammatti-instituutti, Hamppukatu 2, 20740 Turku.

Entering the area with transport equipment is FORBIDDEN.

15. COMPETITOR MATERIAL

Classes 1-8 and 14-19 crews are handed a road book that indicates the detailed itinerary, 2 x road maps, door numbers and GPS tracking device for the Reconnaissance from the Rally Office on Thursday 12.05.2022 between 18:00 and 21:00 and on Friday 13.05.2022 starting from 07:00.

In classes 14-19 the competitors are obligated to collect the timing transponder on Saturday after an accepted scrutineering.

Classes 9-13 and 20-25 crews may collect the material from Rally Office on Saturday 14.05.2022 starting from 07:00 local time.

Upon collection of the competitor material in the Rally Office the 1st driver's license is inspected, in Nuorten SM -classes 1st driver's I.D. - Identification card, driver's license, passport, the 2nd driver's I.D. - Identification card, driver's license, passport etc., in Nuorten SM 2nd driver's license.

Competitors will receive the timing transponder and GPS tracking device from the Rally Office after an accepted scrutineering.

16. START

Start time of each crew will be published according to the programme on the official notice board.

An international time card is used and cards can be found in roadbook.

Instructions for using the card and map of the start place can be found in the Rally Guide

The start of the competition 13.05.2022 at 20.01 one (1) minute apart for classes 1 to 8.

Section 2 start times and re-placed competitor's start times are published Friday evening as scheduled in programme.

Route given in the Road Book must be followed on the liaison sections, under penalty of exclusion by the Clerk of the Course.

17. RESULTS

The provisional results will be published by class according to the schedule in the Rally Guide on the Official Notice Board. The official results will be found on the Official Notice Board and KITI portal.

18. PRIZES AND PRIZE GIVING

The number of awarded competitors will be published at the Official Notice Board.

The prizes will be given to the both competitors according to the provisional/official results. The official prize giving schedule will be declared by class in Rally Guide.
