4. **DESCRIPTION OF THE RALLY**

Length of the route is 218 km including 9 special stages, the total length of which is 103,5 km.

If a person who is either a competitor or acting on behalf of a competitor is found on the roads outside the reconnaissance schedule before the competitor's start time in the area of, Loppi, Hämeenlinna, Riihimäki, Hausjärvi and Janakkala the competitor is refused the right to start. This concerns roads of Finnish roadmap, marked in yellow, grey and black or unmarked roads used for the rally, excluding Saukkolan EK and roads to Saukkolan EK Ourajoentie and Saukkolantie.

The competition follows the regulations of the Finnish Sports Ethics Center (SUEK), which can be found at suek.fi, as well as the legislation regarding doping.

6. ENTRIES

Anybody wishing to take part in Auto Sorsa Riihimäki-ralli must submit the entry through KITI-service, or ask the secretary of the event for instructions to submit entry using alternative means. Foreign competitors indicate the fuel and refueling method they use on the registration form.

The maximum number of entries is fixed at 220 crews. If the number of entries exceed this number, drivers who have entered the Finnish Rally Championship or Suomi Cup will be given priority. Should the number of entries in any of the classes 8-17 be less than 3, the organizer may merge such class with another class.

Competitors are obligated to take a Finnish traffic insurance for the foreign race car, for the duration of the competition.

Use of competitor information by the organizer:

By entering the competition, the competitor accepts the processing of personal data provided by the organizer and the publication and inclusion of specified personal information (name, club, etc.) in the entry list, results list, etc. in all organizer's communications and registers. The organizer also reserves the right to disclose relevant published information to use by third parties.

8. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

Electronic administrative checks is used in the competition. On the organizer's website www.riihimakiralli.fi or with the forms found in the Sportity application (contact information during the competition and information for the announcer). The forms must be filled out by 09:00 on 11 January 2024.

9. SERVICE

The service park is located at the Mikontie 1, 11910 Riihimäki. Service is allowed only in the service park. There will be two services on Saturday. Service time at both services is 30min.

Both times are so called flexi services. The competitor will be given a Service Out Time and the earliest possible time to start service at Service IN TC. After this and after possible technical inspection (scrutineering) (FRC art. 14.2), competitor will move their rally car at the service spot and will place the document that shows the starting time of service, visibly on the windscreen etc. other place inside the rally car. Competitors must leave their rally car as soon as they arrive at service spot. Service will be overseen, for starting service early the penalty is 30 sec per starting minute.

Organizer reserves every crew a service space as defined in the FRC SR. Should a joint service space be requested, a written request (with the dimensions of the area) must reach the organiser by 04.01.2024 at 9.00pm at the following contact: email riihimaenua@gmail.com. After that date the organiser will charge € 150 for every change concerning the service park layout. Organizer reserves the right to reject requests.

Service vehicles must be equipped with fire extinguisher appropriate for extinguishing flammable fluids and with an oil spill kit ready for use at any time. (FRC art. 14.5) A tarpaulin or equivalent being at least the size of the rally car to prevent oil spillage. The absence of any of these will result in the immediate decision of the Clerk of the Course to exclude competitor from the competition.

Penalty fees for infringements in the service park area are as follows

1st infringement 300€ 2nd infringement 600€

3rd infringement exclusion from the event by the decision of the Clerk of the Course













10. TYRES

Classes 1-7 Marking of tires (10 pcs) and inspections take place in accordance with the FRC. The tire code form must be returned electronically to rallismkatsastus@gmail.com by 12.01.2024 5pm.

In other classes, the number of special anti-skid tires is not limited and in them it is allowed to use tires according to the FSC APPENDIX J section 6.1.2 Studded tires or tires according to the previous years FSC APPENDIX J section 6.1.2 Studded tires (so-called 16-inch tires of the old rule).

11. REFUELLING

Refueling is only allowed at petrol stations marked in the road book or otherwise shown by the organizer. Finnish Rally Regulations (FRR) in contrast to the refueling interval in section 18, intermediate refueling between special stages 7 and 8 is prohibited for classes 1-4 according to the FRC SR, Art 15.1.

In entry, competitor must fill a form type of fuel to be used (98E5, E85 or FIA (FRR Appendix J) and also method of refuelling (at petrol stations or in organizer refuelling area from own containers). Refueling distances and locations are stated in the competitor's manual.

12. RECONNAISSANCE (non concerning classes 15-17)

Competitors in classes 1-14 may collect their reconnaissance material from the subsidiary rally office ABC Riihimäki, Kinturintie 2, 11120 Riihimäki on Friday 12.01.24 from 8:00am When acknowledging receipt of the material, the competitor must confirm the information about his / her reconnaissance car and his / her telephone number provided in advance to the organizer.

Identification stickers (2 pieces) for the reconnaissance must be affixed on the reconnaissance vehicle as follows: one to top center of the windscreen and the other to the rear side window on the right-hand side. They must be visible throughout the whole duration of the reconnaissance.

