4. GENERAL

Total length of the route is approximately 165 km, including 4 Special Stages, in total 67 SS kms.

If a competitor or someone on behalf of competitor is found in Jämsä, Kuhmoinen or Orivesi region roads marked in yellow, grey, black on the road map of Finland or non-marked roads before competitors starting time their right to participate to the rally is denied, excluding reconnaissance period in classes 19-23, 27 ja 42-45. This won't rule out possible sanction from National Sporting organization AKK-Motorsport ry. (Exception; section 10. Reconnaissance). There is camera surveillance on the route. The rally follows the regulations of the Finnish Sports Ethics Center (SUEK), which can be found at website: https://suek.fi/en/, as well as legislation regarding doping.

6. ENTRY PROCEDURE

Competitors who are willing to participate VI Kuhmoisten Sora rally, must place and entry to KITI-kisapalvelu portal or ask optional instructions for entry from rally secretariat by email; eve.kivitela@gmail.com.

Those who driving with a one-time license submit the registration to the secretary with complete information.

You can participate in classes 1-18, 24-26 and 28-41 with a one-time license. In this case, registration according to the secondary registration instructions to the rally secretary.

In Historic Rally Trophy rallies, cars can use seats according to FIA standards and seat belts, the validity date of which is not decisive. The condition of the equipment is checked in the scrutineering.

A maximum of 200 competitors registered in accordance with the rules will be accepted for the rally in order of registration. If a qualification must be carried out, a qualification will take place from additional classes, as well as from competitors outside AKK-Motorsport ASN region 4.

Use of competitor data by the rally organizer:

When registering for the rally, the competitor accepts the processing of the personal data they have provided by the rally organizer, as well as the publication of specified (name, club, etc.) personal data in the list of participants, list of results, etc. in the communication of the rally.

7. ENTRY FEES

Entry fee are following:

Registration and entry fee must be with the organizer no later than February 14th 2023 at 21:00. Payments must be made to account of Tullan Urheiluautoilijat ry:

The driver's competitor license number must be used as the reference number.

8. SERVICE

In the rally, service on the route is allowed, excluding service-prohibited areas.

The service cars must have at least a 6 kg fire extinguisher for each crew, as well as an oil marking mat ready for use, a liquid-impermeable cover (not a lightweight cover) under the race car at least the size of its bottom surface and a protective cover (not a light cover) under the service car the size of its engine compartment. Absence of any of these will lead to an immediate decision to excluded from the rally by the Clerk of the Course.

9. REFUEL

Refueling is only allowed at a station marked in the road book, from the station's own pumps.

Refueling elsewhere is prohibited. Refueling of cars using E85 and 2-T gasoline is carried out at the service station indicated in the road book, in the immediate vicinity of the meter field, from own fuel tanks.

10. RECONNAISSANCE

Starting at 8:30 a.m. on Friday 24 February, competitors can pick up reconnaissance material from the rally office. When the reconnaissance material as received, the competitor must give the organizer information about his recce car and his phone number. The two (2) reconnaissance car badges given by the organizer must be affixed to the windshield in the middle up and on the right rear window and must be visible throughout the reconnaissance period.

While reconnaissance on the route, a speed limit of 80 km/h is valid for all special tests, unless the speed has been set lower than this by traffic signs or signs placed on the terrain by the organizer. The driving style must be such that it does not endanger or disturb other traffic or nearby settlements. The organizer forbids driving against the driving direction of the Special Stage. The organizer performs speed and driving style monitoring during the reconnaissance period.

The police also supervise the route and punishes traffic violations in accordance with the Road Traffic Act. The call to stop by officials with the organizers' badges must be obeyed under the threat of being denied the right to start. The reconnaissance period starts on 24.02.2023 at 09:00 and ends on 24.02.2023 at 18:00. The number of passes on Special Stages is not limited.

11. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

The competition number stickers used in the rally are size 50 cm * 50 cm.

The Historic Rally Trophy series promotor, HRCF, reserves a place for the competitors of the HRT classes for the series windshield advertisement, and in addition, a 20 * 40 cm advertising space on both front doors. The stickers are distributed in connection with competitor materials and the presence of advertising stickers is checked during the scrutineering.

12. START

The competitors' actual starting times are announced according to the program on the rally's official noticeboard. Competitors will receive their timecard at the Start TC.

The rally start takes place at 10:01 in front of the Rally HQ, Kuhmola, start interval 1 minute. Failure to follow the rally route in liaison sections will result in disqualification from the rally, by the decision of Clerk of the Course.

13. COMPETITOR MATERIALS

Classes 1-18, 24-26 and 28-41 (non-reconnaissance classes); On paper checks, each crew receives a roadbook, which shows the route to be followed in detail and 2 route maps from Rally HQ in Kuhmola. More detailed instructions and schedule for registration are given in the Rally Guide.

Classes 19-23,27 and 42-45 (classes with reconnaissance); Each crew receives a reconnaissance material that shows the rally route in detail on paper checks at the Rally HQ in the office of Tullan UA, Toritie 64 (upper courtyard) on Friday 24.02.2023 from 08.30.

14. SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering starts at 8:01. The location and address is described in the Rally Guide. Scrutineering ends 10 minutes after the end of the scrutineering of the last competitor.

15. BREAK

There is one break in the rally.

16. RESULTS

The publication of provisional results according to the schedule will be published in the Rally Guide. The final results will be published on the rally's official noticeboard, and the final official results can be found in the KITI system and the SPORTITY application.

17. PRIZES AND PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The number of prize winners will be announced on the official noticeboard in Sportity. Prizes will be awarded to both drivers of the crew at the Rally HQ, Kuhmola, Toritie 57, Kuhmoinen.

All award-winning competitors must attend the prize giving ceremony. For compelling reasons permission to be absent can only be given by the Clerk of the Course.
