## 4. GENERAL INFORMATION

The rally will be organized based on ASN (AKK-Motorsport) regulations, Historic Rally Trophy and Historic Regularity Rally Regulations, and the regulations of 22<sup>nd</sup> Peurunkaralli, of which AKK-Motorsport has approved with visa 5/RA/25. Regulations are published also in English; in case of any dispute, the Finnish version is determinative.

Total distance of the rally route is 117 km, including 5 Special Stages. Total distance of the Special Stages is approx. 51 km.

If a competitor or his/her representative is met prior to his/her starting time on the roads used as Special Stages in the rally, marked yellow, gray or black or unmarked roads in the road map of Finland in the areas of Laukaa, Äänekoski or Konnevesi, the competitor will be prohibited to participate in the Rally.

The Rally follows the regulations of the Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports (FINCIS), which can be found on website: [suek.fi](http://suek.fi), and in the legislation regarding doping.

The cars can use seats and seat belts that comply with FIA standards, the validity date of which is not decisive. The condition of the seats and belts must be first-class, and their condition will be checked during the safety inspection.

## 6. ENTRY PROCEDURE

Everyone, who wants to participate the 22<sup>nd</sup> Peurunkarally, needs to register via KITI portal of AKK-Motorsport at the latest on 18.02.2025 at 23:59, or ask secondary registration instructions from secretary of the rally.

By the order of entries, 220 first crews who did the registration according to the regulations, are accepted to the rally. Possible elimination is made from other classes than Historic Rally Trophy, Historic Regularity Rally Trophy, VW Aircooled Rally Series of BMW Rally series classes. No merging of classes will be made.

### Use of competitor's information by the organizer:

When placing an entry to the event, the competitor agrees with the processing of the given personal data by the organizer and publication of the specified information (name, club etc.) in the entry list, results and communication of the event.

## 7. ENTRY FEES

## 8. SERVICE

On the rally route there is a service break between SS 3 and SS 4.

Time of the service break will be published in the official rally itinerary.

The contact details for the service area representative and instructions for any service area reservations will be specified in the Rally Guide.

Service vehicles must have a competitor-specific fire extinguisher and an oil absorbent mat ready for use, as well as a liquid-proof protective cover under the rally car, that is at least the size of its ground surface area. The absence of any of these will result in immediate exclusion from the rally at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Additionally, the service vehicle must have a liquid-proof protective cover under it, at least the size of its ground surface area

## 9. TYRES

Regulations regarding tyres, Appendix J. Article 252.6.1. In Historic Regularity Rally, class 24, tyres based on Historic Regularity Rally Trophy series and Road Traffic Act.

## 10. REFUELING

Refueling will take place from individual fuel cans in the service area, in a designated area allocated by the event organizer. Refueling will be carried out in accordance with the ASN rally regulations, section 18.

## 11. RECONNAISSANCE

From 08:45 on 28.02.2025, competitors (classes 19-23, 26, 39-42) may collect their reconnaissance material from the registration/paper check (Huoltotyö Pentti Oy office, Rokkakankaantie 16). When receiving the material, the competitor must provide the organizer with details of their reconnaissance car and phone number.

The two (2) reconnaissance car identification stickers provided by the organizer must be affixed to the recce car; one in the center at the top of windshield and the other to the right rear side window, and they must be visible throughout the reconnaissance period.

Competitors must comply with the Finnish Road Traffic Act and lower regulations during reconnaissance and the rally on all sections other than special stages. During reconnaissance, there is an 80 km/h speed limit on all special stages unless a lower speed is indicated by traffic signs or markers set by the organizer. The driving style must be such that it does not endanger or disturb other traffic or nearby residential areas. The organizer prohibits driving against the special stage direction. The organizer will monitor speed and driving behavior during the reconnaissance period.

The police will also monitor the route and impose penalties for traffic violations according to the Road Traffic Act.

Instructions from officials with organizer identification must be followed, under the threat of denial of start rights.

The reconnaissance period starts on 28.02.2025 at 09:00 and ends on 28.02.2025 at 18:00.

Reconnaissance of the route is allowed with the following restrictions: only for classes 19-23, 26, and 39-42. The number of reconnaissance runs is not limited.

## 12. RALLY NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

The rally number backgrounds used in the event are 50 cm \* 50 cm in size.

Historic Rally Club Finland reserves the right to the following advertising spaces on the HRT competitors' cars:

- Upper windshield advertising space (no other advertisements are allowed on the windshield)
- Door advertising space of 20 cm x 40 cm size

## 13. SAFETY SCRUTINEERING

Safety scrutineering will take place at Laukaa Kone and Kuljetus premises, located at Honkarinteenkatu 10, 41350 Laukaa.

Safety scrutineering with pre-booking on 28.02.2025 will begin at 18:00 and ends at 20:00.

On the rally day, 01.03.2025, safety scrutineering will start at 08:30 for the Historic Regularity Rally (Class 24) and at 09:30 for other classes. Scrutineering will be conducted in the order of the starting list.

The schedule will be confirmed if necessary in the Rally Guide.

The safety scrutineering will conclude 10 minutes after the last competitor's scrutineering time.

## 14. COMPETITOR MATERIALS

Each crew will receive a roadbook detailing the route to be followed, as well as two (2) route maps.

The distribution of materials will take place at the Rally HQ (Peurunka Spa Hotel).

GPS tracking devices and timing transponders will be distributed alongside the competitor materials.

Competitors in the reconnaissance classes are responsible for charging the devices for the rally day, Saturday.

The devices will be collected at the finish control of the event, at the parking area of Peurunka Spa Hotel, on Saturday after the rally finish.

## 15. START

The list of those eligible for the start will be announced according to the schedule on the official virtual notice board in Sportity App.

Competitors will receive their time cards at the Start Time Control of the event.

The start will take place from the Peurunka Spa Hotel parking area, with a 1 minute interval between competitors:

- at 10:00, competitor number #401 (Historic Regularity Rally)
- at 11:01, competitor number #1

The rally organizer reserves the right to extend the start intervals between competitors or classes.

Competitors must follow the route designated by the organizer throughout the rally. Failure to adhere to the rally route may result in a penalty set by the Clerk of the Course, depending on the severity of the violation.

## 16. REGROUPING

There will be no regrouping on the route. Any regrouping will be done during the service breaks.

## 17. RESULTS

Provisional results will be published by class according to the schedule outlined in the Rally Guide on the official notice board, and the final official results will be available on the official notice board, the Sportity app, the KITI system, and the event's website at [lmm.fi](http://lmm.fi).

## 18. PRIZES AND PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The number of prizes will be announced on the official notice board of the event.

Prizes will be awarded to both drivers at the Peurunka Spa Hotel Bistro Nemo based on the provisional results.

The prize distribution schedule by class will be provided in the Rally Guide.

The number of awards will be announced on the rally's official notice board.

The prizes will be distributed to both drivers at Peurunka Spa Hotel's Bistro Nemo based on conditional results.

The schedule for the award ceremony, categorized by classes, will be provided in the competitor instructions.
