### TRAILER PARKING:

In the service park, it is not possible to unload race cars from the trailer.

The dismantling of the equipment takes place in the vicinity of the service park (marked on the attached map of the competition centre), from where the trailers must be moved to their own parking area immediately after the equipment has been unloaded.

The organizer reserves maintenance areas in accordance with the Finnish Championship and RJSM series rules for each pair of competitors and those driving for the team championship. Voluntary paper inspection and distribution of materials for classes 8-12 and 22-27 on Friday 3.3.2023 until 18.00 and on Saturday 4.3.2023 from 6.00 at Gradia Jyväskylä Viitaniemi, Viitaniementie 1 A 40720 Jyväskylä.

#### To competitors are distributed:

- Reconnaissance car number code 2 pcs classes 1-7 and 13-21
- competition numbers 4 pcs (2 pcs for doors, 2 pcs for windows)
- GPS safety tracker and timing transponder

#### RECONNAISSANCE, CLASSES 1 – 7 AND 13 -15

Reconnaissance material can be collected at the Rally Office starting on Thursday, 18,00 – 20,00.

Competitors must provide the organizer with the following information regarding the Reconnaissance car details, phone number and accommodation details. The competitor must also provide the organizer with a phone number that can be used to reach him at any time.

Reconnaissance identification numbers (2) must be attached to the used car (windscreen top centre, right rear side window) and kept visible for the whole duration of the reconnaissance.

A maximum speed limit of 80 km/h is in place during the whole reconnaissance on all special stages, unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organiser. The competitor must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages. Driving against the direction of the rally is prohibited, unless directed so by the organiser, their representative, or the police. The organizer will control speeds used as well as the manner of driving during reconnaissance. Also the police will make checks along the route and will penalise for traffic infringements according to Finnish Traffic Law. Any stopping request by the organizers representatives with the organizers' identifiers must be followed, under penalty of disqualification from the event.

Any infringements during reconnaissance will be punished in accordance with Section 9.1 of the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations.

#### GPS – safety device

Competitors will be given the GPS-safety device with the reconnaissance material.

GPS Device must be installed at the reconnaissance cars and kept power on for whole reconnaissance.

GPS device must be installed with USB-power unit.

Reconnaissance is allowed two times / each stage.

#### Reconnaissance cars

Only road homologated tyres are allowed during reconnaissance. In the reconnaissance car, there must be warm overalls for drivers, a snow shovel, a first aid kit, a tow rope and a reflecting triangle to be used for warning following cars in case of road blockage.

Reconnaissance starts on Friday 03/03/2023 at 07.00 and will end on Friday 03/03/2023 at 17:00

Organizer will inform about conditions on the route on the Virtual Official Noticeboard.

#### Speeding during reconnaissance:

The Clerk of the Course can impose the following sanctions for speeding during the reconnaissance measured with the speed control device by the police or the organizer:

1. Penalty = warning
2. Penalty = fine 90 €
3. Penalty = fine 200€
4. Penalty = Right to start will be denied

#### Speeding during the rally:

The Clerk of the Course can impose the following sanctions for speeding during the route sections measured with the speed control device by the police or the organizers GPS-device:

1. Penalty = Note and fine 90€
  2. Penalty = Penalty defined by organization. max 500€ or disqualifying from the rally.
- Penalty's must be paid with the organization before the start.

#### PRE-EVENT SCRUTINEERING

A safety scrutineering will be arranged Gradia Jyväskylä Viitaniemi Viitaniementie 1 A 40101 Jyväskylä.

The safety scrutineering starts on Fri 3.3.2023 at 13.00 (classes 1-7 and 13-15) and ends at 18.00.

For classes 8-12 and 16-27, there is an opportunity for a safety scrutineering on Fri 3.3.2023 at 18.30-21.00. Sat 4.3.2023 safety scrutineering for classes 8-12 and 16-27 from 9.00 a.m.

The Slot booking system opens on 24.2. at 12.00 and closes on 27.2. at 20.00.

If a competitor wants to change their scrutineering time after the booking system has closed, the competition organiser will withhold a fee of 50 €. The same fee is also charged for those cars that the organiser places after the competitor has not booked an appointment or if the contestant is late for the scrutineering time they have booked.

The scrutineering ends 10 minutes after the end of the inspection of the last competition number.

The contestant is obliged to submit the car information in accordance with the electronic procedure to the competition organiser **by Wednesday 1.3.2023 at 18.00** [rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi](mailto:rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi)  
**The email header should show the contestant's number and the name of the driver.**

- Pages 1 and 2 of the inspection card
- 1st page of Homologation or passport
- Security cage classification certificate or certificate
- Catalytic converter certificate
- Transfer permit/extract from the register
- A condition survey certificate or certificate of an approved annual survey

The documents submitted as attachments must be scanned with high quality. The absence of papers prevents the performance of a scrutineering.

