4. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Hämeenlinna Historic Rally follows the regulations imposed by ASN of Finland (AKK-Motorsport ry) including the Finnish Sporting Code, Finnish Rally Regulations, regulations of Historic Rally Trophy, regulations of Aircooled Rally Series, regulations of BMW Rally Series and these Supplementary Regulations of Hämeenlinna Historic Rally. The Supplementary Regulations have been approved by AKK-Motorsport with competition licence number **5/R/23**.

In situations of ambiguity, the original Finnish version of Supplementary Regulations is decisive.

The complete rally route total length is approx. 160 km including 5 Special Stages, with combined length of approx. 60 km.

If any competitors or persons working for them are met on the non-arterial roads in the regions of Hämeenlinna, Tammela or Hattula, before their official start time, their participation to the event is prohibited. (Exception for classes 19 – 23, 26, 27 and 39 – 42 during the reconnaissance on Friday 10.2.2023)

The competition follows the regulations of the Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports (FINCIS), which can be found at <https://suek.fi/en/>, as well as the legislation regarding doping.

6. ENTRY PROCEDURE



Competitors who want to participate in the Hämeenlinna Historic Rally should do the entry procedure in the KITI system or ask the Secretary of the Rally for secondary entry instructions **by email from jenni.kuisma@gmail.com**.

Administrative check takes place online via Google Forms (instructions will be published in the Rally Guide).

One of the crew members must have a valid competitor's licence. Those who will enter with using one time licence must do the entry by filling the entry form found in the KITI system and the Sportity application and submit it **by email to the Secretary of the Rally jenni.kuisma@gmail.com**.

The maximum amount of competitors will be 160. If a qualification must be executed, it will take place from classes 35–43.

In Additional classes (classes 35 – 43), at least 3 participants are required. If the amount of entrants is smaller, the competitors of that class can be combined with another class.

Use of competitor information by the organizer:

When entering for the competition, the competitor accepts the processing of personal data provided by the organizer as well as the publication of specified (name, club, car etc.) personal data in the entry list, classifications, etc. in the communication of the competition.

7. ENTRY FEES

The driver's licence number must be used as the reference number. If the driver will enter by using one time licence, the co-driver licence number must be used as the reference number.

8. SERVICE

Please notice that servicing is prohibited at the area of Rally HQ, because the HQ is located in the groundwater area.

There will be a service break in the Rally. Rally Guide will include more details and itinerary of the service break.

A service place is reserved for each crew.

If competitors have a common service with some other crew, it must be informed to the Service area contact person not later than **8.2.2023**.

In each service vehicle must have a 6 kg fire extinguisher, a liquid impermeable Environmental Mat ready to use and a liquid impermeable Environmental Mat under the rally car at least the size of its bottom surface.

9. TIRES

In the competition must use tires according to Finnish ASN rally regulations of 2023.

Please notice:



The following road sections must drive using winter tires according to Finnish Road Traffic Act

- First road section from start of the rally to service area
- After SS5 from tire changing area to finish of the rally

10. REFUEL

There is only one gas station with two gasoline pistols of 98E on the rally route. For this reason a refueling area has been arranged in the service area, where refueling from the own containers is possible.

11. RECONNAISSANCE (only classes 19 – 23, 26, 27 and 39 – 42)

Reconnaissance materials and competition materials can be collected from **Cafe Raparperi (Käräjämäentie 2, 14300 Renko) starting on Friday 10.2.2023 at 7.30 am**. Competitor must have given the organizer the information about the reconnaissance car and phone number where reached during the reconnaissance. Informations is given in online administrative check.

Reconnaissance identification number stickers (2) must be attached to the used car (windscreen top centre, right rear side window) and kept visible for the whole duration of the reconnaissance.

A maximum speed limit of 80 km/h is in place during the whole reconnaissance on all special stages, unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organiser. The competitor must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages. Driving against the direction of the rally is prohibited, unless directed so by the organiser, their representative, or the police. The organizer will control speeds used as well as the manner of driving during reconnaissance. Also the police will make checks along the route and will penalise for traffic infringements according to Finnish Road Traffic Act.

Any stopping request by the organizers representatives with the organizers identifiers must be followed, under penalty of disqualification from the event.

Reconnaissance is allowed only on friday **10.2.2023 to 8.00 am to 5.00 pm**.

13. SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering will be held at Ammattiopisto Tavastia, **Hattelmalantie 8, 13100 Hämeenlinna**.

Please notice: Competitors must arrive to the Scrutineering by driving winter tires according to Finnish Road Traffic Act.

Saturday 11.2. at 8.00 am and classes 1–18, 26 and 28–34 (without reconnaissance) from Ammattiopisto Tavastia starting at Saturday 11.2 at 8:30 am.

15. START OF THE RALLY

Start list will be published at the Sportity application according to itinerary of the event.

Competitors will collect the Time Card from the TC0.

Start of the Regularity Rally is at 9:41 am, The starting time of the first HRT competitor is determined according to the number of competitors in the Regularity Rally and Show class. More detailed starting time will be published in the Rally Guide.

Start of the rally takes place at 11.2. from Koulutuskeskus Tavastia. Competitors are sent to the route in every 1 minute. Route given in the Road Book must be followed throughout the the rally, under penalty of disqualification from the event

16. BREAK

There will be a break in the Rally. Starting time from the break is given from TC3B.

17. RESULTS

Publication of provisional classification at Sportity application (schedule by class will be published in the Rally Guide).

Final results will be published at the Sportity application and in the KITI system.

18. PRIZE GIVING SEREMONY

The list of prize winners will be published at the Sportity application.
