## 4. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Competition will be run in compliance with National ASN (AKK) general national rally regulations and Finnish Rally Championship regulations, and these Future SM-ralli supplementary regulations. ASN permission number is 18/2023.

**NOTE: This document is a translation of Finnish regulations. In cases of any doubt, the original Finnish text is valid.**

### HRT:

The total length of rally is 648,62 km including 12 special stages, total length of 149,12 km.

Part 1 will be driven at 11.08.2023. Part 1 contains 222,16 kms, including 4 special stages, total length of 51,96 kms.

Part 2 will be driven at 12.08.2023. The length of part 2 is 426,46 kms including 8 special stages, total length of 97,16 kms.

BMW Rally Serie will be driven at 12.08.2023, only Part 2

The total rally length is 426,46 km including 8 special stages, total length of 97,16 kms.

The numbering of the special stages follows the SS numbering of the EHRC. The Special Stages to be run are numbered by SS 5–10.

### FRC:

The total length of rally is 538,96 kms including 10 special stages, total length of 123,98 kms.

Part 1 will be driven at 11.08.2023. Part 1 contains 112,50 kms, including 2 special stages, length 25,98 kms.

Part 2 will be driven 12.08.23. Part 2 contains 426,46 kms including 8 special stages, total length of 97,16 kms.

NOTE: The numbering of the special stages follows the SS numbering of the EHRC. The Special Stages to be run on 11.8.2023 are SS 3-4, on 12.8.2023 numbered by SS 5–10.

The Secto Rally Finland Power Stage is Alikylä 2 (FRC-classes, Part 1, the 2nd special stage)

If competitor is found before his starting time on roads used as special stages in the rally, marked yellow, grey or black on the road map of Finland, in areas of Kärkölä, Mäntsälä, Padasjoki, Hollola, Hämeenlinna, his ASN will be informed for further actions to be taken. Note reconnaissance for classes 1–8 and 29–33, 36 and 37.

The competition follows the regulations of the Finnish Sports Ethics Center (SUEK), which can be found at [www.suek.fi](http://www.suek.fi), as well as the legislation regarding doping.

Electronical administrative checking is used in the competition.

Competitor information must be sent in accordance with the electronic procedure defined in the competitor instructions. The competitor must use the Google Forms defined in Rally Guide to provide competitor documents (all information and service contact information as well as information about including reconnaissance time), and send them to the competition organizer by Sunday, August 6, 2023 at 6:00 pm.

The licence number of the driver must be used as the reference number. If the driver competes with a familiarization licence, the co-driver's license number should be used as the reference number. If both drivers in the Historic Rally Regularity Class are competing with a familiarization licence, the name of the driver must be included in the payment as a reference.

The entry fee includes the GPS tracking device fee and the timekeeping transponder fee. If the competitor does not return the GPS tracking device and/or transponder undamaged to the organizer after the competition, the competitor is charged 250 euros by the organizer (€ 250/piece).





## 8. SERVICE

HRT: 3 service breaks on the route. The schedule of services are specified with more details in the Rally Guide. Between Parc fermé and the start of part 2, there is a possibility of service. Class 44 BMW, 1 service break.

FRC: 2 service breaks on the route. The schedule of services are specified with more details in the Rally Guide. Between Parc fermé and the start of part 2, there is a possibility of service.

There is a centralized service park in the competition: Lahti Sports and Exhibition Center, Salpausselänkatu 7, 15210 Lahti.

The organizer charges € 150/competitor for changes that occur after this. A space of 6 x 8 metres has been reserved for one competitor.

To competitors of the FRC series will be reserved space according to the series regulations.

Service cars must have competitor-specific fire extinguishers and an oil-naming mat ready for use, and a liquid-impermeable cover under the race car at least the size of its bottom surface. Absence of any of these leads to immediate disqualification from the competition by the decision of the competition director.

**Flexi Service is available in all classes.**

Part 1 evening service B, TC 4B early check-in permitted as well as Parc ferme's TC 4C.

## 9. TYRES

HRT: Tyres according to the 2023 Finnish Rally Regulations.

FRC: In classes 1–6, a maximum of 12 tyres may be used in the competition. These tyres must be reported using the tyre code form, which must be delivered by Friday 11 August 2023 by email not later than at 12:00 to [rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi](mailto:rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi)

The tyre code form can be found at Sportity.

## 10. REFUELING

Refueling is possible only at gas stations and refueling areas marked in the road book. The refueling points are shown in the schedule in the Rally Guide, where the distances for the SS and the service area etc. are marked.

## 11. RECONNAISSANCE

HRT, classes (29–33, 36, 37) from 9.8.2023 at 07.30 and 10.8.2023 at 07.00 competitors may collect reconnaissance and other material and GPS tracking device from the rally office.

FRC, classes (1–7) from 9.8.2023 at 16:30 and 10.8.2023 at 06.30 competitors may collect reconnaissance and other material as well as GPS tracking device from the competition office.

The two (2) reconnaissance car badges given by the organizer must be affixed to the windshield in the middle up and on the right rear window and they must be visible throughout the pre-introduction period.

During reconnaissance, a speed limit of 80 km/h is valid for all special stages, unless the speed has been set even lower by road signs or signs placed on the terrain by the organizer. The driving style must be such that it does not endanger or disturb other traffic or nearby settlements. The organizer forbids driving against the driving direction of the special stages. The organizer carries out speed and driving style monitoring during the reconnaissance period. GPS tracking is also used to monitor reconnaissance hours and speed limits. The police also supervises the route and punishes traffic violations in accordance with the Road Traffic Act.

The call to stop by officials with the organizers' badges must be obeyed under the threat of being denied the right to start.





Reconnaissance schedule:

**HRT:** Reconnaissance takes place over two days, 9.8.2023 at 08:30–17:30. and 10.8.2023, from 07:30 to 16:00. Drivers of the HN category (class 36) are allowed do their reccee taking into account the license and qualification regulations.

**FR:** Reconnaissance on 10.08.23 at 07:30–20:00.

According to the series regulations special stages can be passaged twice, also applies to special stages run twice.

## 12. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

### Sealing (FNC)

FRC 11.08.23 from 11:30 a.m. by appointment

The competitor or his representative must arrive at the safety scrutineering area (Autosalpa Oy, Vanhanradankatu 2, 15520 Lahti) 10 minutes before the scrutineering time, when it is determined that the racing car will be there on time. After registration, the equipment check is carried out, after which the racing car is moved to the inspection hall. The safety inspection ends 10 minutes after the last inspection time.





#### 14. MATERIAL

Each crew receives a road book, which shows the route to be followed in detail, 2 route maps and all the timecards used in the competition, as well as, if necessary, series-specific windshield stickers.

The GPS tracking device will be handed over at the rally office in connection with the distribution of materials. Timekeeping transponders are distributed, for classes 1–7 and 11–44, before the start at the TC, in the Port of Lahti.

Competitors will receive all their timecards together with the competition material.

Part 1 departs from Lahti Harbour, Satamakatu 7, 15140 Lahti, with 1 minute interval.

Part 2 departs from the Service park, Salpausselänkatu 7, 15210 Lahti. Starting times are published on the virtual official notice board in the Sportity mobile application.

In this respect, the preliminary instructions to each competitor in the schedule are part of the competition's regulations. Departure takes place from the Service park, TC Service Out.

The competitor must follow the rally route determined by the organizer at all times. Failure to do this always will be followed by disqualification from the rally.