An objection to the car's technique that a competitor intends to make to a co-competitor's car during the race should always be made by phone to the phone number indicated by the organizer in the road book, before the objected car arrives at the race finish AT. After that, the representatives of the technique take the their car surveillance. The organiser of the competition must verify the identity of the person making the objection. During the race, any objection to the car's technique must be made in writing at the latest as soon as arrival to the finish TC.

### 13.1. Sealing

The spare parts to be registered and sealed for the competition will be inspected and, if necessary, sealed on Friday 3.3.2023 in connection with the safety inspection.

### 13.3. Technical inspection

Final inspection site is Gradia Jyväskylä Viitaniemi Viitaniementie 1 A 40720Jyväskylä.

The safety inspection ends 10 minutes after the end of the inspection period for the last competition number.

## TYRES

It is permitted to use 10 tyres that comply with Finnish Rally Championship Regulations of 2023, Chapter 16 Tire Regulations. In Classes 1-6 competitors must submit a list of barcode numbers for the tyres according to the following schedule:

- Tyres for rally: must be announced by Friday 3/3/2023 at 17.00 at [rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi](mailto:rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi)

The information is submitted using a digital form to which a link is provided at the Virtual Official Noticeboard.

### RACE BIKES ARE NOT ALLOWED TO RIDE TO PARC FERME!

The use of additional lights is allowed on Fri 3.3.2023 on special stage 1.



Barcode numbers must be available for reading on the outside facing side of tyres. Scrutineer officers must be allowed to do markings to tires and rims. In case competitor do not have FIA barcodes on tires, organizer will give alternative instructions. If you don't have barcodes you shall report it to the Rally Office or to the Chief Scrutineer at the latest the day before the pre-event scrutineering.

#### Classes 1-7 and 13-15

Between TC 1B and Start 2 for leg 2, use only road homologated winter tyres. These tyres are not counted in the number of tyres allowed.

## DURING THE EVENT

### GPS SAFETY TRACKERS AND TIMEKEEPING TRANSPONDER

The contestant must have the race organiser's timekeeping transponder and GPS safety tracker in their car.

The timing transponder and the GPS safety tracker will be distributed to the competitors upon registration. The equipment must be attached to the race car already when going to the scrutineering. With the exception of competitors doing reconnaissance who have the tracking device involved in the reconnaissance. However, the holder of the tracker must be attached to the race car when going to the scrutineering.

For all classes, the GPS safety tracker and timing transponder are collected immediately after the race finish TC.

In the event of an interruption, the competitor or service must immediately return the equipment to the competition office. There is no Track Opening Safety car from the race organiser in the competition, but the organiser of SS acts as a Safety cars. The equipment can be left at the Safety Car of the SS organizer or at the STOP point of the special test. N.B! The contestant is responsible for the equipment for the duration of the competition.

For an unreturned or mechanically broken timer ponder, the result service charges 150 euros.

### Special Stage Start

The list of eligible participants will be announced according to the programme on the official notice board of the competition In the Sportity app.

#### Timecard A

Competitors in grades 1-7 and 13-15 will receive their time cards on Fri 3.3.2023 at 18:58 TC 1. **Changed from Supplementary regulations.**

SST 1 output takes place at 19.01 every 2 minutes.

Time cards are taken away from competitors at TC Start B.

#### Timecard B

All competitors will receive their time cards on 4.3.2023 from 10.01 a.m. TC start B. **Changed from Supplementary regulations.**

Departure will take place on Saturday 4.3.2023 at 10.01 a.m. from Killeri horse race track at Vesangantie 24 40630 Jyväskylä every 1 minute.

The contestant must follow the race route specified by the organizer throughout the competition. Failure to follow the race route will always result in exclusion from the competition.

## PARC FERMÉ

Parc Fermé is located in the parking garage of Sokos Hotel Paviljonki in Jyväskylä at Uno Savolankatu P-Paviljonki 2 floor 1. N.B! The parking garage is a cool space, remains at plus degrees.

Parc Fermé is allowed to be attended by a race car crew and an additional two (2) servicemen 10 minutes before their own start time.

Parc Fermé has a night watch by the organizers of the competition. Be prepared to prove your identity when picking up your race car from Parc Fermé.

## SERVICE

All service operations and functions must be carried out in accordance with "Chapter 14. Service" in Finnish Rally Championship Series' Regulations of 2023 with the following additions.

The event Service Park is located at the Killeri horse racing track, which open for competitors on Friday 3/03/2023 at 06.30. All services are at same area.

Rally Guide will include details of the service park functions and contact persons.

The rally includes four service breaks at the Killeri Service Park.

