III GENERAL INFORMATION

Total length of the route is 247,77 km including 7 special stages, which cover 120,21 km in total.

Competitors in classes 17–19 take part in the Leg 2 of the rally and thereby complete only special stages 2–7 (Sat 22 February.), 105,22 kilometres of competitive distance in total.

Should a person who is either competitor or acting on behalf of a competitor of SM Vaakuna-Ralli be found on the roads in the area of Mikkeli prior to the start time of the particular crew, excluding official reconnaissance as per Art. 13.6., such crew will consequently be refused to start the rally.

Art 4. Rally Car

4.2. Studded tyres are allowed.

In all classes the maximum number of tyres allowed to be used during the rally is fixed at 12. Regulations, marking and inspections of the tyres in accordance to Finnish Rally Championship regulations.

The overnight halt Parc Fermé is located at Mikkelin Toriparkki (underground parking facility underneath Mikkeli City Square) and is only to be entered with tyres in compliance with civil traffic law. These tyres are not to be marked and will not be included in the maximum of 12 tyres to be used during the rally. More detailed information will be given in the Competitor's Information Kit.

Art. 5. Competitors

Event is a NEAFP-event and thereby open to licence holders of other countries' ASNs.

Art. 6. Entries

6.2. Anybody wishing to take part in SM Vaakuna-Ralli must submit the entry through KITI-service, or ask the Secretary of the Event for instructions to submit entry using alternative means.

6.3 The maximum number of entries is fixed at 150 crews. Should the number of entries exceed this number, drivers who have entered the Finnish Rally Championship or Suomi CUP will be given the priority.

6.4 When entering the rally, competitors must inform the organiser the type of fuel they wish to use and the method of refuelling, according to FRC regulations, Art. 15.1. **When using organiser's refuel zone, the competitor must pay a 30 € extra fee together with the entry fee of the rally.**

Art. 7. Entry fees

7.1.

All drivers competing with an AKK-Motorsport license are eligible for Finnish Rally Championship points in classes SM1-SM4. Championship registration can be paid in advance for the season by 8th January 2014 at the latest to AKK Sports Ltd. Registered drivers pay their entry fee according to the first column of the table below.

Other drivers with an AKK license pay their entry fee as in second column and drivers in classes SM1-SM4 with a foreign license pay as in the third column. These prices include the tracking device fee.

Art. 13. Traffic and service

13.2. Service area

There is one service park in the event, located at the Kasarmi Campus area (Patteristonkatu 3, Mikkeli). Servicing the rally car is only allowed in this area.

Organiser reserves every crew a service space as defined in the Finnish Rally Championship regulations. Should a joint service space be requested, a written request (with the dimensions of the area) must reach the organiser by **10 February 2014 at 21.00 CEST** at the following contact: email mikua@mikua.fi . After that date the organiser will charge € 150 for every change concerning the service park layout. Organiser reserves the right to reject requests.

Service vehicles must be equipped with fire extinguisher appropriate for extinguishing flammable fluids and oil spill kit ready for use at any time. A tarpaulin or equivalent must be used in the service park at all times BOTH under service vehicle AND rally car to prevent oil spillage. The absence of one of these may lead to exclusion by the Clerk of the Course.

Penalty fees for infringements in the service park area are as follows:

1st infringement	300 euros
2nd infringement	600 euros
3rd infringement	exclusion from the event by the decision of the Clerk of the Course

13.3. Refuelling zones

Refuelling is only allowed at petrol stations marked in the road book or otherwise guided by the organiser according to the Finnish Rally Championship regulations.

When entering the rally, competitors must inform the organiser the type of fuel they wish to use (98E5, E85 or FIA Appendix J), as well as the method of refuelling (directly from the pump at petrol station or in organiser's refuelling area from own drums/cans). When using drums/cans, the competitor must pay a 30 € extra fee together with the rally entry fee, also see Art. 6.4.

13.6. Reconnaissance

Starting on Friday 21 February 2014 at 7.00 reconnaissance material for competitors in classes 1-16 can be collected from a meeting room on the 2nd floor of Sokos Hotel Vaakuna. At registration, each competitor must give the organiser details of the car used for reconnaissance and contact details of his/her mobile phone and/or contact details of the overnight accommodation. At the administrative checks/registration for reconnaissance both drivers must present drivers' competition and driving licences, competitor/entrant licence, and authorisation for the drivers by their ASN to take part in the rally. **Both drivers have to present their licences and other documents personally.**

Competitors can collect their materials also on Thursday 20 February at 19.00–21.30, when the optional administrative checks is available. **Both drivers have to present their licences and other documents personally.** Optional administrative checks does not apply to competitors in classes 17-19.

Identification signs for the reconnaissance must be affixed on the reconnaissance vehicle according to the instructions given by the organiser and they must be visible throughout the whole duration of the reconnaissance.