During the reconnaissance on special stages the speed limit is 80 km/h unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed along the route by the organizer. The competitors must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages. Under no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the rally in a special stage. Organizer will control the traffic during the reconnaissance paying attention to the manner of driving as well as to the speeds used. Police will also control the reconnaissance and will penalize competitors for infringements according to the Finnish Traffic Law.

GPS tracking devices are distributed in connection with the distribution of the reconnaissance materials and must be in use during the reconnaissance. The competitor must reserve a USB power source for the tracking device in his familiarization car and keep the device connected throughout the familiarization.

After reconnaissance, before the competitor's departure time for part 1 of the rally, the competitor must transfer the GPS tracking device to his rally car.

Competitors are, under pain of refusal to start, obliged to stop if Rally Officials with official plates request them to do so. Reconnaissance concerning SS 1-7 and 9 starts on Friday 12.1.24 at 9.00am and ends 12.01.24 at 8.00pm. Reconnaissance concerning SS 8 starts on Friday 12.01.24 at 9.00am and ends Friday 12.01.24 at 2.00pm.

13. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

Competitors must reserve advertising spaces on the rally cars and overalls according to the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations of 2024.

Advertisements of competition numbers and the windshield advertisement of value competitions will be notified by bulletin.













14. PRE-RALLY SCRUTINEERING

Pre-rally scrutineering will take place at Hyria Riihimäki, Sakonkatu 1, 11100 Riihimäki.

Pre-rally scrutineering will take place on Friday 12.1.2024 starting from 3.00pm and Saturday 13.1.2024 starting from 9:00am

Competitor must book a time for scrutineering at https://slotti.fi/booking/rallism/ Classes 1-7 Saturday 06.01.24 at 9am to Monday 08.01.24 at 10pm. Classes 8-17 Tuesday 09.01.24 at 9am to Wednesday 10.01.24 at 10pm.

For scrutineering competitor must scan or photograph following documents no later than 11.1.24 at 9am and send by email to rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi

- Race car transfer permit / registration extract
- · Condition inspection certificate or certificate of an approved annual inspection
- Inspection card, page 1 and page 2
- Homologation certificate or passport (V-, R-Lite, Historic or F-group national passport) first page

- 1st page of the catalyst certificate

Subject the e-mails with the race number and the driver's name.

The scrutineering ends 10 minutes after the end of the last scrutineering time.

If the competitor wants to change his/her scrutineering time after the booking system has closed, the competition organizer will withhold a fee of €50. The same fee is also charged for the cars that the organizer places after the competitor has left without making an appointment.

Payment must be made to the competition office no later than one hour before your start time.

The competitor or his representative must register for the scrutineering at the inspection site office 10 minutes before his own inspection time, when it is determined that the racing car will be there on time. After registration, we proceed to the equipment inspection, which is carried out in the same room, and the car is moved towards the inspection line. In connection with the safety inspection, the noise level of the racing car can be checked, which may be a maximum of 103db at 3500rpm

Sealing

The spare parts to be sealed and registered for the competition are inspected and, if necessary, sealed during the safety inspection. More detailed instructions in the competitor instructions.

15. COMPETITOR MATERIAL

Competitors in classes 1-14 will receive one road book describing the rally route in detail, two route maps and GPS Safety Tracking device ABC Riihimäki Kinturintie 2, 11120 Riihimäki Friday 12.1. starting at 08:00 4.2. Other material such as competitor numbers they can collect from rally office Auto Sorsa Oy, Tehtaankatu 6, 11710 Riihimäki starting from 12.

Competitors in classes 15-17 will receive one road book, describing the rally route in detail, two route maps, GPS Safety Tracking device on Saturday 13.1. starting at 8:00am Auto Sorsa Oy, Tehtaankatu 6, 11710 Riihimäki.

The timing transponder will be distributed at the starting area of the rally.

16. START

The competitors' ideal starting times are announced according to the program on the competition's official notice board. The competition uses the official Finnish time, which can be found at https://time.is

The international time card is used in the competition and competitors receive it at the start of the competition. Instructions on how to use the card can be found in the competitor instructions.

The departure takes place every minute from 11:01 a.m. and is located at Kauppakatu, Riihimäki.

The competitor must follow the competition route determined by the organizer throughout the competition. Failure to follow the competition route always results in disqualification from the competition.













17. **RESULTS**

Provisional classifications per competition class will be published on the official notice board as per schedule given in the Competitors' manual. Official classifications will be available at KITI-system and www.rallism.fi

18. PRIZES AND PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

The number of awarded competitors will be published on the Official Notice Board. Prize-giving ceremony is right after finish. Prizes will be given to both drivers in the finish area. All crews to receive prizes must attend the ceremony. Only the Clerk of the Course may grant permission for a crew not to attend the ceremony.
