3. ORGANISER

The organizer is Lahti Historic Rally ry.

This rally competition will be held under the National Sporting regulations of AKK-Motorsport, Historic Rally Trophy 2022 series regulations, Sporting Regulations FIA Trophy for Historic Regularity Rallies and Finnish Rally Championship regulations which are approved by the AKK Motorsport in ASN Visa number 19/R/22.

4. DESCRIPTION

Historic Rally Trophy Finland event

Total distance of the rally is approx. 560 km, including 12 special stages (six separate road sections driven twice) and total special stage distance is approx. 154 km.

If a competitor or someone on behalf of competitor is found in Orimattila or Hämeenlinna city or Asikkala, Hausjärvi, Hollola, Janakkala tai Pukkila region roads marked in yellow, grey, black on the road map of Finland or non-marked roads before competitors starting time their right to participate to the rally is denied. This won't rule out possible sanction from National Sporting organization AKK-Motorsport ry. (Exception section 11. Reconnaissance)

5. CLASSES

Cars participating in classes 1 to 23 must have a FIA HTP, or an old passport (expired FIA HTP issued on 10/2007 or later).

Cars participating in HTRS (Regularity class 24) may alternatively have either an FIA HTP, or an old passport (expired FIA HTP issued on 10/2007 or later), HRCP (Historic Regularity Car Pass) or FIVA IC (Federation International Vehicles Anciens Identification Card).

Cars participating in the HN (Showrun class 25) must have a valid FIA HTP, an old passport (expired FIA HTP issued on 10/2007 or later).

5.1. Competitors

Competition is a Historic Rally Trophy Finland and Qualifying Event for 2022 FIA Trophy for Historic regularity rallies status. Competition has also a NEAFP status and thereby open for other countries ASN competitor licence holders.

Competitors are obligated to have an insurance for their vehicle also for the special stages, so that it covers accidents to the third party. (Red plate)

Historic Rally Trophy Finland

In Historic Rally Trophy classes of Varaosaexpert Rally, you can use FIA standard seats and seat belts which validity dates aren't ruling. Seats and seat belts have to be in prime condition, and they are checked in the scrutineering. (Rally regulations 2022, section 16.)

Classes are not combined.



6.1. Competitor information used by the organisation

When entering to the competition, a competitor accepts their personal data handled by the organizer and the specific information (name, club...) published in the participation list, results for example.

7.1. Payment

8. COMPETITOR MATERIAL AND DOCUMENT INSPECTION

Foreign competitors must send their information to rally organization (contact information, information for announcer etc.) advised by the Rally Secretary.

Competition material is collected from the Rally HQ; classes 19–23 starting Wednesday 10.8.2022 at 07:30 and Thursday 11.8.2022 at 06:30.

Non-reconnaissance classes 24–29 collect competition material starting on Friday 12.8.2022 at 07:30.

GPS Tracking device is given at the same time. Transponder is given at RH on the first rally day of own class.



Only one competitor to the collecting of the materials, personal identity is checked!

Competitors receive their international timecards from the time control station at the rally start.

9. SERVICE

Service is allowed only on the Service Park which organizer has pointed out. In two day's rally (Fri-Sat 12.–13.8.2022) there are three service brake; after SS 3, SS 6 and SS 9. In one day rally there is one service brake, after SS 9.

10. TYRES

It is permitted to use tyres that comply with Finnish Motorsport Regulations.

11. REFUELLING

Refueling is allowed at the fuel stations marked in the roadbook at pump areas or nearby the fuel stations in separate areas from their own cans. Please check Rally Guide for more information.

12. RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaisance (classes 19–23 and 30-35) by the program.

Classes 19–23 and 30-35 competitors may collect the reconnaissance material from the Rally HQ from 10.08.2022 07:30. When receiving and signing the reconnaissance material the competitor must give to the organizer information about the recce car and their phone number during the reconnaissance. The two (2) recce car signs which organizer hands to you must be attached to the recce car. One to the top center of the windscreen and one to the right rear window. These signs must be visible for the whole reconnaissance time.

The maximum speed limit is 80 km/h during reconnaissance on all special stages unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organizer. The competitor must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages. Driving against the direction of the rally is prohibited.

The organizer will control speeds as well as the manner of driving during reconnaissance. Also, the police will make checks along the route and will penalize for traffic infringements according to Finnish Traffic Law. If you neglect the organisers' official request to stop, the organizer has right to deny competitors start permission.

Reconnaissance is on Wednesday 10.08.2022 from 08:30 to 17:30 and on Thursday 11.8.2022 from 07.00 to 16.00.

Classes 1–18 and 36–44 are not allowed to reconnaissance.



13. Scrutineering

Scrutineering is on Friday 12.08.2022 starting at 08:00 at Autosalpa Oy, Vanhanradankatu 2, 15520 Lahti.

Scrutineering schedule and other instructions for the scrutineering are given in the Rally Guide.

Scrutineering ends 10 min after the scheduled time for the last competitor.

14. NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

Competition number stickers with organizers ads are size 50 cm * 50 cm.

Adverts for the competition numbers: on top Varaosaexpert and on bottom Autosalpa.

Adverts for the windscreen in the title competition: according to the HRT series regulations: SILVASTI

Other adverts: according to the HRT series regulations.

15. THE PROGRESS OF THE COMPETITION

Start list to the rally is published according to the programme on the Official Notice Board on Sportity App. Competitors receive their timecard from start (TC 0) at Lahti Harbor.

All competitors use international timecards. The organizer publishes an info about the international timecard use at the Official Notice Board.

Competition starts to the Leg 1: classes 1–35 (Friday 12.08.2022) after last EM Lahti Historic Rally competitor from Lahti harbor at 1-minute interval. (EM Lahti Historic Rally 1st competitor starts at 09.31) Time is informed later in the Rally Guide which for that part is part of the regulations.

For the Leg 2 (Saturday 13.08.2022) classes 1–44 start from the Parc Fermé Hansatalo parking hall after the last Lahti Historic Rally competitor. (Lahti Historic Rally 1st competitor starts at 07:51) Estimated start time is informed later in the Rally Guide which for that part is part of the regulations. Official start times are announced in the Official Notice Board.

If competitor neglects to follow the route given in the roadbook the Clerk of the Course excludes the competitor from the competition.



Super Rally

Competitor who is retired from the Leg 1 is allowed to join for the Leg 2.

The special stages which competitor didn't finish is given the fastest time +5min. For the competitor who retired on the Leg 1 last liaison is given 5min time penalty.

Competitor must inform their willingness to continue the competition to the Clerk of the Course no later than 12.8.2022 at 23:00. After repairs the rally car must be in Parc Fermé on Saturday 13.8.2022 morning at the latest one hour before first HRT-competitor starting time. The Stewarts or the Clerk of the Course can order a re-scrutineering for the rally car. The start order for the restarters decides the Clerk of the Course.

17. RESULTS

Provisional class results will be published according to the Rally Guide in the Official Notice Board and results are published in KITI-kisapalvelu portal, www.lahtihistoricrally.fi and on the Official Notice Board at Sportity App.

18. PRIZES AND PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The number of rewarded by class is published in the Official Notice Board.

Both drivers will be rewarded at the podium according to provisional results at Lahti harbor. If the results change after the prize giving ceremony the competition is responsible to return the reward. The schedule for the prize giving ceremony is published in the Rally Guide. All competitors must participate in the ceremony. In case of force majeur permission for absence may be granted only by the Clerk of the Course.

Class 24 competitors will get both day's prizes at the same time at Lahti Harbour on Saturday 13.08.2022.