In addition to requirements in the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations, competitors are responsible to protect the ground with a liquid impermeable Environmental Mat under all service vehicles during their full stay at the Service Park. The impermeable Environmental Mat must cover the whole surface area underneath the vehicle's engine. **Impermeable Environmental Mat must also be placed under any external electricity generators, heaters and other fuel containing receptacles.**

**Service A, Friday 3.3, classes 1 – 7 and 13-15, tyre change for Road-homologated tyres and free service. Between stage 1 and Parc Ferme Nightbrake. Servicetime aprox 15min.**

**Service B, Saturday, 4.3. Classes 1-7 and 13-15, tyre change and free service. Between Parc Ferme and Start for leg 2. tyre change and free service, servicetime aprox 15min.**

**Service C, Sat 4.3. all classes, after stage 3, flexiservice 30min.**

**Service D, sat 4.3, all classes, after stage 5, flexiservice 30min.**

### Service C and D are Flexi Services

When arriving at these services' Regrouping In TC, competitors will be given a Service Out time. The time includes 3 minutes for technical inspection (scrutineering), regrouping time and a service time of 30 minutes. The competitors may start the service at a time of their choosing by marking the start time on their timecard and placing the timecard visibly on the windscreen and outside the service tent on an A4 board / cardboard / paper so that the time is clearly visible from the service road. No changes or markings can be made to the timecard until the end of the service time, which must be marked on the timecard. The service time is monitored by the organizer with a round trip inspection, the inspectors must have an unobstructed access to the service area and there must be an unobstructed line of sight to the serviced rally car from outside the maintenance tent.

### Sanctions for infringements in service areas, remote services, refuelling areas and tyre and light fitting zones:

1st infringement: 300 €

2nd infringement: 800 €

3rd infringement: Disqualification applied by the Clerk of the Cours

## REFUEL ZONES

Refuelling is only allowed at petrol stations as determined by the Organiser, according to Art. 15. in the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations and at supplementary refuel zones as described in the competition materials.

Competitors must use their own fuel permitted to their class at refuelling zones in Killeri tank zone.

Visiting refuelling zones is optional. On the liaison sections it is allowed to refuel using pumps determined by road book.

The competitor shall indicate which refuelling method he wishes to use in the event entry form. Refuelling takes place either from the petrol station pump, or from competitor's own containers in the marked refuelling zones. Refuel Zones are listed in the itinerary, including distances and calculated consumption. Itinerary as appendix.

## RETIREMENT

If a contestant retires the competition, he or she must notify about the retirement as soon as possible to **the retirement number +358 400 240 081**, which can be found in the road book, or to inform the nearest TC station.

## ACTIONS OF COMPETITORS IN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT

If, in the event of an accident, medical or fire-fighting assistance is needed at the accident site, the SOS button on the tracking device is pressed and the SOS sign is displayed to the other competitors. The SOS sign should be clearly displayed to competitors coming to the accident site, and the sign cannot be left unattended.

If a competitor presses the SOS button of the tracking device in need of medical/extinguishing assistance, the competitor must display the SOS sign as mentioned above.

Each pair of competitors who have been shown the SOS mark must stop to provide assistance to injured persons or a burning car and, if necessary, alert additional assistance using a tracking device or from the **safety number +35846 903 7581**. If the additional assistance alert fails, the information must be delivered to the next message point on the route, which can also be the finish of the special test.

If a competitor hits a vehicle and/or a person on a special stage, the competitor must immediately stop and ensure the need for assistance and act as described for accidents.

When calling for help, provide the following information:

- the race number of the accident vehicle,
- how many injured contestants and/or spectators
- how seriously they have been injured
- whether any of the competitors are stuck in the car
- whether the viewer under the car is pinched
- the scene of the accident, e.g. road book section/nuisance or milepost
- other relevant information, such as whether there is fire, water, etc.

Also, the following cars need to stop to help if red "SOS" is displayed. A competitor who has stopped on a special stage must set a red warning triangle at least 50 m before the stopping place, if the gap is still on the road.

The unhindered passage of rescue units arriving at the scene must be ensured by moving the race cars that have arrived at the scene past the scene of the accident. If this is not possible, the cars must be moved to the side of the road.

Similarly, if you do not need medical assistance, show the green OK sign on your car to the officials and fellow competitors.

Contacts of competitors with the doctor of the competition are made by the management center via **the emergency number +358 46 903 7581**.

**The authorities oblige competitors to inform the officials of the special test at the finish line of the special test about possible hazard elements, such as:**

- **the public in the wrong/dangerous places**
- **lack of characters**
- **the danger points on the route,**

## RACE FINISH

The finish of the race is located on the Killeri horse race track. The contestants to be awarded in the competition will be directed to the award area after the finish TC.

After reaching the finish line, there is no Parc Fermé.

## RESULTS

The provisional classification is calculated together the times from the special stages in both Section 1 and 2 and the other given time penalties. Prizes will be awarded based on these results.

Provisional final classification will be published according to the event programme on the Virtual Official Noticeboard (SPORTITY app), followed by the official classification both on the VONB and the <https://www.rallism.fi/content/fi/1/10092/Tulokset.html>