On special stages the speed limit is 80 km/h unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed along the route by the organiser. The competitors must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages. Under no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the rally in a special stage. Organiser will control the traffic during the reconnaissance paying attention to the manner of driving as well as to the speeds used. Police will also control the reconnaissance and will penalise competitors for infringements according to the Finnish Traffic Law.

Competitors are, under pain of refusal to start, obliged to stop should Rally Officials with official plates request them to do so.

Organiser reserves the right to carry out an inspection at any stage of the rally to rally car in classes 17–19 including crew members' personal belongings (incl. mobile phones) and bags in order to find pace notes. Should such material (pace notes or equivalent) be found by the organiser, such crew will be excluded from the event and is subject to additional penalties imposed by their national ASN.

13.6.1. Duration

For classes 1-16 reconnaissance starts on Friday 21 February 2013 at 8.00 and ends at 17.00.

Reconnaissance is allowed on the following conditions: the maximum number of passages on each special stage for reconnaissance is limited to two per entered crew.

V RUNNING OF THE RALLY

Art. 15. Start

Start time of each crew for Leg 1 and 2 will be published on the official notice board according to the programme.

Leg 1

Time cards will be given at TC 0 (Start of the Rally), which is located at the service park area. The cars will be started on 21 February 2014 starting at 18.45 with one (1) minute intervals. There will be no Parc fermé at the start of the rally.

Crews who have retired from the rally during Leg 1 or have been rejected to start the rally by scrutineers are allowed to repair the car and restart the rally on Leg 2. Such crew must inform the Rally office by written document by 23.00 hrs on Friday 21 Feb 2014. Should such crew fail to complete special stage/special stages on Leg 1, total time for Leg 1 will be fastest time in the respective class added by 3 minutes per non-completed special stage. Should a crew retire from the rally either on the road section after SS1 a time penalty of 5 minutes will be added to the total time.

Rally car of a crew retired during Leg 1 and restarting the rally for Leg 2, will undergo a technical scrutineering procedure 1 hour before the start time of 1st competitor on Saturday 22 February 2014. Only cars that have passed the technical scrutineering will be eligible to restart the rally.

Overnight halt - Parc Fermé

There will be a Parc Fermé for night halt located at the parking facility of Mikkeli City Square (Mikkelin toriparkki). **There will be no penalty for early arrival at overnight halt parc ferme-IN (TC 1F). The parking facility is only allowed to be entered with tyres in compliance with civil traffic law.** These tyres are not to be marked and will not be included in the maximum of 12 tyres to be used during the rally as defined in Art 4.2. Before night halt there will be a service of 30 mins in the service park.

Leg 2

Starting order for Leg 2 is the one used on Leg 1. This also applies to crews retired from the rally during Leg 1 and restarting the rally for Leg 2.

Competitors will start the Leg 2 at Parc Ferme area. Competitors are allowed to enter the Parc Ferme area 10 mins before their respective starting time at the earliest. Competitors will be given time cards at start-TC (TC 1G). Leg 2 of the rally will start at 10.00 on Saturday 22 February 2014. There will be a service time of 15 mins after the start. Starting at 11.01 there will be ceremonial re-start of the rally at Mikkeli City Square. Competitors in classes 17-19 start the rally at the Start-TC (TC 1I).

15.8. At the administrative checks (Sokos Hotel Vaakuna 2nd floor, on Thu 20 February 2014 at 19.00-21.30 or Fri 21 February 2014 starting at 07.00), each crew of classes 1-16 will receive a road book describing the route of the rally in detail, and two route maps. Any deviation from the given road sections will lead to exclusion.

Crews in classes 17-19 will receive a road book describing the route of the rally in detail, and two route maps and timecard against completed scrutineering document from the rally info at Service park one (1) hour prior to their respective start time.

Art. 18. Regrouping halts

There will be one (1) regrouping halt during the rally during which servicing will be prohibited.

VI SCRUTINEERING

Art. 21. Scrutineering before and during the event

Scrutineering will take place at Etelä-Savon Ammattiopisto, Kinnarinkatu 3, 50170 Mikkeli. Classes 1-16 on Friday 21 February 2014 starting at 16.00.

Classes 17-19 on Saturday 22 February 2014 starting at 10.00.

Schedule for scrutineering will be given in the Competitor's information kit in Art. 3.6., which is regarded as part of these supplementary regulations.

Scrutineering closes 30 minutes after the time given for the last competition number.

21.7. Sealing of turbos

Organiser strongly recommends that all cars to be sealed, would attend the optional scrutineering on Friday 21 February 2014 at 14.00–16.00. More information in the Competitor's information kit.

Art. 26. Prizes

Prizes are mostly utility articles and souvenirs. The number of awarded competitors will be published in Competitor's information kit and on the official notice board.

Art. 27. Prize-giving ceremony

Prize-giving ceremony will take place on 22 February 2014 at Sokos Hotel Vaakuna. Schedule for the ceremony will be given in the competitors' information kit. All crews to receive prizes must attend the ceremony. Only the Clerk of the Course may grant permission for a crew not to attend the ceremony.
