For competitors in the SM3 NEZ JRC – class, the rules and regulations of the NEZ JRC are also in effect. Similarly, in class 21, additional rules and regulations of the VOC Volvo Original are used.

III General Regulations/Information

Art. 3. General Description

The total length of the race is approximately 279 km and it includes 8 special stages, which have a total length of approx. 92 km.

If a competitor, or someone working with or for them, is found on roads used as special stages in the rally, marked yellow, grey or black on the road map of Finland (in provinces of Joensuu and Tohmajärvi), they will not be allowed the start the rally.

Art. 4. The Car and tires

4.2. Anti-Skid Tires are allowed. Other tire regulations according to the Finnish Champion 2014 rules and regulations.

4.4. The results can be found in the KITI - system. The organizer reserves the right to combine classes as necessary.

Art. 6. The entry procedure

Tracking units are distributed on Saturday 8.3.2014 in the Race Office, beginning at 8 AM. The Unit must be picked up at least an hour before the allotted start time.

In accordance with the Finnish Championship regulations art 15.1, when a competitor makes an entry to the race, they must inform the organizer of the type of fuel they will be using, as well as the method of refueling during the race.

If a competitor wishes to receive NEZ JRC points, they must inform ASN before the entries close.

6.2. Everyone wishing to take part in SM Itäralli must make the entry using the KITI – system or ask for secondary entrance instructions from the Race Secretary.

6.8 The maximum number of contestants is 200 (The first 200 entrants will be taken).

Art. 7. Entry fees

All the competitors with Finnish ASN lisence are deserved Finnish Championship points in classes SM1-SM4. The registration fee was able to pay forward by 8.1.2014. Competitors registrated in advance may pay entry fee during the column A.

The other ones compete with Finnish ASN lisence may pay entry fees during the column B. The prize contain fees for the monitoring device

Competitors with foreign ASN lisence may pay entry fees is mentioned in the column C. This prize contains fee for series service and the monitoring device.

Art. 13. Traffic and Service

13.2 Service Area

The competion uses a single service area, which is in Joensuun Moottoriurheilukeskus (Address: Polvijärjentie 25, 80400, Ylämylly). Service is only allowed inside this service area and the length of service is 30 minutes. The organizer reserves the right for changes.

Organizer will reserve a place in the service area for drivers who are participating in Finnish Rally championship, according FC rally regulations. For any special request regarding service area needed, or area for teams, please send a detailed written request to the organizer by 9 PM on 24.2.2014 (email: joeua@pp.inet.fi). After the afore mentioned date, changes might still be possible, but there is a fee of 200€.

Each service car must have one fire extinguisher per pilot and there must also be material for containing oils spills. Also, during service, there must be a liquid proof covering under the entire car. Neglecting any of these three requirements is grounds for immediate disqualification from the race.

Other sanctions for infringements in the service area:

- 1. Infringement → 200€
- 2. infringement → 500€
- 3. infringement \rightarrow disgualification from the race

13.3 Refueling during the race

Refueling is only permitted on service stations and depots that are either marked in the Road Book or otherwise clearly indicated by the organizer, as required by the rules of Finnish Championship 2014.

In accordance with the Finnish Championship 2014 regulations art 15.1, when a competitor makes an entry to the race, they must inform the organizer of the type of fuel they will be using, as well as the method of refueling during the race. If the contestant wishes to use the service depot to refuel, the organizer will collect a service fee at the registration.

The service fee for using the service depot is based on dividing the costs of security at the depot among the users. The size of the fee will be notified later, once the number of users has been confirmed.

13.7. Reconnaissaince

Material for reconnaissance is available on 7.3.2014 at 08:00 in the Race Office (Sortavalankatu 4). When signing, competitor must give information on the reconnaissance car, a mobile phone number and details on accommodation. Also, the Technical- ja Safety Form available in the KITI - system needs to be given to organizer. Also, both pilots need to have identification documents with them and both need to be present personally.

Organizer will give deification numbers to competitor's reconnaissance car. One number needs to be located in the top middle of windscreen and the other to right side back window. Numbers need to be visible throughout the whole reconnaissance.

Max speed limit during reconnaissance is 80km/h unless otherwise stated by traffic signs. Driving during recce should not cause any kind of risk or disturb other traffic or people living close to the rally roads. It's forbidden to drive in the wrong direction on special stage. The organizer and police are controlling competitors behavior during the recce period. In Finland, it's forbidden to use any kind of radar detectors. Competitors must stop if the organizer tells them to do so.

For competitors in classes 16 – 20, reconnaissance is forbidden. If such a competitor or anyone working with or for them is found on any of the special stages before their allotted start time, they will be immediately disqualified. Note that ANS may also assign other sanctions on top of disquilification.







The organized reserves the right to inspect the cars and possessions (including bags and mobile phones) of competitors in classes 16 – 20, at any time. If any pace notes are found, the competitor is immediately disqualified and ANS is informed, as above.

13.7.1. Duration

Reconnaissance begins on 7.3.2014 at 9 AM and ends at 6 PM, except for the public special stage, where reconnaissance begins at 5 PM and ends at 7 PM.

Additionally, each special stage can be driven twice.

Competitors in classes 16 – 20 are forbidden to perform reconnaissance.

Art. 14. Advertising 14.3. Advertising

All advertisements must conform to Finnish Championship 2014 rules and regulations.

V The way of the race

Art. 15. Start

Actual starting times will be published on the official notice board according to the program. Time card will be given to the competitors in the start TC. The start will take a place in the marketplace of Joensuu at 10.01 AM with 1 minute intervals. It's recommended that the competitors arrive in starting area 10 minutes before their given start time.

15.8. For classes 1-15 and 21, the competitors will receive the road book (with the detailed route to be followed) and 2 route maps on Friday 7.3.2014, beginning at 8 AM in the Race Office (Sortavalankatu 4, 80200 JOENSUU).

For classes 16-18, the competitors will receive the road book (with the detailed route to be followed) and 2 route maps one hour before their starting time. These are available from the Race Office with an accepted scrutineering document.

The route needs to be fully followed, or competitor can be excluded from the event.

Art. 18. Regrouping

There are two regroupings during the race. Service during the regrouping is forbidden.

VI Scrutineering

Art. 21. Scrutineering before and during the rally

Scrutineering place: Itä-Suomen Katsastuskeskus (Street address; Aspitie 9, 80100 Joensuu). Starts at 08:00. Detailed information in competitor info.

Scrutineering ends 30 minutes after the last competitors time.

Voluntary scrutineering on Friday, 7.3. 2014 at 5 PM to 9 PM in Itä-Suomen Katsastuskeskus (Street address; Aspitie 9, 80100 Joensuu) If you wish to participate in voluntary scrutineering, please inform Mr. Timo Brilli (timo.brilli@gmail.com) before 4 PM on 6.3.2014.

Voluntary scrutineering also ends 30 minutes after the last competitors time.







21.7. The Sealing of Turbochargers

The organizer recommends that all cars that need to be sealed would participate in scrutineering on Friday 7.3.2014 between 5.30 PM and 9 PM. There is a special lane available for cars with turbochargers.

Art. 26. Prizes

The number of competitors that receive an award will be notified on the official noticeboard.

Art. 27. The Award Ceremony

Both pilots will receive their awards at the race finish based on unofficial standings. Every competitor receiving prices must be present at the award ceremony. Only the Clerk of the course may excuse a competitor from the ceremony and only for an important reason.
